

1.2 Defence, National Security and Terrorism

CENTRE HAS APPROVED DEEP OCEAN MISSION

- Centre has approved the Union Ministry of Earth Sciences' Deep Ocean Mission (DOM). The project plans to explore the deepest recesses of the ocean. It is a five year project. The cost estimated for the project is Rs.8,000 crore.
- DOM will commence from October 31, 2019. A blueprint of the program was unveiled by the Ministry last July.
- One of the proposals is offshore desalination plant that will work with tidal energy. The projects also proposes to develop a submersible vehicle that can go to a depth of at least 6,000 metres with three people on board.

Aim:

- The main objective of the mission is to explore the deep ocean. The mission aims to look for metals and minerals.
- India has been allotted a site of 75,000 sq. km. in the Central Indian Ocean Basin (CIOB) by the UN International Sea Bed Authority for exploitation of polymetallic nodules (PMN).

IRAN LAUNCHED 3 NEW PRECISION-GUIDED MISSILES "YASIN", "BALABAN" & "GHAEM"

■ Iran unveiled three precision-guided missiles "Yasin", "Balaban" and a new series of "Ghaem" in Tehran. The airto-air missiles were developed jointly by the Ministry of Defence of Iran and Sa Iran, also known as Iran Electronics Industries.

RUSSIA LAUNCHES FLOATING NUCLEAR REACTOR IN ARCTIC

- Russia launched the world's first floating nuclear reactor. The vessel weighs 21,000 tons and has two reactors with a capacity of 35 megawatts each.
- This reactor loaded with nuclear fuel, the **Akademik Lomonosov** left the Arctic port of Murmansk to begin its 5,000 kilometres (3,000-mile) voyage to Pevek in northeastern Siberia.

INDIAN ARMY LAUNCHES 'MISSION REACH OUT' IN JAMMU AND KASHMIR

■ The Indian Army launched "Mission Reach Out" in Jammu to ensure basic necessities and essential services are available in the region post the dilution of the provisions of Article 370 and reorganisation of Jammu and Kashmir.

Key Words

'Mission Reach Out'

These are mobile medical care units with essential medicines and lady medical officers, wherever necessary, providing water in locations where the supply was disrupted, provision of essentials, including rations, assistance in transportation of patients to hospitals, facilitating people to speak to their near and dear ones through Army exchange and creating a safe environment for ATMs, banks and hospitals to function.

U.S. COAST GUARD EXPANDED ITS OPERATIONS IN WESTERN PACIFIC

- The Coast Guard discussed on providing Military Training Assistance and Law Enforcement training teams.
- The operation is a 30-day deployment of a 225-foot Juniper-class buoy tender and the Fast Response Cutter USCGC Joseph Gerczak (WPC-1126) to partner with Pacific island nations.
- The exercise, Stratton will head to India to conduct port visits and engagements and then move on to the Pacific islands.

CABINET APPROVES ISRO TECHNICAL LIAISON UNIT AT MOSCOW

- Cabinet has given nod to the setting up of ISRO Technical Liaison Unit (ITLU) at Moscow in Russia.
- Information and Broadcasting Minister Prakash Javadekar recited, the unit will collaborate with Space agencies and industries in Russia and neighbouring countries for mutually synergetic outcomes.

NEW PANEL TO REVIEW POLICY ON DEFENCE ACQUISITIONS

- **Defence Minister Rajnath Singh** has approved setting up of a committee to review the current policy of acquisition of weapons for defence forces in view of new security challenges.
- The committee will be constituted at a time when defence forces have been complaining of delay in getting modern weapons due to procedure delays and neighbouring country China massively expanding its military, Navy and Air Force.
- The committee under **Director General** (**Acquisition**) Apurva chandra will revise the procedures to ensure that forces get weapons seamlessly and to ensure life cycle support for the acquired weapon system.
- The committee has been set as **Defence Procurement Procedure 2016** was due for revision. The committee will get six months to submit its recommendations.

FIRST PILOT OF IAF TO PERFORM WINGSUIT SKYDIVE JUMP

Indian Air Force (IAF) Wing Commander Tarun Chaudhri created history by becoming the first pilot to perform a wingsuit skydive jump. He jumped 8500 feet from the Mi-17 V5 helicopter at Air Force Station in Jodhpur, Rajasthan during the Kargil Diwas day celebrations.

Key Words

- 1. This is the first time when a pilot of the IAF jumped the wingsuit skydive with the same helicopter, which he has just flown.
- 2. Mi-17 V5: It is a military transport variant, equipped with modern avionics and glass cockpit instrumentation.

INDIA CONDUCTED 1ST EVER SIMULATED SPACE WAR EXERCISE," INDSPACEEX"

■ The three armed forces of India (Army, Navy, and Air Force) conducted 1st ever simulated space warfare exercise called "IndSpaceEx" on July 25, 26, 2019. The 2-day exercise aims to assess requisite space and counter-space capabilities that are needed by India It will also help India



that are needed by India. It will also help India to better grasp strategic challenges in space that need to be handled.

Key points:

■ IndSpaceEx: It code-named as 'table-top war-game' with DRDO(Defence Research and Development Organisation), academia and think tanks took part in it. It helps to assess capabilities India needs to ensure that it can protect its space assets. It will also help to better understand possible challenges in space warfare and a major threat to India's national security interest.

ASAT:

 Anti Satellite(A-Sat) Weapon has a capacity to incapacitate or destroy satellites for strategic military purposes. Only the United States, Russia, China, and India have demonstrated this capability successfully. ASATs are of two types, Kinetic and Non-Kinetic.

UNDERWATER MILITARY VEHICLES MUSEUM

- **Jordan** has unveiled its 1st Underwater Military Museum on the bed of **Red Sea off the coast of Aqaba**.
- The Museum features 19 decommissioned pieces of military hardware, submerged at depths up to 92 feet.
- This unique tourism experience is expected to attract more tourists to the already popular Aqaba diving resort.

Key Words

About Red Sea

- ► The Red Sea is a seawater inlet of the Indian Ocean, lying between Africa and Asia.
- ► It is designated as a Global 200 eco-region by WWF (World Wide Fund for Nature).
- ► Over half of the eco-regions in the Global 200 are rated endangered.

INDIA WILL NOW HAVE CHIEF OF DEFENCE STAFF

- In a major announcement for the three armed forces of India, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that the country will now have a post of Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) that will integrate the operations of the three forces the Indian Army, the Indian Navy and the Indian Air Force.
- Prime Minister Modi said the armed forces are pride of every India. He said in the changing time, there is a need for the forces to sharpen coordination.

DRDO HANDS OVER DESIGN OF MOBILE METALLIC RAMP TO ARMY

 Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) handed over the design of Mobile Metallic Ramp (MMR) to the Indian Army at an event held at DRDO Bhawan here.

Key Words

About Mobile Metallic Ramp

- ▶ With load bearing capacity of 70 metric ton (MT), the MMR has been designed and developed by DRDO's premier research laboratory, Centre for Fire. Explosive and **Environment** Safety (CFEES) on the requirements projected by Army for reducing the Strategic Mobility time of mobilizing Armoured Fighting Vehicles.
- ► The ramp will provide the strategic mobility for Armoured and Mechanized units and formations of the Army. It is portable, modular in design, which can be easily assembled or disassembled.

14TH EDITION OF KONKAN-19 BILATERAL EXERCISE

■ The Indian Navy's stealth frigate, INS Tarkash, participated in the 14th Edition of KONKAN-19 series of annual bilateral exercises between Indian Navy and Royal Navy of Britain off the South Coast of the United Kingdom (UK).

Key Words

- 1. It exercised with the Royal Navy's Daring Class Destroyer, HMS Defender with integral helicopter Wildcat.
- 2. KONKAN-19 involved Gunnery Shoots, Manoeuvres, Cross Deck Flying, ASW Screening and Air Defence exercise.
- 3. The thrust of the KONKAN-19 was on Anti-Air Warfare, Anti-Surface Warfare, Flying Operations and Seamanship Evolutions of varying complexities.

■ 5th International Dharma-Dhamma conference is being held Rajgir International Convention Centre in Rajgir, Bihar from 27-28 July 2019. The conference was inaugurated Union Minister of State Kiren Rijiju who is also the Chief Guest of Conference. It is being hosted by Rajgir for 2nd time.

About 5th International Dharma-Dhamma conference

- Objective: To address people about terror, violence and global warming prevalent in world. The 2-day conference also addresses subjects of Sat-Chit-Ananda and Nirvana Dharma-Dhamma Tradition which are pivotal topics of Buddhism.
- Organised by: Nalanda University (NU) in collaboration with New Delhi's Centre for study of Religion and Society-India Foundation (CSRS-IF).

INDIA MOVES UP 5 RANKS TO BECOME 52ND MOST INNOVATIVE COUNTRY

- India has improved its ranking on the Global Innovation Index (GII) 2019 to reach the 52nd position, up five places since last year's rankings.
- The country has improved "in four of the seven GII pillars", namely Institutions, Human capital and research, Infrastructure Market sophistication, Business sophistication, Knowledge and technology outputs and Creative outputs.
- In the past five years, India has steadily moved up the charts from rank 81 in 2015.

G7 CONFERENCE

President Donald Trump expressed his support for reinstating Russia into the G7 and French President Emmanuel Macron has agreed with the President that Russia should be invited to the G7 conference in 2020.

Key Words

About G7 Conference:

- ➤ The Group of Seven (G7) is a group consisting of Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, the United Kingdom, and the United States. These countries, with the seven largest IMF-described advanced economies in the world, represent 58% of the global net wealth .
- ▶ The G7 countries also represent more than 46% of the global gross domestic product(GDP) based on nominal values, and more than 32% of the global GDP based on purchasing power parity.

INDIA IS THE 46TH HIGHEST RISK COUNTRY IN THE WORLD: WATER STRESS INDEX

- According to the Water Stress Index, formulated by London-based risk analytics firm Verisk Maplecroft, India is the 46th highest risk country in the world.
- It measured the water consumption rates of households, industries and farm sectors and the available resources in rivers, lakes and streams and plotted the index with projected population growth trends to rank the cities facing the biggest threat to their water resources. Chennai is the "tip of the iceberg" for India's water stressed cities.

SANIA MIRZA WILL CO-CHAIR WEF'S INDIA ECONOMIC SUMMIT 2019



■ The World Economic Forum (WEF) in collaboration with Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) will organize 2-day India Economic Summit 2019 scheduled to be held in New Delhi from October 3 – 4, 2019 with the aim of promoting strong collaboration between South Asia and ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) nations. The theme of the event will be 'Innovating for India: Strengthening South Asia, Impacting the World'.

ISRO TO BUILD 2ND DEDICATED SATELLITE FOR NAVY

- The Navy will get its second dedicated communication-cum-surveillance satellite by 2022 to keep tabs on the critical Indian Ocean Region and network all its warships, submarines and aircraft with operational centres ashore.
- Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and Navy inked a Rs. 1589 crore contract last month for the new satellite called Gsat-7R, which will supplement the orbiting Gsat-7 or "Rukmini" geostationary naval satellite launched in August 2013.

THE INDIAN NAVY IS TO HOST NAVAL EXERCISE MILAN IN MARCH 2020 IN VIZAG

 The Indian Navy is to host the multilateral naval exercise named 'MILAN' at Visakhapatnam for the year 2020 in the month of March.

Key Words

- MILAN is a biennial exercise which was first started in 1995. Until last year the exercise was held at Andaman and Nicobar Command (ANC).
- 2. For the first time, this exercise is to be conducted in the mainland of ENC, Vishakapatnam.

TWO-DAY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON TEACHER EDUCATION BY NCTE HELD IN NEW DELHI

■ A 2 day International Conference titled "Journey of Teacher Education: Local to Global" was inaugurated by the Union Minister of Human Resource Development Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank'in New Delhi. It was organized by the National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE) as part of the silver jubilee celebration of its establishment in 1995 (August 17).

Key Words

 Ministry of Human Resource Development will launch the world's biggest project for teacher training named NISHTHA (National Initiative on School Teachers Head Holistic Advancement) on August 22, 2019.

5[™] MEETING OF BRICS MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT HELD IN SAO PAULO, BRAZIL

■ 5th BRICS Minister of Environment Meeting held in Sao Paulo, Brazil, which was preceded by the 2-day meeting of BRICS Joint Working Group on Environment. The Indian delegation was led by Union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Prakash Javadekar.

Key Words

About BRICS

- Acronym BRICS, refers to 5 major emerging economies include Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa.
- Originally as per term 'BRIC' coined in 2001 by then-chairman of Goldman Sachs Asset Management, Jim O'Neill, South Africa was not a part of this grouping. It joined in 2010 and thereafter these countries have been collectively referred to as BRICS nations.

S JAISHANKAR TO VISIT BANGKOK FOR EAST ASIA SUMMIT

- Foreign minister S. Jaishankar will travel to Bangkok for the East Asia Summit (EAS) and ASEAN Regional Forum (ARF) to be held amid heightened tensions prevailing between China and Vietnam in the South China Sea region following aggression by the Chinese coast guard.
- The visit will be an opportunity to discuss newly announced ASEAN Outlook for Indo-Pacific and explore synergy between the two sides on the Indo-Pacific construct.
- He is expected to underline India's cardinal principle of freedom of navigation in seas and rules based international order.

MICROPLASTICS IN WATER: NO PROOF FOR IT'S HARMFUL

- Micro plastics are increasingly found in drinking water, but there is no evidence so far that this poses a risk to humans, according to a new assessment by the World Health Organization.
- United Nations body warned against complacency because more research is needed to fully understand how plastic spreads into the environment and works its way through human bodies.
- Plastic production has grown exponentially in recent decades and is predicted to double again by 2025.

ONE- FOURTH OF THE WORLD'S POPULATION IS FACING EXTREME WATER CRISIS

- The World Resources Institute's (WRI) President and CEO (Chief Executive Officer) Andrew Steer released report on Aqueduct Water Risk Atlas that about 17 countries in the world which holds a quarter of the earth's population is facing extremely high water crisis.
 - ▶ India is one among those 17 countries facing extremely high water stress.
 - ▶ All these countries are close to "Day Zero".

Key Words

- The WRI ranked **189 countries** and their respective states and union territories based on water stress, drought risk and riverine flood risk.
- It is expected that by 2030 the number of cities in the extremely high stress category will increase to 45 with nearly 470million people.
- India's rank: India is ranked at 13th place among the top 17 countries. India has a population thrice more than that of the other 16 countries.

UNISA; EXPERTS CALL FOR LOCAL LAWS SUPPORTING

TREATY

- Indian Government has signed the **United Nations Convention on International Settlement Agreements (UNISA).**
- The **United Nations General Assembly adopted the United Nations Convention** on International Settlement Agreements Resulting from Mediation in 2018.
- The UN has authorized that the Convention will be open for signature in Singapore and will be known as the "Singapore Convention on Mediation".
- The Convention provides a uniform and efficient framework for the enforcement of international settlement agreements resulting from mediation and for allowing parties to invoke such agreements.







These 2400 houses are in addition to 60000 accommodations built under Indian Housing Project meant for war affected people in north and east Sri Lanka and estate workers in planttion areas of the country.

PAKISTAN STOPS SAMJHAUTA EXPRESS AT WAGAH BORDER

- Pakistan stopped Samjhauta Express on their side at Wagah border citing security concerns.
- The passengers were stranded briefly before Indian crew members and guard escorted the train back to **Attari**.
- The train service was started on **July 22, 1976** under the **Simla Agreement that settled the 1971** war between the two nations.
- On the Indian side, the train runs from **Delhi to Attari** and from Lahore to **Wagah** on the Pakistan side.

- Chinese telecom giant Huawei launched its own operating system called HarmonyOS or HongMeng in Chinese. It was revealed by Richard Yu, head of Huawei's consumer business at a press conference in Dongguan.
- This unveiling comes at a time when telecom giant is facing threat of losing access to Google's Android platform, amid escalating U.S.-China trade tensions, although Huawei has reportedly been working on its own operating system since 2012.

Narrendra Modi has approved a p p o i n t m e n t of Rajiv Gauba, as India's new Cabinet Secretary for a tenure of two years. His term will start from 30 August 2019 or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

2.1 Latest Court Verdicts

SC ORDERS SETTING UP OF SPECIAL COURTS IN DISTRICTS WITH OVER 100 PENDING POCSO CASES

- The Supreme Court directed the setting up of special courts in each district across the country that had over a 100 cases of child abuse and sexual assault pending trial under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.
- A Bench led by the Chief Justice of India directed the courts to be set up within 60 days.

NOTICE TO T.N., KARNATAKA ON 10% EWS RESERVATION

- The Supreme court asked the **Tamil Nadu** and **Karnataka** governments to reply to a petition seeking that they implement the **10**% **quota for economically weaker sections (EWS)**, in addition to the existing reservation.
- A Bench of justices S.A.Bobde and B.R.Gavai issued notice to both the States on the plea claiming that all the other State governments have implemented the 103rd Constitutional Amendment Act, 2019, which granted 10% reservation to the EWS category in government jobs and educational institutions.

WORK ON SPECIAL COURTS TO DEAL WITH RAPE CASES LIKELY TO BEGIN ON OCTOBER 2

- The work on setting up over 1,000 fasttrack, special courts across the country to deal with pending cases of rape is likely to begin on October 2.
- The Department of Justice in the Law Ministry had proposed to set up 1,023 fast-track courts at a total budget of ₹ 767.25 crore.
- The central support of ₹ 474 crore for one year will be funded under the Nirbhaya Fund.
- The fund was announced by the Centre in 2013 after the December 16, 2012 gangrape and murder of a student in Delhi, to support the initiatives of governments and NGOs working towards safety of women.



CABINET APPROVES INCREASING STRENGTH OF SUPREME COURT JUDGES FROM 31 TO 34

- At present, the sanctioned strength of the apex court is **31**.
- The **Supreme Court (Number of Judges) Act, 1956** was last amended in 2009 to increase the judges' strength from **25 to 30 (excluding the CJI).**
- The decision of the Cabinet came days after **Chief Justice of India Ranjan Gogoi** wrote to **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** to increase the number of judges in the top court.
- In 1988, the **judge** strength of the **SC was increased from 18 to 26**, and then again in 2009, it was increased to **31**, including the CJI.

2.2 Political parties and Political system in India

PARLIAMENT PASSES COMPANIES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2019

■ Parliament passed Companies (Amendment) Bill, 2019 aimed at tightening Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) compliance and ensuring stricter action for noncompliance of the company law regulations. It amends the **Companies Act, 2013.** It was first passed by Lok Sabha on July 26, 2019 and then by Rajya Sabha by July 30, 2019.

THE RIGHT TO INFORMATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2019

- Under the **RTI Act, 2005**, Public Authorities are required to make disclosures on various aspects of their structure and functioning.
- This includes: (i) disclosure on their organisation, functions, and structure, (ii) powers and duties of its officers and employees, and (iii) financial information.



INDIA TO OFFER E-TOURIST VISA FEE BASED ON TOURIST FOOTFALL

- With the aim of attracting more foreign travellers to the country, it has been proposed to reduce the e-visa fee while also offering the option of a short-term as well as long-term tourist e-visa.
- The **Tourism Ministry** has proposed to introduce a short duration e-visa for tourists with one month validity at a charge of \$ 25. This will be applicable during peak tourism season between July and March. To attract more tourists during the lean period, the visa fee is proposed to be reduced to as low as \$10 between April to June.
- The information was given by Tourism minister Prahlad Patel.

PARLIAMENT PASSES MUSLIM WOMEN (PROTECTION OF RIGHTS ON MARRIAGE BILL, 2019

■ Parliament passed the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill 2019 or Triple Talaq Bill after it was approved by Rajya Sabha. It replaces ordinance promulgated on February 21, 2019. It aims to declares practice of instant triple talaq void and illegal by making it cognizable penal offence.

Key Words

Salient Features of Bill

- **Definitions:** It defines talaq or any other similar form of talaq pronounced by Muslim man resulting in instant and irrevocable divorce. It defines Talaq-e-biddat as practice under Muslim personal laws, as pronouncement of word 'talaq' by Muslim husband thrice in one sitting to his wife, resulting in instant and irrevocable divorce
- Offense and Penalty: It makes this offence punishable with imprisonment up to 3 years and fine. It also makes all declaration of talaq, including in written or electronic form (email, text message etc) to be void and illegal.

J & K LOSES ITS SPECIAL STATUS, DIVIDED INTO TWO UTS

- Government of India revoked Article 370 and the special status of Kashmir .
- Union Home Minister Amit Shah announced government's decision in the Rajya Sabha
- **Jammu & Kashmir** will be a Union Territory with a legislature while **Ladakh** will be a **Union Territory without legislature.**

Article 370 removed

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah has announced in Rajya Sabha that the government has decided to repeal Article 370 of the Constitution which grants special status to Jammu and Kashmir.
- Jammu and Kashmir will not be a state it will a Union Territory. Special features like a separate constitution, separate flag and separate status will no more after repealing Article 370.

Article 35A scrapped

- With the removal of **Article 370**, **Article 35A** will be also scrapped.
- People from other states may also buy or purchase land and settle there.

Bifurcation of Jammu and Kashmir

- As per the statement released by **Home Minister Amit Shah**, **Jammu and Kashmir** will be "reorganized" and will no longer be a state.
- Ladakh will be a **Union Territory** without an assembly and Jammu and Kashmir will be a Union Territory with an assembly, under recommendation.
- There will be two Lieutenant Governors when this provision will come into the force.

J&K becomes UT

- Jammu & Kashmir has become a Union Territory now and union laws would apply in this area.
- According to the notification released by government of India, "Keeping in view the prevailing internal security situation, fuelled by cross-border terrorism in the
- existing state of Jammu & Kashmir, a separate Union Territory is being created."
 Ladakh becomes UT
- The **Ladakh region** has given the status of a Union Territory (UT), without legislature. The **Ladakh division** has a large area but is sparsely populated with very difficult terrain.

The new order

- Under Article 370, Jammu and Kashmir had its own constitution and the laws passed by Parliament were applicable to the State only with the State government's concurrence.
- **Under Article 370,** The President was empowered to decide which provisions of the Indian Constitution would be applicable with the State's assent.
- These special measures could only be altered on the reccomendation of the Sadar-i-Riyasat (on the advice of the Ministers Council) or by the 'Constituent Assembly'.
- **Article 35A** protected the law such as bar on outsiders buying property in the State and women marrying Non-Kashmiris will loose their property rights.
- Article 367, To scrap Article 370 altogether, a few clauses were added to Article 367 which contains "Interpretations": the reference to the 'Consitituent Assembly' was amended to read 'Legislative Assembly of the State'. All references to the 'Sardar-i-Riyasat' will be constructed as references to the Governor.

Sharing of Power

- The Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Bill, 2019, will bring about the following changes to the State.
- Two Union Territories to be formed out of the State of Jammu and Kashmir: UT of Ladakh (Kargil and Leh districts;) and UT of J&K (all other districts of the State of J&K).

PRADHAN MANTRI LAGHU VYAPARI MAAN-DHAN YOJANA

■ It was launched by the Union labour and Employment ministry for retailers and smalltraders. This scheme provides minimum monthly pension of ₹ 3000/month to small shopkeepers, retail traders and the self-employed people after they attain 60 years of age.

Eligibility

- 1. Self-employed people, small shopkeepers and retail traders aged between 18-40 years and with Goods and Service tax (GST) turnover below ₹1.5 crore can avail the scheme.
- 2. The above eligible persons should not be covered under the National Pension Scheme, Employees' State Insurance Scheme and Employees Provident Fund or be an Income Tax payer (assessee).

Contribution

- 1. Amount of contribution is age specific.
- 2. It is a 50:50 basis scheme where the government contributes an equal amount as that of the contribution made by the subscriber.

Rashtriya Aajeevika Mission

- About: It is a poverty alleviation scheme launched in 2011 as National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM) and was succeeded by Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana in 2016.
 - 1. Sub-schemes under DAY-NRLM
 - 2. Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs): It allows a trainee to take bank credit and start his/her own business.
 - 3. Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP): It aims at facilitating rural poor for setting up micro-enterprises.

PRADHANA MANTRI SURAKSHA BEEMA YOJNA

■ The State Government of Uttar Pradesh (UP) has become number one in implementation of ambitious central government scheme Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Beema Yojna. Totally 1.95 crores people have been given insurance cover under the scheme till 31 march 2019 in the state.

About Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Beema Yojana:

■ It is a government-backed Life insurance scheme launched on 9 May 2015. It is available to people between 18 and 50 years of age with bank accounts get an accidental insurance cover of rupees 2 lakh by paying an annual premium of 330 rupees.

MISSION SHAKTI SPORTS INITIATIVE LAUNCHED BY

BOLLYWOOD ACTOR AAMIR KHAN

Mission Shakti which is an initiative to train athletes from Chandrapur and Gadchiroli for international events like the Olympics by the Maharashtra minister Sudhir Mungantiwar, was launched by Bollywood film actor Aamir Khan in presence of Maharashtra sports minister Ashish Shelar.

Mission shakthi

 Families who have food security cards can buy subsidized rice and wheat from any ration shop in these states but their ration cards should be linked with Aadhar Number to avail this service.

STATES & DISTRICTS FELICITATED UNDER BBBP

- The Union Ministry of Women and Child Development felicitated those Districts and States who have successfully implemented the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) scheme in the country.
- The function was held on 7th August, 2019 in New Delhi.
- The BBBP scheme launched on 22 January 2015 has been implemented in phases.
- Currently, it is being implemented in 640 districts (as per census 2011).

150 MILLION WORKERS AIMED BY THE GOVT. TO BE ENROLLED UNDER PM PENSION SCHEME

- Over the next 3 years under the pension scheme Pradhan Mantri shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM-SYM), the union government aims to enroll 150 million workers to bring them under the social security net.
- Labour secretary, Hiralal Samariya stated that about 50-60 million workers will be from the construction sector and Agriculture workers and self-employed retailers will also be part of this pension scheme.

Key Words

Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan yojana (PM-SYM)

- The scheme was announced in the month of February 2019. It provides monthly pension of **Rs. 3000** by contributing to this scheme till the age of **60 years**.

- This mega drive will be launched at Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Auditorium, Kendriya Vidyalaya No. 2 in Delhi.
- Inspired by Prime Minister's impetus to Jal Sanchay, Government of India has launched the Jal Shakti Abhiyan (JSA). It is a time-bound campaign with a mission mode approach.

SOFT LAUNCH FOR TRADERS' PENSION SCHEME

- One of the priorities of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government in the first 100 days of its second term, pension scheme for small traders, is likely to have a soft launch on August 19 evening, two officials of the Union Labour and Employment Ministry said.
- According to the Ministry's 100-day plan, the Pradhan Mantri Laghu Vyapari Maan-Dhan scheme would target enrolling 25 lakh subscribers in 2019-2020 and 2 crore by 2023-2024.

MUKHYAMANTRI KRISHI ASHIRWAD YOJANA

■ Under the Jharkhand state's scheme, Mukhyamantri Krishi Ashirwad Yojana launched by Shri Venkaiah Naidu, farmers/ beneficiaries having farmlands of less than 1 acre to 5 acres will be provided a financial assistance of ₹ 5,000-25,000. The launching ceremony was held in 23 districts apart from Ranchi.

Key Words

- 1. This scheme would benefit approximately 35 lakh farmers and by september /october this year ₹ 3000 crore will be sent to beneficiaries' account.
- 2. This scheme is apart from the benefits that the farmers are getting under **Pratan Mantri Kisan Yojana.**

PM'S HEALTH INSURANCE SCHEME WILL COVER CANCER TREATMENT

Cancer treatments will soon be covered under the Ayushman Bharat Yojana Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY), which is the Central Government's health insurance scheme that aims to give medical cover to over 10 crore poor and vulnerable families of approximately 50 crore beneficiaries, providing coverage of up to ₹ 5 lakh per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalisation.

VHALI DIKRI YOJNA

■ Gujarat Chief Minister (CM) Vijay Rupani has launched a flagship financial assistance scheme called 'Vhali Dikri Yojna' in Rajkot, Gujarat for the welfare of girl child in the state. The scheme launched in order to improve the child sex ratio in the state, which currently stands at 890 girl child per 1000 male child.

Key Words

The amount will be given by the state government under the 'Vhali Dikri Yojana'.

Eligibilty for Gujarat Vahali Dikri Yojana

- ► Applicant must be a permanent resident of Gujarat state.
- ▶ The girls must belong to a poor family with an annual income of less than 2 years.
- ▶ In the case of more than 2 female students from a family will be not allowed to attain this benefit.

INTER-STATE PORTABILITY OF RATION CARD BEGINS IN 4 STATES

- In a bid to implement 'One Nation, One Ration Card' across the country by June 1,2020, the Centre on Friday kick-started inter-state portability of ration cards between Telangana-Andhra Pradesh as well as Maharashtra-Gujarat.
- This means beneficiaries living in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh can buy their quota of ration from the Public Distribution System (PDS), also called ration shops, in either of the two States. Similar would be the case in Maharasthra and Gujarat.

ONLY 46% PREGNANT, LACTATING MOTHERS RECEIVE TAKE HOME RATION UNDER NUTRITION PROGRAMME

- Despite a high enrolment rate of 78 per cent, only 46 per cent pregnant and lactating women received 'Take Home Ration' under the supplementary nutrition programme, according to a survey conducted by the NITI Aayog in 27 districts.
- The survey also found that of the **64 per cent** eligible children registered with **Anganwadi** services, only 17 per cent received a hot cooked meal in a day.
- In order to deal with the situation, the **NITI Aayog** recommended expediting release of **Community-based Management of Acute Malnutrition (CMAM)** guidelines by the Health Ministry and filling up of vacant positions under Aanganwadi services at various levels in states and Union Territories.
- Using the CMAM method, malnourished children receive treatment suited to their nutritional and medical needs.

 Sabha in 2017 but subsequently lapsed.

- Entry 56 of Union List empowers the Union Government for the regulation and development of inter-state rivers and river valleys to the extent declared by Parliament to be expedient in the public interest.
- Article 262 of Indian Constitution is related to river water disputes.
- Parliament has enacted two laws according to Article 262:
 - ▶ River Board Act, 1956
 - ▶ Inter-State Water Dispute Act, 1956
- Interstate River Water Disputes Act, 1956 (IRWD Act) was enacted by the parliament of India under Article 262 of Constitution to resolve the water disputes that would arise in the use, control and distribution of an interstate river or river valley.

APPROVES CHILD CARE LEAVE FOR MALE SERVICE PERSONNEL

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has approved extension of benefits of Child Care Leave (CCL) to single male service personnel as well as certain relaxations of CCL provisions in case of women officers of defence forces. Currently Child Care Leave (CCL) is granted only to women officers in defence forces.
- This decision is in line with a recent Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) order which extended similar benefits of CCL to civilian employees.

CENTRE LAUNCHES SAN-SADHAN HACKATHON FOR DIVYANG ACCESSIBLE TOILETS

- With an aim to have functional, accessible and well-maintained toilets for the disabled, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD), under Swachh Bharat Mission, launched San-Sadhan Hackathon.
- Under San-Sadhan Hackathon, startups, student innovators, technology enthusiasts, academicians and industry experts have been invited by the Central government to create composite and affordable toilet solutions for Divyang or physically challenged people. The last date to apply for participating in Hackathon is August 28.

INDIA HOME TO 2967 TIGERS

- An increase of 741 tigers in the last four years because of the conservation initiatives taken by the Centre and State government.
- Compared to 2006 when the scientific method of tiger counting began, the numbers doubled from 1,411 in 2006 to 2,967 in 2018.
- The entire Western Ghats has 981 tigers with **Tamil Nadu (264)** and Kerala (190) contributing significantly.
- Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserve, Tamil Nadu showed the highest increment in management since the last cycle for which the park was awarded
- The 33% rise in tiger numbers is the highest ever recorded between cycles which stood at 21% between 2006 and 2010 and 30% between 2010 and 2014.
- The rise in tiger numbers was in conformity with the average annual growth rate of tigers since, 2006.

TWO NEW SPECIES OF FRESHWATER FISH FOUND

Scientists of Zoological Survey of India



(ZSI) have discovered 2 new species of freshwater fish from north-eastern and northern parts of country. Both fish are hill stream fauna, measures less than 7 centimetres (cm) and are equipped with special morphological features to suit rapid water flow.

▶ Both species of fish were discovered from remote areas of country. As **Glyptothorax gopii** was discovered from Mizoram's Champai district near India-Myanmar border and **Garra simbalbaraensis** has been found from Himachal Pradesh's Sirmour district.

"DRACAENA CAMBODIANA", INDIA'S FIRST DRAGON BLOOD-OOZING TREE DISCOVERED IN ASSAM

- A three-member research team led by Assam forest officer Jatindra Sarma has discovered Dracaena cambodiana, a dragon tree species in Dongka Sarpo area of West Karbi Anglong district in Assam.
- This is the first time that a dragon tree species, whose sap turns bright red after coming in contact with air has been reported from India.

PAPUA NEW GUINEA HAS THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF 'LIVING' LANGUAGES IN THE WORLD, INDIA RANKS 4TH

• According to **Ethnologue**, a directory of languages which lists 7,111 living languages (languages that are still being used and spoken by people) worldwide, Pacific island nation of **Papua New Guinea**, Country in Oceania tops the list with 840 living languages, while **India** ranks 4th position with 453.

- 78,383 forest fires were recorded in Brazil so far this year, the highest number for any year since 2013, and experts say the clearing of land during the months-long dry season to make way for crops or grazing has accelerated the **deforestation**. ■
- More than half of the fires are in the Amazon, and some 1,663 new fires were ignited, according to the National Institute for Space Research (INPE).

WITH AMAZON FOREST ON FIRE, BRAZIL FACES GLOBAL BACKLASH

- As dozens of fires scorched large swaths of the Amazon, the Brazilian government has struggled to contain growing global outrage over its environmental policies, which have paved the way for runaway deforestation of the world's largest rainforest.
- The fires, many intentionally set, are spreading as Germany and Norway appear to be on the brink of shutting down a \$ 1.2 billion conservation initiative for the Amazon.

CHHATTISGARH & TELANGANA TOP IN THE PROCESSING OF SOLID WASTE

■ The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) informed that Chhattisgarh and Telangana processed the largest percentage of solid waste until November 18.

11 SANCTUARIES IN TN, 1 EACH IN CHHATTISGARH, MAHARASHTRA APPROVED AS ESZ: ENVIRONMENT MINISTER

- The Ministry of **Environment** on Friday approved 13 wildlife sanctuaries, including one tiger reserve in Chhattisgarh, as eco-sensitive zones (ESZ) for scientific conservation of the ecosystem.
- Making the announcement on social media, Union Environment Minister Prakash Javadekar said, "To help scientific conservation of ecosystems and at the same time give relief to the people in the area, I have approved final Eco Sensitive Zone notifications of 11 sanctuaries in Tamil Nadu and one in Chhattisgarh.
- The 11 sanctuaries in Tamil Nadu are Vaduvoor Bird Sanctuary, Kanjirankulam Bird Sanctuary, Srivilliputhur Grizzled Squirrel sanctuary, Megamalai Wildlife sanctuary, Gulf of Mannar Marine National Park, Vettangudi Birds sanctuary, Kodaikanal Wildlife Sanctuary, Sakkarakottai Bird Sanctuary, Vallanadu Blackbuck Sanctuary, Oussudu Lake Bird Sanctuary and Point Calemere Wildlife Sanctuary.
- The Achanakmar Tiger Reserve in Chhattisgarh and Tungareshwar Wildlife Sanctuary in Maharashtra have also been approved as ESZ, Javadekar said.
- The ministry had earlier said that till June 25, 2019 over 30 per cent of India's protected area (PA) has been covered under the final ecologically sensitive zone notification. According to the ministry, out of the 651 protected areas in India, 316 have been covered under the final ESZ notification which provides for prohibition of mining, stone quarrying and crushing units located within one km of such protected areas.

GST COUNCIL REDUCES RATE ON ELECTRIC VEHICLES FROM 12% TO 5%

Highlights

- GST rate on electrical vehicles (EVs) from 12 per cent of 5 per cent and on EV changers from 18 per cent to 5 per cent from August 1, 2019.
- The Council also approved exemption from GST for hiring of electric buses by local authorities.

INDIA NEEDS TO GROW AT 9% TO ACHIEVE PM MODI'S TARGET OF \$ 5 TRILLION ECONOMY

- The country will need to grow by 9 per cent every year for five years continuously and raise aggregate investment rate to 38 per cent of GDP to achieve Prime Minister Narendra Modi's target of turning India into a USD 5 trillion economy, Ernst & Young.
- In its latest edition of Economy Watch, EY said assuming India grows by projected 7 per cent in the current fiscal year ending March 31, 2020, the size of the economy will grow to USD 3 trillion from USD 2.7 trillion in the previous year.
- It will have to grow by 9 per cent in each of the five subsequent years to take the size of the economy to USD 3.3 trillion in FY21, USD 3.6 trillion in FY22, USD 4.1 trillion in FY23, USD 4.5 trillion in FY24 and USD 5 trillion in FY25.

JALAN PANEL DEFERS REPORT ON RBI SURPLUS FUNDS AFTER LACK OF CONSENSUS

- A Reserve Bank of India (RBI) committee considering guidelines for transfer of the central bank's surplus funds to the government delayed submitting its report, after lack of consensus.
- The six-member committee led by former RBI governor **Bimal Jalan** will met once more before submitting its report by the month-end.
- The committee was appointed in December 2018 to review the Economic Capital Framework (ECF) for the Reserve Bank after the Finance Ministry advised the central bank to transfer surplus funds to the government.
- The RBI has over Rs 9.6 lakh crore surplus capital.

INDIA IS THE 7TH LARGEST ECONOMY IN THE WORLD IN 2018: WORLD BANK

■ The **World Bank data** for 2018 showed that India is the 7th largest economy in the world at \$ 2.73 trillion.

5.1 Latest Inventions on Science & Technology

IIT-M STUDENTS DESIGN 'AGRICOPTER' TO SPRAY PESTICIDES

- An "agricopter" designed by three students of the Indian Institute of Technology Madras has won them funds.
- The "agricopter" was developed by Rishab Verma, a student of chemical engineering, Kavin Kailash, studying aerospace engineering, and Akash Anand, pursuing engineering design.
- The team won at the finals of the Indian Innovation Growth Programme (IIGP)
 2.0 University Challenge, held in IIT-Bombay.

KAIGA ATOMIC ENERGY STATION SETS A WORLD RECORD

- Kaiga Atomic Energy station (Karnataka) sets a World Record in continuous operation of 962 days by Unit-1 of Kaiga Generating Station (KGS-1) among nuclear power plants of all technologies.
- KGS-1 (220 MW) in an indigenous Pressurized Heavy Water Reactors (PHWR) fuelled by domestic fuel which started commercial operation on November 16, 2000.

INDIAN SCIENTISTS DISCOVER 28 NEW STARS IN MILKY WAY

- Scientists at the Aryabhatta Research
 Institute of Observational Sciences
 (ARIES) here have discovered 28 new
 variable stars in the Milky Way galaxy.
- ARIES Director Wahab Uddin described the finding of the new variable stars, whose luminosity or brightness keeps changing, as a "rare achievement".
- The ARIES team of researchers led by Dr Sneh Lata and Dr AK Pandey performed photometric observations of globular cluster NGC 4147 using 3.6 metre Devasthal Optical Telescope (DOT) established in 2016 near Nainital.

CHINA LAUNCHES UNMANNED WARSHIP

- China has launched an unmanned warship, which its developer claims is combat-ready.
- The ship, jointly developed by China Shipbuilding Industry Corporation (CSIC), has a length of about only 15 meters and a displacement of 20 tonnes.

CHINA CONGRATULATES INDIA FOR CHANDRAYAAN-2, WANTS TO WORK TOGETHER IN SPACE EXPLORATIONS

- China congratulated India after the successful launch of the **Chandrayaan-2**. China decided to work with India for upcoming outer space programs.
- China launched its five lunar exploration missions to the Moon. They made history landing on the far side of the Moon.
- They looked for a launch of its own Mars **mission by 2020**.

China - Moon - History

- China is the first spacecraft landed on the far side of the Moon. This is the lunar surface known as the dark side of the moon.
- The main aim is to explore lunar surroundings rover **Yutu-2** then rolled off the lander. **Chang'e-4 of China** the first spacecraft that landed on the far side of the Moon on January 2019.
- It is the lunar mission to **Change 3**, first spacecraft landing on the Moon.
- The main objective of landing on the dark side of the Moon to explore the surface of the Moon. It is used to collect samples that are still unexplored.

Chang'e 6 mission

- Chang'e 6 mission is expected to launch in 2023 or 2024.
- The Chang'e 7 and 8 will be launched in 2023 and 2027 respectively.
- The **Chang'e 8** will carry a lander, a rover, a flying detector, and a **3D Printer** to build a small structure on the lunar surface.
- They may conduct a brief ecosystem experiment on the Moon.

A JAPANESE "FLYING CAR" HAS SUCCESSFULLY MADE ITS FIRST TEST FLIGHT

- Japan's government is hoping to position the country as a leader in the flying car not-quite-aslarge-as-a-helicopter drone space.
- Its "road map" document says it plans to ship goods this way by 2023 and let people ride in the vehicles in its (very densely populated) cities by the 2030s.

UAE WILL BE THE FIRST ARAB NATION ON MARS

- The Arab world will launch its first mission to Mars in July 2020, the chair of the United Arab Emirates (UAE) Space Agency.
- → The UAE's Hope probe will lift off from Japan and should reach Mars at the end of the following year, in time for the 50th anniversary of the emirates' independence. It will be the first planetary-science mission from the Arab world.
- ★ The mission's goals include understanding why Mars is losing its atmosphere by tracking the escape of hydrogen and oxygen, and building a bigger picture of the changing Martian atmosphere.

INDIA TEST-FIRES SURFACE TO AIR-MISSILE FROM CHANDIPUR

- India successfully test-fired its all-weathertracked-chassis Quick Reaction Surface-to-Air Missile (QR-SAM) from a mobile launcher at launch complex III of the Integrated Test Range at Chandipur in Odisha.
- This Missile Jointly developed by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Bharat Electronics Ltd, the QR-SAM weapon system is a quick reaction, network-centric missile system capable of search-on-the-move. QR-SAM system can also engage multiple targets within a range of around 25 to 30 km with 2 vehicle configuration for area air defence.
- It is a truck-mounted missile with a 360 degree rotatable, electro-mechanically operated, turret-based launch unit.

About QRSAM:

- It has been developed to replace the 'Akash' missile defence system, and has 360-degree coverage.
- It uses solid fuel propellant and has a strike range of 25-30 km with capability of hitting multiple targets.
- It is capable of hitting the low flying objects.

IIT-DELHI STUDENTS DESIGN WORLD'S FIRST SELF-STANDING CRUTCH

- The alumni from the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Delhi have created the world's first automotive crutches which have the capacity to stand on their own.
- The product which will be available in the market by the end of August is expected to solve problems of people with locomotive disabilities and the elderly.

TOI 270: NASA'S TESS DISCOVERS

■ NASA's Transiting Exoplanet Survey Satellite (TESS) recently discovered new dwarf star and planetary system named as TOI 270. It is located about 73 light years away from Earth, and in the constellation Pictor.

TOI 270 Planetary System

▶ Its members include Dwarf star named TOI 270, which is 40% smaller than the Sun in size and mass, and three exoplanets (planets outside solar system) that have been named TOI 270b, TOI 270c and TOI 270d. These three planets or bit their star every 3.4 days, 5.7 days and 11.4 days respectively.

IIT GUWAHATI BUILDS HAND-HELD DEVICE TO DETECT BACTERIA

- Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Guwahati researchers have developed a low-cost, hand-held device for rapid detection of bacteria, bringing portable bacterial detection kits closer to reality.
- The researchers believe that besides being useful in a healthcare set up, the device could aid anti-bioterrorism measures and environmental monitoring applications.
- The Organic Field Effect Transistor (OFET)-based bacterial diagnostic device has been shown to have the ability to distinguish between Gram positive and Gram negative types. The sensor detects the charges on the cell walls of bacteria.

NASA'S TESS SATELLITE DISCOVERS FIRST NEARBY SUPER EARTH

 A super-Earth was discovered by an International team of astronomers led by Lisa Kaltenegger and is considered to be the first potentially habitable world outside our own solar system.

Key Words

Super Earth

- The super Earth is named as GJ 357d and it was discovered in NASA's Translating Exoplanets Survey Satellite (TESS) according to new modelling research in "Astrophysical Journal Letters".
- This super Earth, GJ 35 70 located about 31 light years away from our solar system is more massive than earth and could contain liquid on its surface.
- This discovery of the GJ 357 system was announced in the journal "Astronomy & Astrophysics" by Astronomers of Spain.

JULY HOTTEST MONTH ON RECORD FOR THE EARTH

- July 2019 temperatures were the hottest ever recorded globally, the U.S. National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) said, while satellite data showed polar ice shrank to its lowest levels.
- According to the NOAA, the average global temperature for the month was 0.95°C above the 20th century average of 15.8°C, making it the hottest July in its records, which go back to 1880.

ISRO'S RISAT SERIES AND RISAT-3

- Radar Imaging Satellite (RISAT) is a series of remote sensing satellites built and operated by ISRO.
- The launch of RISAT-1 came many years after the launch of its planned successor, RISAT-2, which had enhanced remote sensing capabilities courtesy of an Israeli-built X-band radar.
- The RISAT-2 mission and launch were prioritized over RISAT-1 after the 2008 Mumbai attacks, which delayed RISAT-1's launch by several years to 2012.
- RISAT-1 made a name for itself after images taken by the satellite were used to carry out the surgical strikes after the Uri attack in 2016 and, more recently, air strikes on the Jaish camp in Pakistan.
- ISRO is building RISAT-2B, to be launched on the PSLV-C46 rocket in May, followed by the RISAT-2BR1 in July, RISAT-2BR2 in October and RISAT-1A in November this year.

HEALTH MINISTRY SETS TARGET TO REDUCE HIV CASES BY 2020

- With an aim to bring down incidence of HIV/AIDS by 20,000 per year for the next two years, the Union Health Ministry is reaching out to targeted areas like prisons and women remand homes as cases in these places are much higher as compared to the general population.
- As of now, there are about 2.1 million patients suffering from the disease, however, only 1.3 million are registered with **Antiretroviral Therapy (ART)** centres and getting the treatment as per the **National Aids Control Organization (NACO)**.

TINY LENSLESS ENDOSCOPE CAPTURES 3-D IMAGES OF OBJECTS SMALLER THAN A CELL

- Researchers have developed a new selfcalibrating endoscope that produces 3-D images of objects smaller than a single cell.
- Without a lens or any optical, electrical or mechanical components, the tip of the endoscope measures just 200 microns across, about the width of a few human hairs twisted together.
- According to Juergen W. Czarske, Director and C4-Professor at TU Dresden, Germany and lead author on the paper: "The lensless fiber endoscope is approximately the size of a needle, allowing it to have minimally invasive access and high-contrast imaging as well as stimulation with a robust calibration against bending or twisting of the fiber."

RUSSIA SENDS ROBOT FEDOR INTO SPACE FOR MISSION WITH ISS

- A Russian humanoid robot has started his journey to the International Space Station, serving as a mechanical passenger for a new type of rocket. The Skybot F850 android, named Fedor, is set to learn new skills in space.
- Russian scientist nicknamed the android Fedor, short for Final Experimental Demonstration Object Research.

IITM DEVELOPS MULTIMODAL ROBOTIC SYSTEM CALLED "GRASPMAN" WITH A HUMAN-LIKE GRASP

A team of researchers led by Asokan Thondiyath at Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IITM) have developed a new class of Robotic System called "GraspMan", which has human hand like grasping, manipulation and locomotion abilities.

Key Words

- ▶ GraspMan: It comprises a pair of graspers which provides morphological adaptation& allows it to confirm the geometry of the object. The graspers have the capability to hold objects securely and manipulate them much like the human hand.
- ▶ **Application:** The Robotic System will be used in industrial applications such as pipe climbing and inspection, which involve climbing, holding and assembling. Machines used in search & rescue purpose and locomotory applications will get benefit from this robotic platform.

IIT-M STUDENT DESIGNS SYSTEM TO RECYCLE URINE

- A student specialising in environmental engineering at the Indian Institute of Technology Madras has come up with a method to recycle human urine.
- Project Water Chakra won the Indian Innovation Growth Programme 2.0 award in July.

WORLD'S THINNEST GOLD CREATED BY BRITISH SCIENTISTS

 Scientists from the University of Leeds, United Kingdom (UK), claim to have created the world's thinnest gold



(periodic table representation of gold is Au) which is million times thinner than finger nail of human.

- As it appears to be green in water, researchers named it gold "nanoseaweed".
- This paperwork was published in the journal **Advanced Science**.

Key Words

- ▶ As only two atoms are layered one over the other, this material is regarded as 2D because all atoms are usually surfaced with no bulk atoms beneath the surface.
- ► Thickness of the material is just **0.47** nanometres.



ASTRONOMERS DISCOVERED A 2ND PLANET CALLED 'B PICTORIS C' FOR

BETA PICTORIS STAR

Astronomers at the **Institute for Planetary sciences and Astrophysics, Grenoble, France (IPAG)** have discovered a 2nd planet called '**B Pictoris c'**. It is roughly around 3,000 times more massive than Earth. It orbits **Beta Pictoris** star, which is about nearly twice the mass of Sun and lies about 63 light years away from Earth.

Key Words

► The planet 'B Pictoris c', situated 2.7 times further from its star than the Earth is from the Sun. It takes about 1,200 days to complete its orbit.

IIT-KGP DEVELOPS HYDRO THERMAL CARBONIZATION TECHNOLOGY FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT

IIT-KGP (Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur) researchers develop new technology – Hydro Thermal Carbonization (HTC) for solid waste management. This Hydro Thermal Carbonization Technology can convert municipal solid waste to biofuel, soil amendment and absorbents.

Key Words

Hydro Thermal Carbonization (HTC)

▶ Need: At present India has adopted waste incineration processes from developed nations which are primarily focused on treating dry waste content. These processes require high energy input to combust municipal solid waste generated in India which has high moisture content due to tropical weather, open collection systems and mixed waste thus by using existing processes, only 20-30% of organic fraction of municipal solid waste is being recycled to biofuel. The lack of India suited technology led to develop a technology which can address the challenge indigenously.

SCIENTIFIC AND USEFUL PROFOUND RESEARCH ADVANCEMENT

In a bid to promote research in cutting edge areas of science, the Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB) plans to launch a new scheme called "Supra" (Scientific and Useful Profound Research Advancement) to fund scientists.

- ► The scheme has designed as a part of the Prime Minister Narendra Modi's 100-day transformative ideas.
- ▶ Aim: The aim of this scheme is to fund new scientific and engineering breakthroughs with global impact.

LIGO OFFERS NEW INSIGHTS ON BLACK HOLES

- About 900 million years ago, there was a collision between a black hole and another compact object that resulted in gravitational waves being spewed out into space.
- The LIGO (Laser Interferometer Gravitational-Wave Observatory) and VIRGO collaborations, which look for gravitational waves emanating from such events, have picked up this signal.
- Astro-physicists are keenly analysing this signal, as it could signify this signal, as it could signify new insights into black hole physics or hold promise for developing gravitational wave astronomy.

Key Words

- ➤ The Laser Interferometer Gravitational-Wave Observatory (LIGO) is a largescalephysicsexperimentandobservatory to detect cosmic gravitational waves and to develop gravitational-wave observations as an astronomical tool.
- ▶ Two large observatories were built in the United States with the aim of detecting gravitational waves by **laser interferometry.** These can detect a change in the 4 km mirror spacing of less than a ten-thousandth the charge diameter of a proton.

INDIA'S FIRST CORPORATE CREDIT CARD FOR SMES LAUNCHED BY B2B PAYMENTS STARTUP ENKASH

- Business-Business payments startup company EnKash launched the country's first corporate credit card called 'Freedom Card' for small and medium enterprises (SMEs).
- **Freedom card:** This card provides the freedom to avail credit facility for immediate needs and to manage liquidity of startups.

WHO RECOMMENDS USE OF INNOVATIVE HIV DRUG

- The World Health Organisation (WHO) has recommended the use of the HIV drug dolutegravir (DTG) as the preferred first-line and second-line treatment for all populations, including pregnant women and those of childbearing potential.
- In 2019, **12** of the **18** countries surveyed by WHO reported pre-treatment drug resistance levels exceeding the recommended threshold of **10**%.

MACHINES ON DISPLAY AT WORLD ROBOT CONFERENCE IN CHINA

- Cutting-edge robots from around the globe are now on display at the 2019
 World Robot Conference in Beijing.
- Nearly 200 guests from 22 countries
 - are expected to attend the conference, running from August 20 to 25.
- Over 700
 robots with more than 21 industrial applications will be exhibited.



IMMUVAC, VPM1002: INDIA'S 1ST LARGE-SCALE TRIAL OF TWO NEW TB VACCINES LAUNCHED

Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) launched India's first large-scale trial for two new tuberculosis (TB) vaccines named IMMUVAC and VPM1002. These vaccines aim to prevent infection (pre-exposure) or prevent primary progression or reactivation of latent TB infection (post-exposure), all of which have critical role to play in India's big fight against TB. Both vaccines have been manufactured by Indian pharmaceutical companies.

Key Words

About Vaccines

- ► Immuvac: It is also known as mycobacterium indicus pranii (MIP). It has been manufactured by Ahmedabad based Cadila Pharmaceuticals.
- ► **VPM1002:** It is manufactured by Pune based Serum Institute of India.

Need for new vaccines

▶ At present Bacille Calmette-Guerin (BCG) vaccine is widely used in routine Expanded Programme of Immunisation (EPI) across the world. However, this vaccine is over century old and provides poor protection against pulmonary disease in adolescents and adults.

KARNATAKA GOVERNMENT CATEGORISED NICOTINE AS "CLASS A POISON"

The Government of Karnataka amended the Karnataka Poisons (Possession and Sale) Rules 2015 and notified Nicotine as "Class A poison" in order to strengthen the enforcement of the ban on production and sale of electronic cigarettes. The new rules are called the Karnataka Poisons (Possession and Sale) Rules, 2019.

Key Words

- 1. The ban was imposed after the study conducted the **High Powered Committee on Tobacco Control** headed additional Chief Secretary of Karnataka, **Vandita Sharma**.
- 2. The Government has also ordered the suspension of all kinds of promotion of e-cigarettes, including online promotion.
- 3. Class A poison are "Highly toxic chemicals", which even in very small quantities as gas or vapour in the air are dangerous to life (such as cyanogen, hydrocyanic acid, nitrogen peroxide, and phosgene).

WORLD'S SMALLEST FOSSIL MONKEY FOUND IN THE FORESTS OF AMAZON

A team of scientists led by **Duke**University in the US (United States)
and the National University of Piura
in Peru has discovered the fossils of
the world's smallest monkey in the
Amazon forests. The team has found
18 million years old fossil teeth, which
is related to the small monkey of a new
species.

Key Words

 The fossil found in sandstone on the banks of the Rio Alto Madre de Dios River in south-eastern Peru.

7 NEW SPECIES OF INSECTS THAT CAN WALK ON WATER DISCOVERED

- Scientists of the Zoological Survey of India have discovered seven species of water treaders, semi-aquatic insects that can walk or run on the surface of water.
- The newly described species belong to the genus **Mesovelia** whose size ranges from 1.5 mm to 4.5 mm and are equipped with hydro-phobic setae (bristles) on their legs. The combination of hydrophobic setae and water surface tension prevents them from sinking.

59-MINUTE LOAN SCHEME

Indian Overseas Bank (IOB) may be one of the first public sector banks off the blocks to ease the credit situation for the **MSME sector**, in response to the clarion call from the government. The bank has

announced that the loan amount sanctioned under the 59-minute approval scheme is being upped to ₹ 5 crore.

KARNATAKA IS THE MOST DIGITISED STATE: RAZORPAY REPORT

- **Bengaluru**-based payment solutions company **Razorpay** launched the second edition of its digital transactions report, 'The Era of Rising Fintech'.
- Karnataka topped the list of most digitised States in the April-June 2019 quarter, followed by Maharashtra and Delhi. Tamil Nadu ranked fourth, followed by Andhra Pradesh.
- Digital adoption in Tamil Nadu has grown by more than 35 per cent in the last three months and UPI as an instrument has grown by 57 per cent in the State during the last quarter.

- **4. Report:** More than 20 people were lynched in the months of May & June, 2018 based on the fake news posted on Social media platform, which incites such incidents.

- According to a blueprint prepared by the Railway Board to hand over the two trains to the railways' tourism and catering arm for a period of three years as a pilot project, no concessions, privileges or duty passes will be allowed on these trains.

ALL CAPF PERSONNEL TO RETIRE AT 60 YEARS: GOVT ORDER

- Government of India issued an order that all Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) personnel will now retire at a uniform age of 60 years.
- As per the order issued by Union Home Ministry, all personnel of the forces, the Border Security Force, Sashastra Seema Bal, Central Reserve Police Force and Indo-Tibetan Border Police will retire at the age of 60, instead of 57 years.

PRESIDENT KOVIND INAUGURATES BUNKER MUSEUM AT MUMBAI RAJ BHAVAN

- President Ram Nath Kovind inaugurated the underground Bunker Museum at Raj Bhavan in Mumbai.
- The 15,000 square feet underground bunker museum has virtual reality booths in which visitors can "time travel" to the 19th century.
- The bunker was created in the 19th century to fire cannons at approaching enemy ships.

RAILWAYS TO REFUND TICKETS BOOKED ON CANCELLED THAR EXPRESS

- Jodhpur to Karachi has been cancelled by the Railway Ministry till further orders, the railways will refund 45 tickets booked till now by passengers who wanted to travel to Pakistan on Saturday on the weekly train.
- The operations of Thar Express have been suspended till further orders from Railway Ministry. The directions have been issued by the ministry to the **North Western Railway**.

'HOUSING FOR ALL' TARGET TO BE ACHIEVED BY 2020

- Minister Hardeep Singh Puri said the target of 'Housing for All' under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana will be achieved in 2020, two years before the deadline.
- The Union Housing and Urban Affairs Minister said that under the PMAY (Urban), 24 lakh houses have so far been handed over to beneficiaries and the number will soon reach 50 lakh.
- There are 48 lakh houses which are currently grounded, but this number will also rise to 75 lakh.

40 INDIAN ORIGIN YOUTH TAKE PART IN 54TH KNOW INDIA PROGRAMME

- Kerala government first time decided to allow women to drive government vehicles. The state government was running 'She-Taxi' initiative.
- The Kerala government decided to appoint women drivers in government departments and public sector undertakings, a post so far reserved for men.
- In **Kerala**, barring the State Road Corporation, women are not allowed to apply for driver posts in any other department and many women's organisations have asked the government to lift this ban.

GOGABEEL, AN OX-BOW LAKE IN BIHAR DECLARED AS THE STATE'S FIRST 'COMMUNITY RESERVE'

Gogabeel, an ox-bow lake (measures 88 hectares) in Katihar district of Bihar has been declared as state's 1st 'Community Reserve'. Gogabeel, which is the 15th Protected Area (PA) in Bihar, is formed from the flow of the rivers Mahananda and Kankhar in the north and the Ganga in the south and east.

Key Words

- Gogabeel was initially notified as a 'Closed Area' (CA) by the state government in 1990 & after the amendment of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, the provision of CA has been lifted.
- In 2004, it was given the status of an IBA (Important Bird Area of India). The local residents around the lake have supported every move to declare it as a reserve for birds and biodiversity.
- The environment Department of Bihar was notified the Gogabeel as a 57 hectare Community Reserve and a 30-hectare 'Conservation Reserve' on August 2, 2019.

GOVT. TO LAUNCH 'UBER FOR TRACTORS' APP TO AID FARMERS'

- A laser-guided land leveller harnesses technology to accurately flatten a field in a fraction of the time used by a traditional oxen-powered scraper.
- Farmers save precious groundwater and increase productivity by 10 to 15%.

FIRST WORLD YOUTH CONFERENCE ON KINDNESS INAUGURATED BY INDIAN PRESIDENT

- The President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind inaugurated the first World Youth conference on kindness at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi.

BIODIESEL IN 100 CITIES

- State-run oil marketing companies Indian Oil, Bharat Petroleum and Hindustan Petroleum launched a programme to procure biodiesel made from used cooking oil in 100 cities across the country.
- The programme was formally launched by Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, under which the three OMCs would invite expression of interest from private entities for setting up plants to produce biodiesel from used cooking oil.
- The biodiesel would be procured by the OMCs at an assured rate of `51 per litre, which would be increased to `52.7 in the second year and `54.5 per litre in the third year.

INDIAN PRESIDENT LAUNCHES PLANTATION DRIVE IN NEW DELHI AS PART OF VAN MAHOTSAV CELEBRATIONS

■ The President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind planted Maulsari sapling in the Rashtrapati Bhavan Estate (New Delhi). It was done as part of the 'Van Mahotsav' celebrations.

- The Centre will be in direct control of law and order and police in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir through the Lieutenant Governor (L-G), while land will be a subject under the elected government.
- President Ram Nath Kovind gave assent to a legislation for bifurcation of Jammu and Kashmir under which two Union Territories - Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh -- will come into existence on 31 October.
- The **UT of Jammu and Kashmir** will have a Lieutenant Governor and the maximum strength of its assembly will be 107, which will be enhanced to 114 after a delimitation exercise.
- Twenty-four seats of the Assembly will continue to remain vacant as they fall under Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK).

NITI AAYOG RELEASES REPORT ON THE COMPOSITE WATER MANAGEMENT INDEX 2.0

- Goa, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Karnataka have topped the Composite Water Management Index 2.0 for 2017-18 among non-Himalayan states. Among Himalayan states, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Tripura are on top of the index.
- The composite water management index (CWMI) 2.0 was released by NITI Aayog in the presence of **Jal Shakti minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat** and the Aayog vice chairman Rajiv Kumar.
- The states are ranked across nine themes and cover **25 states** and two union territories.

AMAZON INAUGURATES ITS WORLD'S LARGEST CAMPUS IN HYDERABAD

- E-commerce company **Amazon**, inaugurated its single-largest campus in the world in terms of area (9 acres) in Hyderabad, Telangana.
- The campus was inaugurated by Mohammed Mahmood Ali, MLC (Member of Legislative Council), Minister of Home, Prisons, Fire Services, government of Telangana.

- The country's first Central Institute of Chemical Engineering & Technology (CICET) will be set up in Gujarat to give boost to the chemical industry, said by the Union minister Mansukh Mandaviya.
- The CICET will come up either at Ahmedabad or Surat.
- The state has a significant presence of chemical industry, especially in Vapi, Ankleshwar and Vatva in Valsad, Bharuch, and Ahmedabad districts, and the first-of-its-kind institute will facilitate the chemical industry with research and innovations

KARNATAKA TOPS IN STATE ROOFTOP SOLAR ATTRACTIVENESS INDEX (SARAL) 2019

- RK Singh, the Union Minister of State for Power and New & Renewable Energy (IC) and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship has launched the State Rooftop Solar Attractiveness Index 2019 (SARAL) at the Review Planning and Monitoring (RPM) Meeting with States and State Power Utilities in New Delhi.
- SARAL Index: As per the Index, Karnataka got the top spot with SARAL score of 78.8 as the best state for setting up a rooftop solar project followed by Telangana(72.2), Gujarat(67.9) and Andra Pradesh (66.1). Jammu and Kashmir(J&K) has been ranked last with a score of 14.4.

RAJASTHANS FREE MEDICINE SCHEME SECURES TOP RANK

- Rajasthan's free medicine scheme secured the highest position with first ranking issued by the National Health Mission (NHM) among the sixteen states of the country.
- NHM free drug service was introduced by the Ministry of health and family welfare (MoHFW) for all states/UTs.

Key Words

Rajasthan's free Medicine Scheme:

- The main aim of Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited (RMSCL) is to produce commonly used essential medicines freed from price to patients visiting government tending establishment in the year 2011-12.
- The scheme consists of 2 elements like free drugs and free tests.
- The Free medicines theme was enforced on the Gregorian calendar of 2011 and the free check theme was introduced on World Health Day in April of 2013.

PM MODI TO LAUNCH 'FIT INDIA' MOVEMENT ON AUGUST 29

India has already improved its ranking on a global healthcare access and quality (HAQ) index from 153 in 1990 to 145 in 2016. It still ranks behind Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, Brazil, Russia and South Africa and well below the global average. At a time when the global HAQ index average is 54.4, India's scored 41.2 (2016). This was 24.7 in 1990. The HAQ index was created on a study titled Global Burden of Disease.

7. INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

DENMARK'S JYSKE BANK UNVEILED WORLD'S FIRST NEGATIVE INTEREST RATE HOME LOAN

■ Denmark's third largest bank, **Jyske Bank** has launched the world's first negative interest rate mortgage
- handing out loans to homeowners where the charge is **minus 0.5**% **a year**. It has begun offering borrowers a 10-year deal at - 0.5%.

Key Words

- Under its negative mortgage, Jyske bank borrowers will make a monthly repayment as usual – but the amount still outstanding will be reduced each month by more than the borrower has paid.
- Negative interest rates effectively mean that a bank pays a borrower to take money off their hands, so they pay back less than they have been loaned.
- Another Danish bank, **Nordea** will begin offering 20-year fixed-rate deals at 0% and a 30-year mortgage at 0.5%.

CHINA, RUSSIA, FRANCE SHARE SATELLITE DATA ON ASSAM FLOODS

- With Assam inundated by floods, several countries including China, Russia and France collaborated with India on sharing satellite images of the scale of inundation.
- Based on an activation request by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) on July 17, France's National Centre for Space Studies, China National Space Administration and ROSCOSMOS of Russia shared satellite images of the flood situation in the districts of Dhubri, Marigaon, Barpeta, Dhemaji, Lakhimpur in Assam with ISRO's National Remote Sensing Centre. ISRO's CARTOSAT satellites too got the Indian space agency its own images.
- Since 2000, when the international charter space and major disasters came into operation there have been about 600 activations and data from 61 satellites have helped with disaster operations in 125 countries.

CLEAN AIR INITIATIVE LAUNCHED BY INDIA, UK IN BENGALURU

■ A two year **UK-India** joint initiative, the "**Innovation for Clean Air**" (**IFCA**) was launched by the British Deputy High Commissioner **Dominic McAllister** in Bengaluru to test interventions related to equality and support India's transition to **EV** (Electric Vehicles) integration.

Key Words

■ The air quality is measured by integrating satellite and sensor data.

GUJARAT TOPS IN SOLAR ROOFTOP INSTALLATIONS IN INDIA

Union Minister of State for New and Renewable Energy and Power R K Singh informed that Gujarat was ranked first in the installation of rooftop solar projects in India with an installed capacity of 261.97 megawatts (MW), out of which 183.51 MW were subsidised installations and 78.45 MW was non-subsidised. It was followed by Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu with 198.52 MW and 151.62 MW respectively.

Key Points:

- At present, the total rooftop solar installation in India is 1,700.54 MW.
- Under the Grid Connected Rooftop Solar programme, government provided total financial assistance and incentives of Rs 678.01 crore in 2016-17, Rs 169.73 crore in 2017-18 and **Rs 446.77 crore** in 2018-19.
- The government has set the target to install **40,000 MW** of rooftop solar projects by **2022**, including installation of RTS on the rooftop of houses.

Budget Allocation:

■ For **2019-20**, the union government has allocated **₹3,004.90 crore** for solar power sector, including both grid-interactive and off-grid projects.



INTERNATIONAL ARMY SCOUT MASTERS COMPETITION KICKS OFF IN JAISALMER

- The fifth edition of "International Army Scout Masters Competition" was kicked off in Jaisalmer.
- A total of eight countries comprising of China, Russia, Belarus, Armenia, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Sudan are participating in the event including the Indian Army team. The event commenced on August 5 and will continue till August 16, 2019.

AIM:

■ The aim of the International Army Games is to foster military cooperationbetween the participating nations, develop trust between the armies for the sake of establishing a peaceful society, improving professional training and sharing of best practices being followed by participating nations

SINGAPORE TO BAN SALE OF ELEPHANT IVORY FROM 2021

- **Singapore** will impose a blanket ban on the domestic sale of elephant ivory and products from **2021** as the government tightens its campaign against illegal wildlife trade.
- The announcement on **World Elephant Day** followed two years of consultations with non-government groups, ivory retailers and the public.
- Singapore has banned international trade in all forms of elephant ivory products since 1990.

INDIA AND ZAMBIA SIGN SIX MOUS

- India and Zambia signed six Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) in several areas including geology, defence, arts and culture during Zambian President Edgar Chagwa Lungu's state visit to India.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Zambian President Edgar Chagwa Lungu held delegation-level talks and reviewed the bilateral relations between the two nations.

BASIC COUNTRIES TO PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN MAKING PARIS AGREEMENT

- In the run-up to the United Nations Framework for Climate Change (UNFCC) Conference of Parties (COP-25) meet to be held later in the year from 2nd to 13th December, the BASIC countries held its 28th Ministerial meeting on Climate Change from 14th to 16th August in Sao Paulo, Brazil.
- India which was represented by Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Shri Prakash Javadekar said that BASIC countries coming together and putting views together is an important aspect of UN negotiations. "Brazil, South Africa, India and China put together has one-third of world's geographical area and nearly 40% of the world's population and when we unitedly speak in one voice this shows our determination and the BASIC Group could play an important part in making Paris agreement accepted by all the countries in its true letter and spirit".

ROHINGYA REFUGEES GET IDENTITY CARDS IN BANGLADESH

- Rohingya refugees living in Bangladesh issued identity documents by the UNHCR. The bio-metric, fraud-proof cards are being issued jointly by Bangladeshi authorities and UNHCR to all verified refugees over the age of 12.
- These cards will help in establishing and safeguarding the right of Rohingya refugees to return to their homes in Myanmar.
- The current registration exercise began in June 2018 and it is scheduled to be completed during the last quarter of the current year.
- UNHCR's Bio-metric Identity Management System (BIMS) captures bio-metric data, including fingerprints and iris scans which secure each refugee's unique identity as well as other important information such as family links.

INDONESIA PONDERS PLAN TO MOVE CAPITAL FROM JAKARTA

- President Joko Widodo has asked parliament to sign off on a plan to move the nation's capital to Borneo island. Jakarta is one of the world's fastest sinking cities; a third of its land could be submerged by 2050.
- Indonesia's president vowed to press on with plans to relocate the nation's capital from Jakarta as the city sinks by up to 25 centimeters (10 inches) a year.

INDIA, BHUTAN INK 10 PACTS TO BOOST TIES

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his Bhutanese counterpart Lotay Tshering held wide ranging talks during which they discussed steps to further expand the bilateral partnership across several sectors as the two countries inked 10 Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) to infuse new energy in their ties.
- Inaugurated 740 MW Mangdechhu hydroelectric power plant and also launched stamps to commemorate five decades of India-Bhutan Hydropower cooperation.
- The two countries signed 10 agreements in the field of space research, aviation, information technology, power and education. One of the MOUs include establishment of SATCOM Network in Thimphu for the utilisation of South Asia Satellite.
- The two leaders also unveiled e-plaque of the interconnection between India's National Knowledge Network and Bhutan's Druk Research and Education Network

SAUDI ARABIA PERMITS WOMEN TO TRAVEL ABROAD WITHOUT MALE GUARDIAN'S PERMISSION

■ The Government of Saudi Arabia made a reform in allowing women to travel abroad without the consent from male guardian.

Key Words

- 1. The law to get permission from male guardian was removed as many women made high-profile attempts to escape alleged guardianship abuse despite various reforms made by crown prince **Mohammed Bin Salman.**
- 2. One such reform was overturning the ban on women drivers, allowing them to get driving licence for the first time since **24 June 2018**.



LONDON NAMED AS WORLD'S BEST STUDENT CITY IN QS BEST STUDENT CITIES RANKING 2019

■ In the QS Best Student Cities Ranking 2019 compiled by Quacquarelli Symonds (QS), a global education consultancy, London, the capital of United Kingdom (UK), was named as the world's best city for students for the second consecutive year. Tokyo and Melbourne were ranked second and third positions respectively.

8. TAMIL NADU AFFAIRS

THREE TAMIL NADU DISTRICTS GET SET FOR PRE-TEST CENSUS OF INDIA, 2021

- In Tamil Nadu the pretest census will be taken up in districts three of Sivagangai, Nilgiris and Kancheepuram, conducted to be between August 12 and September 30.
- With the next general census due in the country in the year 2021, the Union Home ministry has notified under the Census Act, conducting of 'pretest census of India 2021' in all the States and Union Territories from August 12, 2019, to September 30, 2019.
- The Census 2021 is the 16th series since
 1881 and eighth after independence.

'PANCHAMIRTHAM' OF PALANI TEMPLE IN TAMIL NADU GETS GI TAG

- Geographical Identity (GI) tag was given to the famous Panchamritham, an offering of the Palani Dandayuthaswamy temple, in Tamil Nadu. It became the first temple offering Prashad from Tamil Nadu to be conferred this honour.
 - The quality of the offering is monitored by the Central Research Institute of Food Technology in Mysore, Karnataka.
 - Earlier, the Tanjavoor Veenai, Madurai Malligai, Neelgiri Tea leaves and Turmeric from Erode from Tamil Nadu were given the GI tags.

T.N. TO GET JUST 83 TMCFT UNDER GODAVARI-CAUVERY LINK PROJECT

- Tamil Nadu has been allotted 83 thousand million cubic feet (tmcft) of water under the proposed Godavari-Cauvery link, according to a draft detailed project report of the National Water Development Agency (NWDA), a Central government organisation entrusted with the task of preparing proposals for linking rivers.
- The allotment has not provided comfort to the State government, as Tamil Nadu has been demanding 200 tmcft of water, a quantity mentioned in a memorandum submitted by Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami to Prime Minister Narendra Modi in June.

CM ANNOUNCES CREATION OF RANIPET, TIRUPATTUR DISTRICTS

- Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami announced that Vellore district would be split into three to create two new districts of Tirupattur and Ranipet.
- Vellore district, currently one of the largest in Tamil Nadu, would retain its head quarters, but see a reduction in geographical area. K.V. Kuppam in Vellore district would be made a taluk.

T.N. SET UP MEGA FOOD PARK

- The Union government will help establish a mega food park in the State by providing investment subsidy to entrepreneurs, Union Minister of State for Food Processing Industries RameswarTelisaid during the inaugural of the second edition of 'Vibrant Tamil Nadu', in Madurai on Monday.
- The Centre stood ready to help farmer producer companies in Madurai set up their own food processing units. The Tamil Nadu Chamber Foundation has organised the four-day international exhibition on food products and kitchen equipment.

INDIA'S FIRST FINTECH CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE SET UP IN CHENNAI

- 1.Software Technology Parks of India (STPI) has set up a 'Centre of Excellence in FinTech' in Chennai, first of its kind in India.
- 2. To provide resources in terms of mentoring, technology support and funding for FinTech startups. Called 'FinBlue', the centre intends to incubate over 58 startups in the next five years.

THREE-DAY DISASTER RELIEF EXERCISE BEGINS IN CHENNAI

- A three-day Joint Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) exercise for the **State of Tamilnadu** and Union Territory of Puducherry.
- The exercise was being coordinated by the Flag Officer Commanding Tamilnadu and **Puducherry Naval Area (FOTNA)** under the Eastern Naval Command.
- The tri-services exercise being organised under the aegis of Headquarters Integrated Defence Staff (HQIDS) was conducted for the first time in Chennai with the participation of multi-agencies.
- The exercise was mainly aimed at refining existing Standard Operating Procedures of all stakeholders in Disaster Relief Operations and to ensure that all agencies concerned work in unison to deliver timely, effective and efficient relief to all citizens in time of need.

TAMIL NADU IS FIGHTING IN THE FIRST ATTEMPT TO SAVE A SINKING ISLAND

- Until a year before the 2004 tsunami ravaged India's southeast coast, a 34year-old Rajan would take his boat from Tharuvaikulam, a small village in Thoothukudi district of Tamil Nadu, to the nearby island of Koswari and mine for corals.
- The island lies only a few **kilometres** away from the mainland, and makes up a small archipelago of 21 islands in the **Gulf of Mannar Marine National Park** in southeast India, spanning the districts of **Rameswaram and Thoothukudi**.

STATE GOVT. SET TO LAUNCH EDUCATION TV

- Kalvi tholaikkaatchi (Education TV), a television channel of the State government, will be launched by Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami.
- The TV station will also feature programmes on employment opportunities and learning the craft of self-employment, and a daily telecast of employment-related news.

PRAKASH JAVADEKAR INAUGURATES NATIONAL CENTRE FOR AVIAN ECOTOXICOLOGY IN TAMIL NADU

■ The Union Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Information and Broadcasting Minister Prakash Javadekar has inaugurated the National Centre for Avian Ecotoxicology at Salim Ali Centre for Ornithology and Natural Sciences ((SACON) in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu.

■ The centre will study the movement of chemical contaminants such as pesticides, heavy metals, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, poly chlorinated biphenyls and drugs through food chain, and their impacts on bird species.
