#### **Data Protection Day**


➤ It is also known as **Data Privacy Day** in some parts

#### International Day of Zero Tolerance for Female Genital Mutilation

> International Day of Zero Tolerance for Female Genital Mutilation (FGM), which is also called as Female Genital Cutting (FGC) that is, removal of all or part of a female's genitalia for non-medical reasons.



#### **AIM**

- i. The UN officially commemorated the International Day of Zero Tolerance for Female Genital Mutilation to remark to fight against FGM on February 6, 2003.
- ii. The theme for the year 2019 is #EndGFM.



#### **National Cleft Day**

➤ India's first toll free national cleft helpline named **Smile** Train India cleft Helpline launched by Smile Train India on National Cleft Day.

#### **Key Points:**

- > The **number 18001038301** is accessible to people throughout India and they can receive 100% free, quality and safe cleft treatment.
- > It will create awareness about cleft surgery support by Smile Train and their partner hospitals across India.



#### **World Pulses Day**

➤ United Nations global event to celebrate pulses worldwide and continue the important



gains made with the 2016 International Year of Pulses.

#### AIM:

> In December 2013, the United Nations (UN) General Assembly voted unanimously to declare 2016 as the International Year of Pulses (IYP), to celebrate, raise awareness and promote the consumption of pulses at events around the globe.

#### **National Deworming Day**

> It was observed with a motive to showcase the importance of worm free lives and maintaining sanitation.

#### Focus areas of the deworming day:

- > It is a single fixed-day approach to treating **intestinal worm infections** in all children aged 1- 19 years.
- ➤ It will mobilize health personnel, state governments and other stakeholders to prioritize investment in control of Soil Transmitted Helminth (STH) infections one of the most common infections.
- > Adequate supply of **Albendazole tablets** at healthcare and Anganwadi centres.
- > Spreading awareness on **safe drinking water and sanitation**.



#### **International Day of Women and** Girls in Science

➤ Theme 2019- "Investment in Women and Girls in Science for Inclusive Green Growth.



#### AIM:

➤ In order to achieve full and equal participation and access to women and girls in science, and to further achieve gender equality and empowerment of women and girls.

#### World day of the Sick

- > It was initiated by **Pope John Paul II** in **1992** with an aim to encourage people to pray for those who suffer from illness and for their caregivers.
- It was observed for the first time on 11th February 1993.

**AIM**: As per the **UNESCO** data (2014-16), only about 30% of all female students select STEM-related fields in higher education

➤ Globally, the enrolment of female students is particularly low in ICT (3%), Natural Science, Mathematics and Statistics (5%) and in Engineering, manufacturing and construction (8%).



#### **National Productivity Council celebrates its** Foundation Day on 12th Feb

> National Productivity Council (NPC) has commemorated its 61st Foundation Day as **Productivity Day**. NPC is celebrating National Productivity Week from 12th Feb to 18th Feb, 2019.

#### **Key Points:**

- > The theme of this year's Productivity Day is "Circular Economy for Productivity and Sustainability".
- This is to signify a distinctive opportunity for circular business representative models for 'Make-Use-Return' for further economic prospects and revitalization of materials.

#### **International Darwin Day**

➤ The legacy of the British scientist "Charles Darwin" was celebrated across the globe by various scientists, activists, and fans.

#### **World Radio Day**

> Theme 2019 - Theme of "Dialogue, Tolerance and Peace"

#### AIM:

United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to commemorate radio as a powerful and influential medium that has been in existence for over 80 years.

#### World Day of Social Justice

> World Day of Social Justice will be observed on Feb.20 every year to create awareness about social justice based on gender, age, race, ethnicity, religion, culture or disability.



#### **Objective:**

This day promotes peaceful and prosperous coexistence among different nations. It also creates awareness throughout the world about values of gender equality or the rights of indigenous peoples and migrants.

#### Theme of 2019:

> 'If you want Peace and Development, Work for Social Justice' to focus on the goal of achieving full employment for the bottom 40 per cent of people and support for social integration.

#### Background:

➤ On 26th November 2007, The United Nations General Assembly has approved to observe 20th February every year and started to activate from 2009, as the World Day of Social Justice.



#### International Mother Language Day

➤ Theme for the year 2019- "Indigenous languages matter for development, peace building and reconciliation".

#### Background:



bring the change a person wants to see in the world.

- 2. The day is significant as it was the birthday of Scouting and Guiding founder Lord Robert Baden-Powell and of Lady Olave Baden-Powell, his wife and World Chief Guide.

#### 1.2 DEFENCE

## INDIA AFRICA FIELD TRAINING EXERCISE (IAFTX) 2019 TO BE HELD IN PUNE

➤ The final planning conference to work out the modalities for **India Africa**Field Training Exercise (IAFTX) which is to be held from 18th to 27th

March 2019 commenced in Pune, Maharashtra.

#### **Key Points:**

- ➤ India Africa Field Training Exercise (IAFTE) 2019 will boost strategic Cooperation, political and military ties between the countries.
- > Representatives from Egypt, Ghana, Nigeria, Senegal, Sudan, South Africa, Tanzania, Namibia, Mozambique, Uganda, Niger, and Zambia are attending the conference.
- ➤ Field Training Exercise will be carried out at Aundh Military station and College of Military Engineering in Pune.

## NAVY CHIEF ADMIRAL SUNIL LANBA COMMISSIONED NEW NAVAL AIR BASE 'INS KOHASSA' AT DIGLIPUR, ANDAMAN

➤ Navy Chief Admiral Sunil Lanba commissioned new Naval Air Base 'INS KOHASSA' at Diglipur, Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

#### **Key Points:**

- ➤ The air base is situated at the northernmost part of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. It will be used for both defence and civil aircraft.
- ➤ The air base will function as an independent unit and will be used to handle operations of helicopters and small aircrafts like the Dornier.

#### **INS Kohassa:**

- ➤ INS Kohassa being the third air base in Andaman and Nicobar Islands will be used for surveillance of Chinese ships and submarines entering the Indian Ocean through Malacca Strait.
- ➤ The probable reason behind **INS Kohassa** is a Chinese submarine docked on Colombo port in **Sri Lanka in 2014** which drew an alarm and India government raised the issue to **Sri Lankan** authorities.

#### **EXERCISE RAHAT'** CONCLUDED IN JAIPUR



Joint Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief Exercise `Exercise Rahat´ concluded in Jaipur, Rajasthan. It was demonstrated in Jaipur, Kota and Alwar in Rajasthan.

#### **Key Points:**

- ➤ Indian Army was represented by Jaipur based Sapta Shakti Command. Representatives from Armed Forces, National Disaster Management Mechanism Response (NDMRM), **SDMA** Rajasthan and DLMAs participated in the exercise.
- ➤ The exercise was conducted in three places, in Jaipur it was in the form of a table top exercise and at Kota and Alwar it demonstrated capability on-ground and coordination among various stakeholders.

#### 1ST LAWASIA HUMAN RIGHTS **CONFERENCE 2019 WAS HELD IN NEW DELHI**



LAWASIA, in association with the Bar Association of India hosted its LAWASIA Human Rights Conference in **New Delhi** with a motive to explore a broad range of human rights issues of relevance in the Asia Pacific region.

#### **About the Conference:**

- ➤ This conference was inaugurated by Vice President Shri. M. Venkaiah Naidu with the theme "State Power. Business and Human Rights: Contemporary Challenges".
- ➤ It provides opportunity for lawyers and associated professional members to exchange insights and expertise on topics of significance.

#### 'BOEING 747-200'-AIR INDIA'S FIRST **EVER FLIGHT SIMULATOR WAS EXHIBITED IN MUMBAI**

- > Air India's First ever Flight Simulator known as 'Boeing 747-200' was exhibited in Nehru Science Centre, Mumbai.
- The Simulator was acquired by Air India in 1980, which is designed and manufactured by the CAE(Canadian Aviation Electronics), Canada.

#### 'AMAN 19' COMMENCED IN KARACHI

➤ The 5-day multinational maritime exercise 'AMAN-19' in which 46 nations participated from all over the world was formally commenced at Pakistan Navy Dockyard, with a colorful flag hoisting ceremony.

#### **Key Points:**

- Pakistan's Naval Chief, Admiral Zafar Mahmood Abbasi welcomed the participations of Exercise AMAN-19, the 6th episode of the AMAN initiative, with motto "Together for Peace".
- ➤ Principal aim to conduct this exercise is to facilitate a forum of understanding of each other's maritime concepts and operation cultures and to produce ways and means to confront common threat at sea.
- ➤ The exercise will have 2 phases-Harbour phase and sea phase.

## IAF CARRIED OUT 'VAYU SHAKTI' EXERCISE AT POKHRAN

➤ Indian Air Force conducted mega exercise 'Vayu Shakti' in Pokhran, Rajasthan. The exercise was conducted two days after 40 CRPF personnel were killed in a suicide attack in Kashmir's Pulwama

#### INDIAN ARMY CARRIED OUT THE ANNUAL EXERCISE NAMED 'EXERCISE TOPCHI'

- ➤ Indian army demonstrated its artillery firepower, aviation and surveillance capacity at the annual 'Exercise Topchi' at Deolali Camp near Nashik.
  - 1. The latest ultra-light Howitzer M-777, self-propelled gun K-9 Vajra and indigenous Swathi weapon-locating radar was demonstrated.
  - 2. The aviation assets showcased were the indigenous advanced light helicopter, light combat helicopter, Cheetah & Chetak helicopters.

#### Related points:

➤ Chief of the Army Staff – General Bipin Rawat



#### **Key Points:**

- ➤ The exercise was carried out day and night where the IAF showcased fire power capability of indigenously developed platforms and efficacy of missiles.
- ➤ For the first time, the Advanced Light Helicopter (ALP) and the Akash surface-to-air missile were deployed in military exercise. MiG-29 fighter jet also participated in the exercise.

#### 1.3 SUMMIT & CONFERENCE

#### INDIA SIGNS AGREEMENT WITH OECD FOR PARTICIPATION IN PISA 2021

> The Union Human Resources Development Ministry signed an agreement with Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) for India's Participation in Programme for International Student Assessment-PISA 2021.

#### Objective:

- > The student assessment by PISA will ensure learning outcome through education. It would lead to an improvement in the learning levels of the children and enhance the quality of education in the country.
- ➤ It would also indicate the health of the education system of the nation and would motivate other schools and states in the subsequent cycles.

#### INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON GURU PADMASAMBHAVA IN **NEW DELHI**

- > An International Conference on 8th century Himalayan sage Guru Padmasambhava was held in New Delhi.
- ➤ The conference was organised as part of events to commemorate 50-years of formalization of diplomatic ties between India and Bhutan.

#### Guru Padmasambhaya

- > Guru Padmasambhava was born in India and travelled all across Himalayan religion in the 8th century to spread Buddhism and Buddhist teachings.
- > Guru Padmasambhava is highly revered in Bhutan. There is an image or painting of the Guru Padmasambhava in every Bhutanese home or temple.
- > Guru Padmasambhava was also known as Guru Rinpoche is widely venerated as a "second Buddha" by adherents of Tibetan Buddhism in Tibet, Nepal, Bhutan, the Himalayan states of India, and elsewhere.
- > Guru Padmasambhava is also considered to be the founder of Nyingama tradition, oldest of the four major schools of Tibetan Buddhism.

#### CAPACITY AUGMENTATION TO SUCCESSFULLY DELIVER THE G20 PRESIDENCY

➤ India is going to host the G20 annual summit is 2022 when it celebrates its 75th year of independence and in order to exploit it to the full extent, capacity augmentation of available resources and efficient addressal of organizational challenges must be done on time to fill the infrastructure,

management and intellectual gap.

➤ Indian Prime Minister, Narendra Modi requested **Italy** to host the **2021 G20 summit instead of 2022 summit** which was accepted by Italy.

#### WORLD ECONOMIC FORUM ANNUAL MEETING HELD IN DAVOS

- > From 22nd January 2019, the flagship event of World Economic Forum. World Economic Forum Annual Meeting-2019 was in Davos-Klosters. held Switzerland. The theme of the event was "Globalization 4.0: Shaping a Global Architecture in the Age of the Fourth Industrial **Revolution**". The event concluded on 25th January 2019.
- ➤ The International Monetary Fund(IMF) released its World Economic Outlook Update in Davos, Switzerland. The report stated that India's gross domestic product (GDP) is poised to grow by 7.5% in the 2019-20 fiscal and 7.7% in 2020-2021.

#### GORKHA BRIGADE WINS BEST MARCHING CONTINGENT AWARD




- Gorkha Brigade received the best marching contingent trophy of the Republic Day parade whereas, The CRPF won the best marching contingent prize for the paramilitary forces.

- > A Star is Born has received 8 Oscar nominations including best actor for Bradley Cooper and best actress for Lady Gaga.

## BHARAT RATNA AND PADMA AWARDS CANNOT BE USED AS TITLES

- ➤ Replying to a written question in Lok Sabha, Minister of State for Home **Shri Hansrah Gangaram Ahir** said that National Awards, such as **Bharat Ratna**, **Padma Vibhushan**, **Padma Bhushan** and Padma Shri do no amount to titles within the meaning of **Article 18(1)** of the **Constitution** and hence, cannot be used as prefixes or suffixes to the name of the recipient.
  - 1. In case of any misuse, the defaulter shall forfeit the award conferred on him/her as per the **Regulation 10** related to creation of awards, which says that the president may cancel or annul the awards, after which the name of the awardee would be erased from the records and he would have to surrender it.
  - 2. India's highest civilian award, Bharat Ratna, has been awarded to **38** personalities since **1995. 307** people have been awarded Padma Vibhushan **1,225** Padma Bhushan and **3,005** Padma Shri.

#### INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS PRIZE

Sudanese refugee, Abdul Aziz Muhamad, who spent 5 years in Australian detention centre on Manus Island in Papua New Guinea, was given the Martin Ennals Award 2019 in Geneva, Switzerland, for exposing "the very cruel asylum seeker policy of the Australian Government".



1. It was the first time that the prize focused on the plight of refugees and awarded to someone who has suffered violations due to the policies of a Western nation.



- > MFN status makes sure that any country with this status avoids any disadvantageous situation in comparison to the other partners in trade.
- ➤ It was in 1996 India granted MFN status to Pakistan. Decades of conflict, mistrust and war has resulted in the MFN status.

#### INDIA BOOSTS CUSTOMS DUTY TO 200% ON GOODS IMPORTED FROM PAKISTAN

> India with immediate effect has boosted the **Customs Duty** on all the goods imported from Pakistan to 200% followed by the day after India repealed Most Famous Nation (MFN) status from Pakistan.

#### **Key points:**

- > This punitory move followed by the **Pulwana Terrorist attack** on 14th February, 2019 that led to the death of 42 CRPF (Central Reserve Police Force).
- > This step is likely to strike Pakistan's exports to India which were **\$381 million** in the April-Nov period and for overall FY18, it was **\$489** million.
- > This 200% tariff rate is higher than average bound rate of 113.5% for agriculture products and 34.6% for non-agriculture products.

# 2. Political Science

## 2.1 POLITICAL PARTIES AND POLITICAL SYSTEMS IN INDIA

## ARTICLE 35-A: SUPREME COURT TO TAKE 'IN-CHAMBER' DECISION ON PLEA CHALLENGING THE LEGISLATION

- > The Supreme Court ruled that it would take an 'in-chamber' decision on listing of a petition challenging the constitutional validity of Article 35-A.
- > The ruling was made by a Supreme Court bench comprising **Chief Justice** Ranjan Gogoi and Justices L Nageswara Rao and Sanjiv Khanna.
- > The Article 35-A was added to the Indian Constitution (Appendix II) through a Presidential Order - The Constitution (Application to Jammu and Kashmir) Order, 1954. It provides special rights and privileges to permanent residents of Jammu and Kashmir.

## CHANGES IN THE INDIAN STAMP ACT, 1899 APPROVED BY PRESIDENT RAM NATH KOVIND

> President Nath Ram **Kovind** gave his assent to the amendments to the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, which were introduced in the Parliament as part of the Finance Act 2019. These amendments have been introduced to regularise the system of levying stamp duty and to help in curbing tax evasion.

## **Key points:**

- For the stamp duty rates, the duties levied by **Maharashtra** will be taken as a benchmark as the state accounts for **70%** of the total collection.
- ➤ They propose creation of a **legal and** institutional mechanism which will enable states to collect stamp duty on securities market instruments at one place by one agency (through the Stock Exchanges or Clearing Corporations authorised by the stock exchange or by the Depositories).

- > Wallace's giant bee the largest beek nown on the Earth which was considered to be extinct since 1981 was re-spotted in an **Indonesian** forest.
- > Scientists spotted a female bee of the species **Megachilepluto** and its size is four times the size of the typical European honeybee and has a wingspan of 2.5 inches.

#### 3.2 NATURAL DISASTERS - SAFEGUARD MEASURES

#### GLOBAL WARMING'S IMPACT ON EL NINO IN 2019

- ➤ El Nino is a climatic chain characterized by high air pressure in the **Western Pacific** and low air pressure in the eastern.
  - **1. El Nino** occurs once in every 15 years and results in heavy drought, flood, dust and snow storm resulting in million of dollar loss to the public in Tropical Pacific region
  - 2. El Nino is forecasted to give a rise in vector-borne diseases, including those spread by mosquitoes, in Central and South America. And Drought caused by El Nino can be widespread, affecting southern Africa, India, Southeast Asia, Australia, and the Pacific Islands.



# 4. Economics

#### 4.1 CURRENT SOCIO - ECONOMIC PROBLEMS

#### APRIL-DECEMBER FISCAL DEFICIT TOUCHES 112% OF BUDGET **TARGET**

> India's fiscal deficit has touched 112% of the FY19 Budget target of Rs. **6.24 lakh** crore during the period of 9 months from April to December 2018.

#### **Key Points:**

- > The data was presented by the Controller General of Accountant (CGA) which manifested that fiscal deficit of previous fiscal was 13.6%.
- ➤ Fiscal deficit was at 7 lakh crores during this financial year. This is 112.4% of the Budget estimates for FY19, while for exact figures, it was 113.6% for 2017-2018.
- > Fiscal Deficit is the gap between income and expenditure of the government.

#### INDIA BECOMES WORLD'S SECOND LARGEST CONSUMER AND IMPORTER OF LPG

➤ As per Oil Minister, Dharmendra Pradhan. India has become the **second** largest importer of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) after China due to rising demands of cleaner alternatives to the traditional cooking fuels like firewood and cow dung.



#### **Key Points:**

- ➤ India surpassed Japan as the imports of **LPG grew 12.5**% over the last 5 years to 12 million metric tons.
- ➤ The demand of LPG is expected to rise 34% from 2014 to 2025.
- > In India, LPG is mainly imported from Qatar, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Kuwait and Iran.

### TCS RANKED AS GLOBAL TOP EMPLOYER FOR THIRD YEAR IN A ROW

➤ Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) launched the Human Space Flight Centre (HSFC) which will act as the hub of ISRO's future manned missions at the headquarters of ISRO in Bengaluru, Karnataka.

## **Key Points:**

- ➤ India's first manned mission announced on 15th August 2018 and it is set to happen by 2022 which is going to be the 75th year of Independence.
- ➤ Former ISRO chairman K. Kasturirangan unveiled the full scale model Gaganyaan's crew module in the presence of ISRO's chairman K.Sivan.
- > S.Unnikrishnan Nair and R.Hutton was declared as the founder Director of HSFC and Project Director of Gaganyaan respectively by ISRO chairman Dr. K. Sivan.

INDIA'S 40TH COMMUNICATION SATELLITE, GSAT-31 HAS BEEN SUCCESSFULLY LAUNCHED FROM FRENCH GUIANA

> Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) successfully launched its 40th communication "GSAT-31" satellite from French Guiana by Arianespace launch vehicle

## **Key Points:**

- ➤ **GSAT-31** will enlarge the Ku-band transponder capacity in geostationary orbit and will bestow the linkage to operational services on some of the in-orbit satellites.
- > **GSAT-31** will be beneficial for Television related up-links, connectivity, services, cellular backhaul connectivity, etc.

### ANTI-TANK MISSILE "HELINA" SUCESSFULLY TEST-FIRED IN BALASORE



- test-fired ➤ India Helina. helicopter-launched version of the Nag anti-tank guided missile, with a hit range of 7-8 km, from the Odisha Coast on Friday.
  - 1. Helina was launched from an Army chopper and the weapon system was tested for its full range at 12:55 PM near the Integrated Test Range in Chandipur in the Balasore District of Odisha.
  - 2. Developed by the **Defence** Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), Helina is said to be one of the most advanced anti-tank weapons in the world. It is guided by an Infra-red Imaging Seeker (IIR) operating in the lockon-before-launch mode.

## Related point:

➤ On July 13, 2015, 3 round trials of Helina were conducted at Jaisalmer, Rajasthan. It was also test-fired from **Rudra** helicopter at Pokhran Test Range on August 19, 2018.

## **BEDIN 1- NEW DWARF** SPHEROIDAL GALAXY DISCOVERED BY HUBBLE SPACE **TELESCOPE**

- ➤ Astronomers from Italy, the UK, Germany and the United States discovered newly discovered galaxy consists of red giant particles.
  - 1. This ancient galaxy is one of the oldest galaxy and was named after Luigi Bedin, a researcher at Italy's National Institute for Astrophysics
  - 2. Bedin 1 is located 28.38 million light years from Earth.

## WORLD'S FIRST MAMMAL TO GO EXTINCT DUE TO CLIMATE **CHANGE**



- > A small brown rat of bramble cay melomys species lived on a tiny island off northern Australia and becomes the world's first mammal to have become extinct due to "human-induced climate change". It was found only on a small sand island near the coast of Papua New Guinea.
- > The rat was not seen since 2009 and scientist thought that the mammal might become extinct in 2014.

#### Reason behind its Extinction:

> Extreme high water levels and damaging storm surges, including its sources of food.

#### SUPERBUG GENE' - FIRST DETECTED IN ARCTIC

- > **Superbug'**, An antibiotic-resistant gene Was discovered in **Arctic**, which is one of the pristine place on Earth
  - 1. Superbug was discovered in soil samples from the Kongsfjorden region, a remote place in the High Arctic.
  - 2. Till date, a total of **131 genes** associated with resistance to antibiotics were discovered by the scientists, of which one of the genes first found in **New Delhi in 2008**.

#### ISRO LAUNCHES KALAMSAT, MICROSAT-R SATELLITES ON PSLV-C44 ROCKET

- ➤ The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) launched a students' satellite Kalamsat and an imaging satellite Microsat-R from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh marking its first launch of the ISRO in 2019.
- ➤ The national space agency's rocket, **PSLV C44** carried the satellites into the orbit. After about 14 minutes into the flight, the rocket ejected **700-kg Microsat R satellite** at an altitude of about **277 km**.
- ➤ The Kalamsat is a 10 cm cube **nanosatellite** weighing about 1.2 kg and has a life span of about two months

#### WORLD'S LARGEST DIGITAL SKY SURVEY ISSUES BIGGEST-EVER ASTRONOMICAL DATA RELEASE

- ➤ The Space Telescope Science Institute (STScI) in US in partnership with the University of Hawai's Institute for Astronomy released the second edition of data from Pan-STARRS, the Panoramic Survey Telescope & Rapid Response System the world's largest digital sky survey.
  - 1. This second released survey contained over **1.6 petabytes of data**, which makes it the largest volume of astronomical information ever released.
  - 2. The **Pan-STARRS** observatory consists of a 1.8 meter telescope equipped with a 1.4 billion pixel digital camera, which was the first survey to observe the entire sky visible from **Hawai**.

## 5.2 LATEST DISCOVERIES IN HEALTH SCIENCE

#### A NEW SNAKE SPECIES DISCOVERED IN ARUNACHAL PRADESH

➤ A non-venomous snake species has been discovered by Herpetologists Jayaditya Purkayastha of Help Earth, Guwahati and Patrick David of Museum National d'Histoire Naturelle, Paris in Guwahati, Arunachal Pradesh.

## Key points:

- ➤ The Snake has been named as "Crying Keelback (Hebius lacrima)" due to the presence of black spots below the snake's eye which is taken as an allusion for crying.
- ➤ The 48 mm long Snake is found is "jhum" (shifting) cultivation areas in the Basar area West siang district of Arunachal Pradesh in 2010-11.
- ➤ The Discovery of snake is published in a peer reviewed journal for animal taxonomy known as "Zootaxa".

- ➤ The expressway will provide for better connectivity of the Prayagraj (Allahabad) to Western Pradesh.

#### **Expressway**

- ➤ Expressways are the highest class of roads in the road network in India. National Expressways are the highest c lass of roads in the road network in India. National Expressways Authority of India under the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways is responsible for the construction and maintenance of expressways.
- > Expressways are controlled-access highway, the highest-grade type of highway with access ramps, lane dividers, for high-sped traffic.

#### TELANGANA TO SET UP 'SAVE TIGER PROTECTION FORCE'

- ➤ The Telangana government decided to form a 'State Tiger Protection Force' to save the Big cat population in the State.
  - 1. The State and Central government will share the cost of the force with 112 members headed by the assistant conservator of the forest on 40:60 basis.
  - 2. They are organised to protect the tiger population in the areas of **Amarabad** and Kawal tiger reserves.

#### TRAIN 18 NAMED VANDE BHARAT **EXPRESS: PIYUSH GOYAL**

➤ Union Minister of Railways, Pivush Goval announced that Train 18 which is India's first indigenously developed engineless high speed train has been named as Vande Bharat Express.



#### **Key Points:**

- > The Train will run between **Delhi and Varanasi** at the maximum speed of 160 kmph and it will be flagged off by Prime Minister Narendra Modi soon.
- The Train has 16 coach and it is built in 18 months with a cost of Rs 97 Crore at Modern Coach Factory, Rae Bareli in Uttar Pradesh.

- > United Arab Emirates (UAE) based international cooling provider, National Central Cooling Company PJSC (Tabreed) entered into a 30-year concession with Andhra Pradesh Capital Region Development Authority (APCRDA) to build India's first district cooling system in Amaravati, Hyderabad.
  - 1. The agreement is for a contracted cooling capacity of **20,000 Refrigeration** Tons (RTs) and will cater to the State's Assembly, High Court, Secretariat and other Government buildings currently being constructed, for which cooling services will start in early 2021.
  - 2. The district cooling system will help save **40%** of the energy currently being used and reduce **CO2 emissions**, as it uses only **50%** of the primary energy consumption for cooling urban buildings, thus, improving the air quality and reducing general noise levels when compared to other traditional air conditioning systems.

  - 2. On **6th Feb. 2019**, NATO member states signed an accession protocol allowing North Macedonia to join the alliance and become the 30th member.

- ➤ Earlier, Xinhua also developed **Oiu Hao**. the world's first male AI news anchor at the World Internet Conference in Wuzhen held in November 2018, who is capable of mimicking human facial expressions and mannerisms while reading out news-reports.


# TN BECOMES FIRST STATE IN MAINLAND TO GET 2 COAST GUARD DISTRICTS
