




1.2 Defence, National Security and Terrorism

2019 Indo Pacific Chiefs of Defence Conference to be held in Thailand

■ The 2019 Indo Pacific Chiefs of Defence (CHOD) Conference will be held in Thailand's capital city Bangkok. In this conference, India will be represented by Chairman Chiefs of Staff Committee (COSC) and Chief of the Air Staff-Air Chief Marshal Birender Singh Dhanoa.

Key Words: 2019 CHOD Conference

- ► Theme for conference: "Collaboration in a free and Open Indo Pacific".
- ► It will see participation of Chiefs of Defence of more than 33 countries.

India to join developed nations in ocean studies

- India's ambition to send men to the deep sea in a submersible vehicle is likely to be a reality in 2021-22 with the 'Samudrayaan' project.
- The project proposes to send a submersible vehicle with three persons to a depth of about 6000 metres to carry out deep underwater studies.
- The ₹ 200 crore project proposes to carry three persons in a submersible vehicle to a depth of 6000 metres under sea for various studies. Submarines go only about 200 metres.

Facility for defence communication system

- A state-of-the-art 20,000 sq ft facility of an Indo-Israel joint venture to design, develop and manufacture tactical communication systems for the armed forces was inaugurated.
- Astra Rafael Communication System (ARC) has positioned itself to become India's first private sector firm to manufacture cutting-edge software defined radios in multiple variants.

Kandla, Adani ports put on security alert

■ The country's two largest ports, **Kandla** and **Adani** in Gujarat, were put on high alert, along with the centre **Gulf of Kutch**, after intelligence agencies shared inputs of a possible entry by Pakistan-trained commandos through the **Harami Naala** creek to carry out underwater attacks.

India's first female military diplomat to join Indian Mission in Russia

Wing Commander Anjali Singh became India's first female military diplomat posted in an Indian mission abroad after joining the Indian Embassy in Russia as Deputy Air Attache (air force officer involved in diplomatic operations). She previously served the Indian Air Force (IAF) for 17 years as an Aeronautical Engineer (AE) and is also trained on MiG-29 aircraft.

Joint Naval Annual Quality Conclave (JNAQC) to be held in Visakhapatnam

- The Joint Naval Annual Quality Conclave (JNAQC) under the theme 'Transformation of QA Paradigm: Opportunities and Challenges' will be hosted by the Naval Quality Assurance Establishments, Ministry of Defence in Visakhapatnam. Vice Admiral Atul Kumar Jain, Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief of Eastern Naval Command will be the Chief Guest for the annual event.
- It is envisaged that the Conclave will provide a vibrant environment for stimulating discussions on all aspects pertaining to Transformation of QA Paradigm and will benefit all stakeholders.

9th SLINEX 2019 Indo-Lanka maritime fleet exercise commenced

- On September 7, 2019 the 9th edition of weeklong joint maritime naval exercise between India and Srilanka (SL) named SLINEX for the year 2019 has commenced in the port of Visakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh.
- ➤ The first **SLINEX** was held in the year 2005 and the previous/8th edition took place in **Trincomalee**, **Srilanka**.

Mount Leo Pargyil

- It is 3rd highest peak of Himachal. It lies in **Zanskar range** in Kinnaur District.
- It is considered to be among most challenging and technically difficult peak to scale.
- An Indian Army team successfully summited Mount Leo Pargyil at 6773 m recently. The expedition team hoisted National Flag atop Mt Leo Pargyil after an extremely challenging climb in harsh weather.

Russia Opens Porthole to Chennai

- India and Russia agreed to open a mari-time route between Chennai and Vladivostok to ensure connectivity between the two countries.
- A Memorandum of Intent was signed between the Indian Ministry of Shipping and Russia's Ministry of Transport for the development of maritime communications between the ports of Chennai and Vladivostok.

Boeing Delivers 11th C-17 Globemaster

- Boeing has delivered the 11th C-17 Globemaster III to the Indian Air Force India's adding capability to meet current and future strategic airlift requirements.
- **Boeing'sC-17GlobemasterIII**isapremier transporter for military, humanitarian and peacekeeping missions.

Maitree 2019: Indo-Thailand Joint Military Exercise to be held in Meghalaya

■ The 2019 edition of Maitree, the **joint military exercise** between **India and Thailand** will be conducted from **16-29 September** at **Foreign Training Node**, **Umroi**, **in Meghalaya**.

28th Indo-Thai CORPAT Being conducted at Bangkok, Thailand

- The 28th edition of India-Thailand Coordinated Patrol (Indo-Thai CORPAT) between India's Indian Navy (IN) and Thailand's Royal Thai Navy (RTN) for the year 2019 is being conducted in Bangkok, Thailand from September 05-15, 2019.
- Indian Naval Ship (INS) Kesari and His Majesty's Thailand Ship (HTMS) Kraburi are participating in the CORPAT along with both navies's Maritime Patrol Aircrafts (MPA).

DRDO gives second indigenously developed AEWC aircraft 'Netra' to Air Force

- The Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO) has handed over the 2nd indigenously developed AWAC (Airborne Early Warning and Control) aircraft, 'Netra' to the Indian Air Force (IAF).
- ▶ The maximum firepower of this missile is about 2.5 km. It can be used for surveillance, tracking, identification and classification of airborne and sea surface targets and is useful in detecting upcoming ballistic missile threats.

DRDO Successfully Flight-Tests Indigenously Developed low Weight, Fire & Forget Man Portable Antitank Guided Missile

- In a major boost for Indian Army, Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully flight tested indigenously developed low weight, fire and forget Man Portable Antitank Guided Missile (MPATGM) in the ranges of Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh
- This is the third series of successful testing of MPATGM. The missile is incorporated with state-of-the-art Infrared Imaging Seeker along with advanced avionics. The test paves the way for the Army to have developed 3rd generation man portable Anti-Tank Guided Missile indigenously.

Yudh Abhyas 2019 to be held in US

- The joint military training exercise between India and United States (US) named Yudh Abhyas 2019 will be held at Joint Base Lewis McChord, Washington, US
- This will be overall 15th edition of the joint exercise hosted alternately between the two countries.

India ranks 9th among the top 10 individual nations in gold reserves

- The World Gold Council (WGC) released the 2019 list of gold reserves in each country. The list was topped by United States (US) with gold reserves of 8,133.5 tonnes followed by Germany (3,366.8 tonnes) at second place.
- India entered the top 10 list this year ranking at 10th spot surpassing Netherlands (612.5 tonnes) whereas it is ranked at 9th position in terms of individual countries with 618.2 tonnes, as the International Monetary Fund (IMF) ranks third (2,451.8 tonnes) in the gold reserve list.
- India's neighbouring country **Pakistan**, stood at 45th position (64.6 tonnes) in 2019 list.

BHEL commissions 1,320 MW thermal plant in Jharsuguda, Odisha

■ BHEL commissions 1,320 MW thermal plant in Jharsuguda, Odisha Govt. of India owned state run engineering firm Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) announced commissioning of 1320 MegaWatt(MW) power project in Ib Thermal Power Station(ITPS) in Odisha's Jharsuguda district. This generated power will be supplied to Grid Corporation of Odisha (GRIDCO).

Maitree: Indo-Thailand Joint Military Exercise

- Exercise MAITREE is a joint military exercise which is being conducted between armies of India and Thailand since 2006. This annual training event is held alternatively in Thailand and India.
- Aim of Military Exericse is to share experience gained during various counter-terrorism operations.

The Indian Army and Indian Air Force (IAF)

■ The Indian Army and Indian Air Force (IAF) will jointly engage to conduct a large war exercise code-named 'HimVijay' in along the china border near Arunachal Pradesh. This would be the 1st and biggest ever war game done by the strike corps in the eastern region. For the first time, 17 Mountain Corps will be involved, over 2500 soldiers will participate in it.

Naval variant of LCA Tejas

- The naval variant of the Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas made a successful short arrested landing on the Shore Based Test Facility (SBTF) in Goa.
- The LCA made its maiden successful trap on the SBTF with the tail hook of the aircraft connecting with the arrestor wire on the deck and coming to halt within a short distance.
- The SBTF, which replicates the flight deck of an aircraft carrier was specifically built to train naval pilots in the complex manoeuvres of landing on the short flight deck of an aircraft carrier before they move on to the actual carrier.
- The Navy currently operates Russian MiG-29K fighters from INS Vikramaditya. They will also fly from the first Indigenous Aircraft Carrier (IAC) Vikrant once it enters service.

White Water Rafting Expedition 'Rudrashila' Flagged off at Jaisalmer

- The White water Rafting Expedition christened 'RUDRASHILA' being undertaken by Kalidhar Battalion under the aegis of Battle Axe Division was Flagged Off at Jaisalmer Military station.
- The expedition christened 'Rudrashila' has been organised to commemorate the 75th Raising day of the Kalidhar Battalion.
- 'Rudrashila' takes its name from the famed Rudraprayag tributary of the Ganges River in the Mountains of Uttarakhand.

SCO exercise "Tsentr (centre) 2019" commenced in DONGUZ Ranges, Russia

- The opening ceremony of exercise "TSENTR 2019" which forms part of the Russian Armed Forces' annual training cycle, under the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO), was conducted at the DONGUZ ranges near Orenburg, Russia.
- 8 SCO member countries inclusive of Russia namely China, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, India, and Pakistan are participating in the exercise. The exercise which mainly focuses on countering international terrorism, comprises of two modules where the first module focuses on counter-terror operations, defensive measures and the second module focuses on offensive operations.

Indo-US First Tri-Services Exercise code "Exercise Tiger Triumph" for the year 2019 at Visakhapatnam and Kakinada in November

■ In November 2019, India and the United States (US) are set to host the first ever tri-services exercise codenamed "ExerciseTiger Triumph" at Visakhapatnam and Kakinada, both of state Andhra Pradesh. The plan for this exercise was discussed during the Final Planning Conference (FPC) for India-US Tri-Services Humanitarian Aid and Disaster Relief (HADR) which was held in the Eastern Naval Command.

DRDO hands over New-Generation War gaming Software to Navy

■ The Defence Research Development Organisation (DRDO) handed over a New-Generation War gaming Software developed by New Delhi-based Institute for Systems Studies and Analysis (ISSA) to the Indian Navy. ISSA is a premier DRDO laboratory.

1st India, Singapore, Thailand Trilateral Naval Exercise begins

■ The maiden Trilateral Naval exercise involving Indian Navy (IN), Republic of Singapore Navy (RSN) and Royal Thailand Navy (RTN) commenced at Port Blair, Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The five-day exercise will be held from 16 to 20 September 2019.

Philadelphia in Pennsylvania, US (United
States) due to congestive heart failure.

Rahul Aware wins Bronze in 61kg Free-Style Category at World C'ship

■ Indian wrestler Rahul Aware has won a bronze medal in men's 61-kilogram freestyle category at the World ChampionshipinNur-Sultan, Kazakhstan. He beat 17th seeded American Tyler Lee Graff 11-4 to ensure he finished on the podium. It was India's fifth medal at this edition of the World Championships with a total haul of 1 silver and 4 bronzes.

1.3 World Organisations - Pacts and Summits

Russia set to offer submarines during Modi-Putin summit

- Russia is likely to offer India its conventional submarines on the government -to-government route under the Navy's Project-75I at the summit between Prime Minister Narendra modi and President Vladimir Putin at Vladivostok.
- Russian conventional submarines will be offered through the government to-government route to India at the summit. This will save a lot of time in the procurement process.
- The deal to manufacture at least 200 Ka-226T Utility helicopters for the Indian Army and Air Force is likely to get a boost.

Gujarat Govt, Delaware State of America sign MoU for Sister State

■ Gujarat Government and Delaware State of America signed MoU – Memorandum of Understanding for sister state. MoU was signed in Gandhinagar, when a delegation of Delaware State of America called on Gujarat Chief Minister Delaware's Vijay Rupani. MoU was signed by Gujarat Chief Minister and Delaware's Secretary of state.

India Ranks 9th on Happiness Index

- According to "Global Happiness Survey" from market research firm IPSOS, Indian has been ranked 9th on the happiness index among 28 global markets.
- Australia and Canada at the top spot (at 86 per cent) have emerged as the happiest nations of the world.

Delhi Ranks 118th and Mumbai at 119th spot in EIU's Global Liveability Index 2019

- The "Global Liveability Index" prepared by the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) has ranked Delhi in the 118th spot which is a drop by 6 places from 112th spot(biggest decline registered in Asia) in its previous report due to an increase in crime, poor air quality, and worsening climate conditions.
- **Mumbai** also dropped by **two places** to rank at **119**th spot this year.
- The list was topped by **Vienna**, the capital of Austria for the second consecutive time whereas **Damascus**, the capital of Syria was ranked last becoming the least liveable city at **140**th position. Russia's St. Petersburg topped the list among BRICS nations at 71st spot.

President inaugurated the World first Youth Conference

■ The President Ram Nath Kovind inaugurated the World first Youth Summit in New Delhi on 7 September 2019. It was organized by the Youth Awakening Mission, a youth wing of Paavan Chintan Dhara Charitable Trust, Ghaziabad.

India Ranked 34th on World Travel, Tourism Competitiveness Index

- India has moved up six places to rank 34th on world travel and tourism competitiveness index, driven by rich natural and cultural resources and strong price competitiveness announced by a WEF report.
- India's ranking improved from 40th to 34th, the greatest improvement over 2017 among the top 25 per cent of all countries ranked in the report.

The Travel & Tourism Competitiveness Index (TTCI), that covered 140 economies, measures the set of factors and policies that enable sustainable development of travel and tourism sector which contributes to the development and competitiveness of a country.

Vaishno Devi Shrine tops list of 'Swachh Iconic Places'

- The Shrine has been adjudged on the basis of the overall improvement in sanitation. Several initiatives were taken in the last few years to ensure the cleanliness of the entire Shrine area.
- Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine in Jammu and Kashmir has been adjudged as the Best Swachh Iconic place in the country in the 'Swachh Iconic Places' list released by the Ministry of Jal Shakti proclaimed by the Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation

Feroz Shah Kotla Stadium to be Renamed as Arun Jaitley Stadium

■ The Delhi and District Cricket Association (DDCA) decided to rename Feroz Shah Kotla Stadium as Arun Jaitley Stadium in the memory of its former president of DDCA. Jaitley was the president of DDCA from 1999 to 2013.



Union Minister of State for Human Resource Development launched Curriculum for Life Skills (Jeevan Kaushal) designed by University Grants Commission (UGC)

- UGC constituted Expert Committee prepared a Curriculum for Life Skills (Jeevan Kaushal) for Under Graduate Program.
- Life Skills like communication skill, interpersonal skill, time management, problem solving ability, decision making capacity, leadership ability and integrity play a crucial role in boosting the employability of the students.
- Life skills (Jeevan Kaushal) curriculum cover the set of human talents acquired by an individual via classroom learning or life experience that can help them to deal with problems encountered in day to day life.

1.5 Eminent Persons

Mother Teresa's 109th birth anniversary

■ Mother Teresa's 109th birth anniversary was commemorated across the world on August 26, 2019. Mother Teresa was born on August 26, 1910. Mother Teresa came to India in 1929 and worked for the welfare of the poorest of the poor as well as the homeless.

1st Serving General to Complete France's Oldest Marathon Cycling Event

- Lieutenant General **Anil Puri (56)** has become the first serving Lieutenant General-rank officer of the Indian Army to complete **1200** km of France's oldest and toughest cycle competition.
- He achieved this feat by cycling non-stop for 90 hours without sleeping on the 19th
 Paris Brest-Paris circuit (PBP) 2019 held from 18-22 August 2019.

India's First Woman DGP Kanchan Chaudhary Bhattacharya Passes away

- India's first woman Director General of Police (DGP), **Kanchan Chaudhary Bhattacharya** passed away. She was a 1973 batch officer, made history in 2004 when she was appointed as the **DGP of Uttarakhand**.
- She was also the second woman IPS officer in the country.

Shalija Dhami of IAF Becomes First Female Flight Commander

■ Wing Commander Shalija Dhami of the Indian Air Force (IAF), became the first ever female officer to be appointed as flight commander (second in command) of a flying



unit. She took over as flight commander of a Chetak helicopter unit at **Hindon** airbase, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh.

- He became the first Indian male pugilist to win a silver in World Championships at Ekaterinburg in Russia.


Pankaj Advani wins IBSF World Billiards Championship





5-Judge SC Bench to hear pleas on withdrawal of Article 370

- A Presidential Order on August 5 had withdrawn Article 370, through which special rights and privileges had been accorded to the people of **Jammu and Kashmir since 1954** in accordance with the Instrument of Accession.

- The Maharashtra cabinet has cleared the "vertical property rules" to create a database of all flats, buildings and commercial complexes. - The joint framework aimed at bridging the gap between the default rates divulged by rating agencies differed from the report computed by the RBI's Central Repository of Information on Large Credits (CRILC), a borrower-level database focusing on systemically important credit exposures.
- RBI will also advise the banks to update the borrower data with CIC (credit information companies) regularly and to maintain the quality of the information.

3.1 Policy on Environment and Ecology

Convention to Combat Desertification Union

- Environment Minister Prakash Javadekar recites the target is in addition to India's pledge to restore 13 mn hectares of degraded land by 2020.
- The target is over and above India's pledge to restore 13 million hectares of degraded and deforested land by 2020 as part of the 'Bonn Challenge'.
- The Bonn Challenge is a global effort to bring 150 million hectares of deforested and degraded land into restoration by 2020 and 350 million hectares by 2030.

Star tortoise, otters get higher protection at CITES

■ India's proposal to upgrade the protection of star tortoises (Geochelone elegans), the smooth-coated otter (Lutrogale perspicillata) and small-clawed otters (Anoyx cinereus) in CITES (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species on Wild Fauna and Flora) have been approved.



- These species have been listed under **Appendix I** of **CITES** and will now enjoy the highest degree of protection as there will be a complete international ban enforced on their trade.
- The upgradation was approved at the Conference of the Parties (COPI7) held at Geneva.

Rohit4Rhinos campaign

- Indian cricket team's star batsman Rohit Sharma is launching "Rohit4Rhinos campaign" in partnership with WWF India and Animal Planet (wildlife channel) to spread awareness about the need for conservation of one-horned rhinos.
- **Key Points:** This rhino conservation campaign will be launched on September 22 on World Rhino Day.
- The one -horned rhinoceros, the state animal of Assam. There are around 3,500 Indian rhinos present in the world. India is home to 82 % of the rhinos.
- Rohit is the brand ambassador for rhino protection in WWF (World Wide Fund for Nature) India and for this, he joined in 2018.

Two new eel species discovered

- Two new species of marine eel were discovered and documented by the Estuarine Biology Regional Centre (EBRC) of the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) at Gopalpur in Odisha.
- One of them is a short brown unpatterned moray eel now named **Gymnothorax** andamanensis.
- New white-spotted moray eel, named **Gymnothorax smithi** has also been identified by Gopalpur's ZSI scientists. Its first specimen was found in the Arabian Sea in 2011.

Special Tiger Force for Corbett Reserve set up

- The Uttarakhand government has decided to form a Special Tiger Force for Corbett Tiger Reserve, a move which will help serve as the much needed second layer of protection for the big cat.
- The decision to set up the force was taken by the State Cabinet. The force will have 85 posts.
- The decision is in line with Government of India guidelines for providing three-tier protection to tigers at reserves.

Anandan's day gecko adds to the Western Ghats

- The recent discovery of the 35th species of day gecko highlights the rich biodiversity of the Western Ghats.
- The recently discovered Cnemaspis anandani (Anandan's day gecko), is the most recent day gecko found in the Nilgiris and is endemic to the Western Ghats.

Butterfly with Light Penetrating Feathers Discovered in Salem

- Nature enthusiasts during a recent Nature walk in the foothills of Yercaud recorded the presence of a rare butterfly Tarucus indica, commonly known as the Indian Pierrot or Transparent Pierrot.
- There are around five or six varieties in the genus **Tarucusand the Transparent Pierrot** is a rare species. This is the first photographic record of the butterfly's presence in Tamil Nadu. Till date its presence has been recorded only in **Maharashtra**, **Gujarat and other Northern States**.

Extreme Mangrove Corals Found on the Great Barrier Reef

- University of Technology Sydney
 Researchers discovered "Extreme Corals"
 in mangrove lagoons around Australia's
 Great Barrier Reef, which is yielding
 important information about how corals
 deel with environment stress.
- 34 species of coral were found to be regularly exposed to extremely low pH, low oxygen and highly variable temperature conditions making two mangrove lagoons on the Woody Isles and Howick Island Potential "hot spots" of coral resilence.

Typhoon Faxai hits Tokyo, Japan

■ **Typhoon Faxai** has hit **Tokyo, Japan.** There were winds of up to 216 kilometres (134 miles) per hour. Authorities have issued non-compulsory evacuation warnings to more than 390,000 people.

Malaria Eradication possible by 2050: Lancet Report

- The latest Lancet Report suggested that it may be possible to eradicate malaria from the world by 2050. The report titled, 'Malaria eradication within a generation: ambitious, achievable, and necessary' has prepared by 41 leading scientists, economists and health-policy experts.
- The Lancet report informed that the **first global campaign to eradicate malaria was launched by the World Health Organization in 1955.** The Global Malaria Eradication Programme lasted for nearly fifteen years and succeeded in eliminating malaria from fifteen countries and significantly reducing transmission in several others.

86 Tigers Rescued From Infamous Temple in Thailand have died

- The government soon removed **147 tigers** from the compound in the **West Thailand** town of **Kanchanaburi**, taking them to two state-run facilities.
- Thailand media announced that 86 of the rescued animals have died. A government official attributed the animals' deaths to a viral disease.

3.2 Natural Disasters – Safeguard Measures

Storm Dorian makes landfall in Canada

Storm Dorian has made landfall in the Canadian province of Nova Scotia as a post-tropical cyclone, it hit the Bahamas as a Category 5 hurricane causing widespread devastation to the archipelago.



Prime Minister Launches National Animal Disease Control Programme and National Artificial Insemination Programme

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the National Animal Disease Control Program (NACDP) to control and eradicate the Foot & Mouth

Disease (FMD) and Brucellosis amongst the livestock in the country, at Mathura on 11 September 2019.

- The Prime Minister also launched the **National Artificial Insemination Program** and a country wide workshop in all the **Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs)** in all the **687 Districts** of the country on vaccination and disease management, Artificial Insemination and Productivity.
- The Prime Minister also launched the Swachhta Hi Seva Program with focus on reducing the usage of Single Use Plastic in the country.
- The Swachhta hi Sewa 2019 theme is 'plastic waste awareness and management'.

- The Central Vigilance Commission has constituted a 4-member Advisory Board for Banking Frauds. The ABBF will be headed by former Vigilance Commissioner T.M. Bhasin.
- The panel will function as the 1st level of examination of all large fraud cases. Lenders will refer all large fraud cases above ₹50 crore to the board and on receipt of its recommendation or advice, the bank concerned would take further action in such matters.

Stamp of Best Author of Siddha Medicine to be Released by PM

- He is among the 12 inspiring personalities whose commemorative stamps will be released by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in the national capital.
- T.V. Sambasivam Pillai was born on September 19, 1880 in Bengaluru, as the eldest son to Vilviah Manniar and Manonmani Ammal.
- This work of T.V. Sambasivam Pillai, the acclaimed author, is considered as one of the great treasures of the Siddha system.

ICICI Bank Deploys 'Robotic Arms' to Count Currency Notes

- ICICI Bank has become the country's first commercial bank to customise and deploy industrial 'Robotic Arms' to digitise operations at its currency chests across 12 cities.
- ICICI Bank announced the deployment of industrial 'Robotic Arms' to digitise operations at its currency chests.
- The cities where ICICI Bank has deployed the robotic arms are Delhi, Jaipur, Chandigarh, Mumbai, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Bhopal, Sangli, Mangaluru, Raipur, Siliguri and Varanasi and will help sort 1.8 billion banknotes annually.



FM Nirmala Sitharaman Announces Mega Public Sector Bank Merger; 10 Banks Amalgamated into 4 Entities

- Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on August 30 unveiled a mega merger plan for public sector banks (PSBs), amalgamating 10 banks into 4.
- The consolidation will bring down the total number of public sector banks in the country to 12 from 27 in 2017.
- Bank of India, Central Bank of India, UCO Bank, Bank of Maharashtra, and Punjab and Sindh Bank will continue to operate as before and will be provided necessary support from the government.
- The government has taken care that the technological platforms used by the banks are compatible and enable a quick realization of gains without any customer inconvenience or disruption in services.

- The Central Board of Direct Taxes CBDT has constituted a five member special cell to address grievances of Start ups with relation to angel tax and other tax related issues.
- The 'startup cell' will be headed by the Member (Income Tax Computerisation) of the board.
- The Cell will work towards redressal of grievances and mitigate tax related issues in case of start up entities with respect to the administration of Income tax Act 1961.

■ Following the recommendations of an expert committee headed by **Y.H.Malegam**, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has revised the guidelines on **concurrent audit system**.

This additional factor of authentication protects from unauthorized ATM cash withdrawals for cardholders. India Post launches speed post service for six new countries

■ The Department of Posts has expanded its speed post service to 6 new overseas destinations in Asia, Europe and South America. It has introduced International Speed Post (EMS) for Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Ecuador, Kazakhstan, Lithuania and North McDonia.

EMS (Express Mail Service):

▶ It is a premium service that **enables its users to send documents** and merchandise faster and in this service **goods can be monitored online** with the help of the internet. Currently India Post is providing speed post service to 100 countries.

CCEA approves ethanol price revision for supply to Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has approved revision of price of ethanol (ethyl alcohol) for the year 2019-20 derived from various raw materials under the Ethanol Blended Petrol (EBP) programme. The revision comes into effect from 1st December 2019 till 30th November 2020.

About EBP:

The programme was launched in January 2003, to promote alternative and environment friendly fuels for meeting the energy requirements. During its initial launch the OMCs were asked to supply 5% ethanol blended Petrol.

TNManoharantaskforceonsecondary market for corporate loans submits its report to RBI

■ A 6-member taskforce on secondary market for corporate loans, headed by Canara Bank Chairman TN Manoharan has submitted its report



to RBI (Reserve Bank of India) Governor Shaktikanta Das.

■ **Self-Regulatory Body:** RBI's task force proposed to setting up of a Self-Regulatory Body for the standardization of corporate loan documents.

UNCTAD Released Its First 'Digital Economy Report 2019'

■ United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) released the first ever Digital Economy Report (DER) titled "Digital Economy Report 2019 - Value Creation and Capture: Implications for developing countries". DER was formerly known as the Information Economy Report. It examines the scope for value creation and capture in the digital economy by developing countries.

Highlights of DER 2019

Following are the highlights of the report:

Global Internet Protocol (IP) traffic

- ► Global Internet Protocol (IP) traffic has grown from about 100 gigabytes (GB) per day in 1992 to more than **45,000 GB** per second in 2017.
- ▶ By 2022, global IP traffic is projected to reach 150,700 GB per second.

Value in digital economy

- ► Estimates of the size of the digital economy range from 4.5% to 15.5% of the world's GDP (Gross Domestic Product).
- ▶ Regarding value added in the information and communications technology (ICT) sector, the **United States** and **China** together account for almost 40% of the world's total.
- ► ICT sector is the largest in **Taiwan Province of** China, Ireland, and Malaysia.
- ► The global computer services industry is dominated by the **United States**.
- ▶ India has the largest share among developing countries in the computer services industry. Also, India ranked fourth in terms of growth in the share of the ICT sector's value-added in GDP between 2010 and 2017.

Niti Aayog Selected McKinsey & Company to set up India's First Digital Capability Centre

■ National Institution for Transforming India (Niti Aayog) has selected McKinsey & Company to set up India's first Digital Capability Centre (DCC) in New Delhi. McKinsey & Company supports 5 such centres globally- in Aachen, Chicago, Singapore, Venice and Beijing.

Infosys tops Indian companies in Forbes' World's best 'regarded' companies list 2019, Visa tops

- Nearly 17 Indian companies were listed in the Forbes World's best 'regarded' companies list 2019. The company which topped among other Indian firms is Infosys which ranked third in the overall list. The first and second place were held by global payments technology company Visa and Italian carmaker Ferrari respectively.
- ▶ Infosys which tops among the Indian companies, was ranked at 31st position in 2018.
- ► Indian firms in the top 50 list: Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) ranking 22nd and Tata Motors ranking (31) featured among the top 50 in the coveted list

An internal group of RBI to assess the adequacy of forex reserves

■ An internal group of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) will frame a formal mechanism to assess the adequacy of its foreign exchange (forex) reserves. RBI had recently adapted the fresh Economic Capital Framework (ECF) as recommended by Bimal Jalan Committee on ECF which noted that RBI's forex reserves in 2008 were higher than India's external debt.

Key Words

- The panel will study whether forex reserves are adequate or not and how much reserves are adequate to cover various risks.
- 2. At present, the forex reserves (more than \$400 billion) are lower than India's total external liabilities (\$1 trillion) and even lower than total external debt (\$500 billion).
- 3. As on August 16, 2019, India's forex reserves stood at \$ 430.5 billion, an increase of \$ 17.6 billion over March 31, 2019 (\$ 412.9 billion).

IFC & FIDC sign a MoU to train NBFCs


- The International Finance Corporation (IFC), part of the World Bank Group and the Finance Industry Development Council (FIDC), a representative body of asset and loan Financing of Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC), signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to train the NBFCs in India on "Commercial Credit Reporting" with an objective to build the capacities of NBFCs to improve reporting and enquiring on Commercial Credit Information Data from the Credit Bureaus.
- Training will be conducted under the guidance of leading consultants from the World Bank Group in India at different centers.
- ▶ It is a company registered under the Companies Act, 2013 of India, engaged in the business of loans and advances, acquisition of shares, stock, bonds, hirepurchase insurance business or chit-fund business, agriculture, industrial activity and sale, purchase and construction of immovable property.

RBI released guidelines for licensing of Small Finance Banks

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on September 13 released draft norms for 'on tap' licensing of Small Finance Banks (SFBs), which will allow applicants to approach the banking regulator.
- A Small Finance Banks (SFB) is a basic banking entity that provides bare minimum financial services with focus on financial inclusion and expansion in unbanked geographical areas. The minimum paid-up voting equity capital for SFBs shall be Rs. 200 crore.
- Indian citizens with at least 10 years of experience in banking and finance at a senior level can apply for a banking license, while companies with track record of **five years** will be eligible as promoters, according to the proposed norms. Others include existing non-banking finance companies (NBFCs), micro finance institutions and local area banks.

IMF cuts India's GDP growth to 7% from 7.3% for FY20

- This rate cut is attributed to uncertainty in corporate and environmental regulatory in



some Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFC).

Key Words

▶ This economic growth rate is expected to rise to **7.2** % **FY21**, which is also a downgraded projected growth rate of 7.5 in the earlier report.

A Federal Body Like GST Council For the Agriculture Sector

- The RBI (Reserve Bank of India) panel has suggested creating an institution like the GST (Goods and Services Tax) Council to implement reforms in the agricultural sector.
- It was also recommended to **transfer subsidy directly to the account** and avoid debt waiver.
- The **Reserve Bank of India** has created the Internal Working Group (IWG) to Review Agricultural Credit chaired by **Mahesh Kumar Jain** on February 13, 2019.



Key recommendations:

- ▶ Banks are required to develop a management information system (MIS) to sanction loans against gold as collateral in core banking solution (CBS) platform for better monitoring of end-use of funds.
- ▶ The panel stated that subsidy on interest subvention or agricultural credit should be converted into direct benefit transfer (DBT) like LPG (Liquefied petroleum gas) and fertilizer with an overall limit of `3 lakh per individual farmer through Kisan Credit Card (KCC) mode.
- ▶ Banks should increase credit supply for agricultural activities and give consumption loans to farmers up to `1 lakh.

OECD Lowers India's Economic Growth Forecast For 2019-20 To 5.9% From 7.2%

■ As per the intergovernmental economic organisation, OECD(Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development) latest update on OECD report 2019, India's GDP (gross domestic product) growth expected to grow by 5.9 per cent for 2019 (FY-Fiscal Year 2020) and 6.3 % in 2020 (FY21).

Other ratings:


► For FY 20, The World Bank (WB) projected India's GDP growth rate remained at 7.5%, IMF (International Monetary Fund) -7%, ADB (Asian Development Bank) -7%, Economic Survey of the finance ministry -7%, Reserve Bank India (RBI) -6.9%.

The 37th GST Council Meeting For 2019 Held in Panaji, Goa

■ The 37th Good and Service Tax (GST) Council Meeting under the Chairmanship of Union Finance & Corporate Affairs Minister Smt Nirmala Sitharaman was held in Panaji, Goa.

About GST:

- ► The Goods and Services Tax (GST) is governed by the GST Council.
- ▶ Article 279 (1) of the amended Indian Constitution states that the GST Council has to be constituted by the President within 60 days of the commencement of the Article 279A.
- ▶ According to the article, GST Council will be a joint forum for the Centre and the States. It consists of the following members:
- ► The Union Finance Minister will be the Chairperson.
- ▶ As a member, the **Union Minister of State** will be in **charge of Revenue of Finance**.
- ► The Minister in charge of finance or taxation or any other Minister nominated by each State government, as members.

5.1 Latest Inventions on Science & Technology

National Cancer Tissue Biobank at IIT-Madras

- The National Cancer Tissue Biobank at IIT-Madras will enable India to perform necessary testing to develop treatments most effective for cancer patients in the country by Union minister Ashwini Kumar Choubey.
- The National Cancer Tissue Biobank at IIT-Madras will enable India to perform the necessary testing to develop treatments and medications that will be most effective in Indian conditions/patients.

MIT Scientists Developed Biggest-Ever Carbon Nanotube Computer chip- RV16XNano

 Scientists at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) have developed the biggest-ever computer chip using carbon nanotubes (CNT) - RV16XNano. This was published in the journal Nature.

Key Words:

RV16XNano is a 16-bit processor that contains 14,000 transistors — electronic switches. These switches are made up of CNT — tiny cylinders made of rolled-up, atom-thick sheets of graphene.

India-France to Jointly Build, Run space-based Ship Tracking System

- The world's first space-based automatic identification system (AIS) to track merchant ships on a real-time basis will be built and operated jointly by India and France.
- Indian and France signed an agreement recently to start development and production of a constellation of satellites on which studies have been underway for more than a year.

IIT-Hyderabad Develops Water Proofing Material Using Fly Ash

- Researchers at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Hyderabad have found fly ash, a waste by-product from coalbased thermal power plants that poses a threat to the environment that can be modified into a waterproofing material.
- The researchers have converted fly ash into a water proofing material by treating it with **stearic acid**, which is commonly used in soaps and shampoos.

India Unveiled World's First Ever Facial BSID

■ India launched the world's first ever Biometric Seafarer Identity Document (BSID) which captures the facial biometric data of seafarers. It was launched by Shri Mansukh Mandaviya, Minister of State (I/C) Shipping and Chemical & Fertilizers in New Delhi. He handed over the new BSID cards to 5 Indian seafarers.

About BSID

The **BSID** has the dimensions of a smart **ID card.** It introduces modern security features like an embedded **biometric** chip, as well as optical security features such as micro prints/micro texts and Unique Guilloche pattern. The security of the **BSID card** is ensured at various levels and through different methods.

India Faces Higher Mortality From Cardiovascular Diseases

- Cardiovascular diseases (CVD) continues to be the leading cause of death across the world, but there are significant variations between rich and poor nations.
- While in high-income countries, that of CVD, in low-income countries, including India, deaths from cardiac disease were three times that of cancer.
- Additionally, indoor or household air pollution has been identified as a key cause of CVD.



Harman Introduces Infinity Brand Audio Products in India

- Audio products maker Harman, which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of South Korean giant Samsung Electronics, has introduced lifestyle audio brand Infinity in India.
- Harman has also unveiled 11 new audio products, which include six headphones, four portable Bluetooth speakers and a multimedia bluetooth system.

IIT-M Students Design Low-cost Freezers for Farm Produce

- Researchers in the Indian Institute of Technology- Madras discovered with low-cost efficient freezers that farmers can use to transport their produce.
- They found that the logistics of cold storage is a huge pain for small-scale farmers

IAmid Vikram Iull, MOM completes 5 yrs around Mars

- On September 24, 2019 Five Earth years in the Martian Orbit for Isro's Mars Orbiter Mission (MOM), bringing subdued cheer at the space agency, amid a lull caused by an unsuccessful attempt at soft-landing Vikram, Chandrayaan-2's lander on Moon.
- MOM was designed for just six months around Mars its long life a feat for Isro, which had failed to achieve to Chandrayaan-1, its first mission to Moon, in 2008. 2.5 Martian Years.
- MOM had completed five Earth years around Mars it only amounts to two-and-a-half Martian years. The Mars actually take more than the double of 365.

Indians have Higher Average Resting Heart Rate

- Indians have an average resting heart rate of 80 beats per minute which is higher than the desired rate of 72, found by Indian Heart Study (IHS).
- The IHS also highlighted that unlike people of other Countries, **Indians have higher blood pressure** in the evenings than in mornings.
- The study was conducted on **18918** participants, both men and women, across **355 cities** in **15 states**.

IAF receives 8 US-made 'Apache AH-64E' fighter helicopters

■ The Indian Air Force (IAF) has received 8 US-made 'Apache AH-64E' fighter helicopters from US (United



States)aerospace major Boeing at Airforce Station, Pathankot, Punjab. Air Chief Marshal B. S. Dhanoa was the chief guest of the ceremony held at the Pathankot Station.

- Drones: Drone is a flying robot which is remote-controlled. It is allowed to work in India by DGCA in October 2017.

■ To keep ghost traders at bay, Aadhaar authentication or physical verification will be made mandatory for new traders coming under the Goods and Services Tax regime from January 2020, according to the GST Network. **Sushil Kumar Modi**, who heads the Group of Ministers of the GST Network announced Aadhaar authentication of new dealers.

IIT Kharagpur to set up Sophisticated Analytical and Technical Help Institute (SATHI)

- IIT Kharagpur selected for setting up a **Sophisticated Analytical and Technical Help Institute (SATHI)** by Department of Science and Technology. Aim of SATHI is to extend help to the academic institutes in the neighbouring regions.
- IIT Delhi has also been selected to develop a **SATHI Centre** as a shared technology infrastructure that can be used by different parties.
- The scheme is a brain-child of the **Department of Science and Technology (DST) of the Central Government.** The grant amount sanctioned for **IIT Kharagpur** under this scheme will be disbursed to the institute over three financial years commencing from **2019-20**.

About SATHI

- ▶ The SATHI Grant Scheme, the Central Government intends to develop state-of-the-art science and technology infrastructure facilities across the country.
- ▶ The **SATHI** scheme intends to help build advance technology infrastructure that can also be used by start-ups and manufacturing units to conduct research with the help of sophisticated instruments which they cannot fund themselves.

World's first website with 32 crore pages

- Delhi resident **Amit Sharma**, owner of world's largest static website Cheapflightsall.com, has developed it only in 23 days and has approximately 32 crores of pages.
- Cheapflightsall.com has approximately 32 crores of pages with size of the website equivalent to 5 TB. Amit has developed this website only in 23 days which connects 159 countries with every intercity wherever airport or flight route is available.



Scientists from BSI discovered two new species of ginger from Nagaland

- Scientists from the Botanical Survey of India (BSI) discovered 2 new species of ginger- Zingiber namely Zingiber perenense and Zingiber dimapurense from Nagaland.
- The article on Zingiber dimapurense was published in NeBIO, an International Journal of Environment and Biodiversity and the article on Zingiber perenense was published in The Thailand Natural History Museum Journal.
- Zingiber perenense was discovered from the **Peren district of Nagaland.** It's the leafy shoots reach up to 70 cm and the specimens were collected in September 2017, when botanists were working on the 'State flora of Nagaland' in the Peren district.

K2-18b: Water discovered for the first time in atmosphere of habitable exoplanet

Astronomers have found water for the first time in atmosphere of habitable exoplanet- K2-18b which orbits in its star's "habitable zone". The article was published in the scientific journal Nature Astronomy and the lead scientist of the research is Prof Giovanna Tinetti of University College London (UCL), United Kingdom.

About Exoplanet:

The planets that are beyond the solar system are called exoplanets. The first exoplanet was discovered in 1992, orbiting a pulsar (a neutron star that emits electromagnetic radiation). They are believed to resemble Jupiter or Neptune.

ISRO loses contact with Moon lander "Vikram"

- 1. Indian Space Research Organisation has announced that it lost contact with the Moon lander "Vikram" which was scheduled to land on the moon between 1.30 a.m. and 2.30 a.m. (IST).
- 2. Further the roll out of the rover "Pragyan" was scheduled between 5.30 a.m and 6.30 a.m. Lander "Vikram" started its descent at about 1.38 a.m. from an altitude of 30 km at a velocity of 1,680 metres per second, but lost its communication with the Chandrayaan-2 Orbiter when it was at an altitude of 2.1 Km from Moon's surface.
- 3. ISRO launched the Chandrayaan-2 (on July 22, 2019) into the space from India's heavy lift rocket Geosynchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle-Mark III (GSLV Mk III). The Chandrayaan-2 spacecraft comprised three segments: the Orbiter, lander 'Vikram' and rover 'Pragyan'.

IIT Madras finds an eco-friendly way to degrade plastics

- Three years ago researchers from the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras observed silver slowly dissolving in a glucose solution when heated to 70 degree.
- 2. The team has demonstrated an environment-friendly strategy to degrade the chemically inert and physically stable plastic fluoro-polymer polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE) of which Teflon is made.
- 3. All that is required to degrade the fluoropolymer into molecules is continuous stirring of it in water containing 1,000 ppm glucose and metal ions for about 15 days at 70 degree C.

Survey of India to deploy 300 Drones for Mapping Country

 India's oldest scientific department, the Survey of India (Sol) historically tasked with mapping the country



- will for the first time rely on drones to map the country.
- A consequence of the mapping will be creating high resolution maps of land in villages facilitating the digitisation of land titles in villages.

Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd Delivered Second Scorpene Submarine "KHANDERI" To Indian Navy In Mumbai

- India's biggest warship builder Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd(MDL), delivered the second of the 6 scorpene class submarine, Indian Naval Ship (INS) khanderi to the Indian Navy in Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- The submarine **Khanderi** is named after wide snouted Sawfish, which is a **deadly** sea predator of the Indian Ocean.

ISRO and DRDO join Hands for 'Gaganyaan' Mission

■ The Space agency of the Government of India (GoI), Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) and the Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to develop human-centric systems for the 'Gaganyaan' project.

Key Words

- ▶ DRDO is committed to provide all necessary support to ISRO for manned space mission. ISRO plans to demonstrate man's ability to reach space before the completion of 75 years of India's independence in 2022.
- ► Gaganyaan: It is a proposed manned space mission by Government of India (GoI).
- ► This will be India's first manned mission, to be launched by 2022.
- ► On August 15, 2018, the mission was announced by Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi in his independence day speech from Red Fort.

Protodontopteryx ruthae - World's oldest Bird Species is Discovered in Waipara, New Zealand

- Scientists from the Canterbury Museum (England) have discovered the world's oldest bird species' fossils in Waipara, New zealand that lived 62 million years ago.
- It was a sea bird, and is named as Protodontopteryx ruthae with its discovery details mentioned in the journal 'Palaeontology'.



The bird which was smallest in size of its family, maintained size of an average sea gull while its descendants had wingspans **more than five metres**.

Defence Ministry signed ₹ 5,500 crore contract for additional indigenous Akash SAM systems and LCAs

- The Kolkata centre would be the hub for research on antibiotic resistance not only for the country but for the entire South Asia.
- The centre was jointly inaugurated by the ICMR, in association with the U.S. Consulate of Kolkata and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.



312 Sikhs of Indian origin from 'adverse list': Reports

- At least 312 Indian-origin Sikhs living in foreign countries have been removed from a Ministry of Home Affairs "adverse list", enabling them to apply for Indian visa and visit the country
- In future, Sikhs mentioned in the list could eventually apply for registration as Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) after they have applied for and held normal visa for a period of two years.
- In the 1980s, when Sikh militancy was at its peak, many members of the community in India and abroad were influenced by anti-India propaganda.
- Some Sikhs fled India to escape the authorities, acquired foreign nationality and took asylum outside the country. They were placed in the adverse list till 2016, making them ineligible to avail visa services to visit India.

National Green Tribunal forms committee to stop illegal groundwater extraction

■ Expressing concern over **depleting groundwater** levels, the National Green Tribunal (NGT) has set up a committee to formulate steps required to prevent illegal extraction of groundwater.

Key Highlights of Committee

- ▶ A bench headed by NGT Chairperson Justice Adarsh Kumar Goel directed the committee to evolve a robust mechanism for ensuring that groundwater is not illegally extracted and to monitor manning and functioning of Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA).
- ► Committee may look into the reports already submitted. The report may be furnished within 2 months by e-mail.

Names of 312 Indian-origin Sikhs were removed from a list that prevented them from getting Indian visa



 Based on intelligence inputs, the Home Ministry was maintaining an "adverse list" of Sikh persons living abroad The list was prepared after the Sikh riots in 1984, following which many young men from the community took part in secessionist movements

 Indian missions abroad used to decline visa to persons on the list. Many in the list, live in the U.S., the U.K., Germany and Canada – in most cases with foreign citizenship

'Gangs of Wasseypur' became the only Indian film in "The Guardian" list of 100 Best Films of the 21st century

 - ▶ Odisha and Telangana have not implemented the scheme.
 - ► Its implementation is monitored by the central and state governments through a web-based **software application** named **PMMVY-CAS**.

About PMMVY:

- ► It is a flagship scheme of the Government for **Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers (PW&LM).**
- ► It is a direct benefit transfer (DBT) scheme under which PW&LM receive a cash benefit of Rs. 5,000 in three instalments on fulfilling certain conditions.
- ► The eligible beneficiaries also receive cash incentive under **Janani Suraksha Yojana** (**JSY**). Thus, on an average, a woman gets **Rs. 6,000**.



HRD Ministry Announces National Educational Alliance For Technology (NEAT) Scheme For Higher Education Learning Outcomes

- The Union Ministry of Human Resource & Development (MHRD) has announced a new scheme named National Educational Alliance for Technology (NEAT) for better learning outcomes in higher education and is expected to be operational in early November 2019.
- The main objective of this scheme is to use **Artificial Intelligence (AI)** in making **personalized learning** and will be developed through **Public-private partnership (PPP)** model.
- AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education) will be the implementing agency of this scheme.
- EdTech (Education Technology) companies will be responsible for managing the learners' registration though the NEAT portal.

Indian Army Conducted 'Chang Thang' Exercise In Eastern Ladakh

- The Indian army conducted massive integrated exercise named 'Chang Thang' in the Eastern Ladakh region bordering China in a very high-altitude area in order to test and improve its capabilities in war fighting.
- The exercise involved all the arms of the **Indian army** like T-72 tanks, artillery guns and helicopters, Unmanned Aerial Vehicles etc.

Reason for the exercise:

- ▶ The exercise which happened first time in the region came from the backdrop of a scuffle (a short struggle/fight) between India and Chinese troops on the northern bank of Pangong Tso (Tso denotes lake) in Ladakh amid China.
- ▶ Him Vijay: The army will also conduct another major exercise **Him Vijay in next two months.** The exercise will be conducted in **Arunachal Pradesh** to test new fighting formation, Integrated Battle Group in mountain warfare.

IAF Chief B S Dhanoa restored Ambala-based 17th Squadron 'Golden Arrows' to operate first unit of Rafale aircraft

■ Indian Air Force (IAF) chief Air Chief Marshal **Birender Singh Dhanoa** restored Air Force Station (AFS) **Ambala**-based **17**th Squadron **'Golden Arrows'** which will be committed to operate India-Pakistan frontier. It will be the first unit to operate the newly-acquired Rafale aircraft.

AP govt forms expert panel to review Amaravati and other developmental plans

■ The Andhra Pradesh government on set up a five-member committee, comprising urban planning experts, to review developmental plans initiated so far (by the government) and suggest a comprehensive strategy for the all-round development of the state, including the upcoming capital Amaravati. Rajnath Singh becomes first Indian defence minister to fly in homebuilt LCA Tejas from the HAL Airport, Bengaluru

- Defence Minister of India, Mr Rajnath Singh became the first Indian defence minister to fly (for 30 minutes) in the indigenously-built light combat aircraft (LCA) Tejas from the Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) Airport, also known as Hindustan Airport, in Bengaluru, Karnataka.
- Tejas is the smallest lightweight, multirole, single-engine tactical fighter aircraft.

NTPC Ltd to set up 5 GW solar parkbiggest in the country, in Gujarat

- NTPC ltd (formerly National Thermal Power Corporation Limited) announced to set up a 5GW (gigawatt) solar national park in Gujarat and is also expected to be the biggest in the country.
- This solar park is part of NTPC's aim to build 32GW renewable energy by 2032 and reduce the energy mix of fossil fuels from 96% to 70%
- The Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has set a target of producing **175GW** of renewable capacity by **2022**.

- IBM aims to train 10,000 ITI faculty members across India. The program will be of one year duration and will have 14 instructors at 7 locations with over 200 workshops.

Narendra Modi launches RuPay card in UAE

- Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi has launched the RuPay card, making the UAE the first country in the Middle East to initiate the Indian indigenous system of electronic payment. RuPay card scheme was launched in 2012 to fulfil the Reserve Bank of India's vision to have a domestic, open and multilateral system of payments.
- RuPay facilitates electronic payment at all Indian banks and financial institutions.
 India has already launched the RuPay card in Singapore and Bhutan.

1st India-Ghana Foreign Office Consultations held in New Delhi

■ The first ever India-Ghana Foreign Office Consultations was held in New Delhi. The Indian delegation was led by Shri. T.S. Tirumurti, Secretary (Economic Relations) while the Ghanaian delegation was led by Charles Owiredu, Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs and Regional Integration.

US Launches New Command for Space Warfare

- USA formally established a new Pentagon command for space warfare.
- Space Com will oversee US military and intelligence efforts in space, including defending American satellites and supporting troops.
- The role of Space Command is to conduct operations, such as enabling satellite-based navigation and communications in the field and providing warning of missile launches abroad.
- The renewed focus on space as a military domain reflects concern about the vulnerability of US satellites, both military and commercial, that are critical to US interests and are potentially susceptible to disruption by Chinese and Russian anti-satellite weapons.
- According to the Pentagon, the Space Force as the sixth branch of the United States military, to go along with the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines and Coast Guard.

- The 66 governments are joined by 10 regions, 102 cities, 93 businesses and 12 investors all committed to net zero CO₂ emissions by 2050 Around 60 world leaders have convened for the UN Climate Action Summit in New York.
- The UN estimates that the world needs to increase its current efforts five-fold to contain climate change to the levels dictated by science a rise of **1.5 degrees**Celsius by the year 2100 to avoid escalating climate damage.
- Countries announced commitments to carbon reduction targets under the Paris Agreement of 2015, and are now expected to update their nationally determined contributions by 2020.

India with 17.5million international migrants, tops country of origin of international migrants in 2019 by UN's 'International Migrant Stock 2019' report

- **Benefits:** The GI tagging will help rural artisans & highly skilled weavers, who possess unique knowledge of traditional practices and methods. They can make & market their products domestically and internationally.

New textile processing cluster at Kariapatti

- The work has started for Southern District Textile Processing Cluster Private Limited and New Industrial Park at Kariapatti (Tamil Nadu).
- The expected investment in this park is about **Rs. 200 crore.**

T.N. bans sex reassignment surgeries in children

- Madras High Court order, the State government has banned performance of sex reassignment surgeries on intersex infants and children, except to overcome life-threatening situations.
- The decision has come as a shot in the arm for intersex activists who had been pleading with the Central and State governments for long against imposition of the parents.

Tamilnadu Plans Underwater Archaeological Excavations

- State Archaeology Department is planning to carry out underwater excavations in areas of the port cities and towns that existed during the Sangam and medieval periods.
- The objective is to probe trade contacts with Greek, Roman and Arab merchants. The last time the State Archaeology Department took up underwater excavations was in the 1990s, off Poompuhar.

Rare tarantula sighted in Villupuram district

- Researchers have sighted a critically endangered species of tarantula for the first time beyond its known habitat in the Eastern Ghats.
- The spider belonging to the genus Poecilotheria, commonly known as the Peacock Parachute Spider or Gooty Tarantula, was spotted by a team of researchers of the Puducherry-based Indigenous Biodiversity Foundation (IBF) in the Pakkamalai Reserve Forests near Gingee in Villupuram district.

India's 1st FinTech centre of excellence - "Fin Blue" in Tamil Nadu

■ Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) in association with Electronics Corporation of Tamil Nadu (ELCOT) has officially set up a 'Centre of Excellence in FinTech' with a cost of over ₹ 23 crore in Chennai, Tamil Nadu. It is first of its kind in India and is named 'FinBlue'.

5 railway stations in Salem division bag ISO-14001 certification

King's College Hospital of London may set up branches in T.N.

- The Tamil Nadu government has signed a memorandum of understanding with King's College Hospital, London, to establish branches in the State.
- The agreement was signed in the presence of Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami confirmed that the State government would help facilitate the setting up of such hospitals in Tamil Nadu.

Ayushman Bharat Signs MoU With Ola To Extend Healthcare Benefits For Its Driver-partners And Families

- The Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) scheme which is the world's largest healthcare scheme signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with mobility platform Ola whereby the scheme would provide health insurance to 2 million driver partners of Ola.
 - ► The first phase of this partnership will be rolled out in **Delhi** as a pilot project after which it will be extended to other states.
 - ► AB card: All Ola employees and eligible driver partners can avail the AB card at a cost of Rs.30.

Centre Introduced a New Scheme Named 'Assistance for Deep Sea Fishing' for the Fishermen in Tamil Nadu

■ Union Minister for Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries Giriraj Singh notified that a new scheme named 'Assistance for Deep Sea Fishing' was introduced for fishermen in Tamil Nadu with an objective to make a 'Blue Revolution'. Rs 300 crore was released for this scheme by the union government.

CM unveils 'Digital Accelerator' to assist investors

- Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami inaugurated a 'Digital Accelerator' to assist entrepreneurs.
- The accelerator, through which the State will allocate 10% of the funds required for entrepreneurs to start business in **Tamil Nadu**, will be set in motion which assistance from the **American Tamil Entrepreneur Association**.
- The Tamil Nadu government, which had earlier signed 16 memorandam of understanding (MoU) in the U.S., inked an additional 19 MoUs for investments to the tune of ₹ 2,300 crore.

Rooftop Solar Attractiveness Index

- Tamil Nadu has been ranked tenth in the State Rooftop Solar Attractiveness Index (SARAL).

CDRI is proposed to be launched at United Nations (UN) Climate Action Summit scheduled to be held in New York, US on 23rd September 2019.

Tamil Nadu officials to participate in safety workshop in Australia

- The **Tamil Nadu government** has sent a team of senior bureaucrats to Australia for studying highway safety using **Safe System Solution** and emulate the best practices back home.
- The programme is part of the memorandum of understanding signed by the State government with VicRoads and Highways Department, Australia.

Karnataka has cleared T.N. quota of water

- Karnataka Chief Minister B.S. Yediyurappa announced the State had cleared the quota of water to be shared with Tamil Nadu in the last one month by discharging the Cauvery and Kabini waters.
- He was offering 'bagina' to the Cauvery at the Krishnaraja Sagar (KRS), near Srirangapatna, which has attained the full-reservoir level.
- The surplus waters were discharged and hence the neighbouring State received its quota in the recent days.

ANPR cameras installed on accidentprone ECR

- Greater Chennai Police have fixed eight Automatic Number Plate Reading (ANPR) cameras at Muttukadu to keep a database of vehicles entering and exiting the city via ECR.
- Police commissioner **AK Viswanathan** launched the functioning of the cameras by inaugurating a peripheral police station, which will also function as a control room for ANPR cameras, at **Muttukadu**.
- He also launched 209 CCTV cameras at Neelankarai and Kanathur police station jurisdictions as part of the police's Third Eye project.

T.N. to form panel to look at treatment of LSD at lower cost

- The Tamil Nadu government has informed the Madras High Court that it will constitute in the near future a committee to have consultations with doctors dealing in different branches of medicine including Ayurveda, Homeopathy and Allopathy to discuss whether a plan for management of Lysosomal Storage Disorders can be evolved at a lower cost.
- Bench comprising Justice Vineet Kothari and Justice C.V. Karthikeyan, Advocate General Vijay Narayan informed the court that there were 132 identified patients in the State suffering from the disease and a discussion would be held to see if this can be managed in an appropriate manner with the pool of funds of the State and the Union government.
