1.1 IMPORTANT DAYS



DRDO Day

➤ The DRDO has made the country self-reliant in areas of missiles, radars, sonars and torpedoes and many other systems.



Aim

➤ The Organisation has been working over the years to develop state of the art weapon system for the country's armed forces.



World Braille Day

➤ To raise awareness on the importance of Braille for approximately 1.3 billion people living with some form of distance or near vision impairment.

Aim

➤ Louis Braille was born on **4th January 1809** in France and he lost his vision at the age of 3.



Pravasi Bharatiya Diwas Day or Non Resident Day

The day is celebrated, marks the contribution of overseas Indian community in the development of India.



AIM

- ➤ To strengthen the engagement of the overseas Indian community with the Government of India and reconnect them with their roots.
- ➤ On 9th January 2019, Mahatma Gandhi came to India from South Africa and became the greatest Pravasi who led India's freedom Struggle.



World Hindi Day

➤ Marking the anniversary of first **World Hindi Conference** which was held in 1975 and inaugurated by the prime minister **Indira Gandhi.**

celebrated as 26th Army Air Defence Day

- ➤ A wreath Laying Ceremony was held at the Amar Jawan Jyoti at India Gate, New Delhi.
- ➤ The Corps of Army Air Defence is the youngest arm of Indian Army.

Army Air Defence Corps:

- ➤ Headquarters: New Delhi.
- ➤ Motto: "Akashe Shatrun Jahi" (Kill the Enemy in the Sky).



National Youth Day

➤ In **1984**, Indian Government first declared to celebrate the birthday of Swami Vivekananda i.e. 12 January as National Youth Day.

AIM

- ➤ Since from **1985**, it is celebrated as the National Youth Day all over the country.
- ➤ The main aim of the Government is to make better future for the country by motivating the youth in the way of their life and ideas of Swami Vivekananda.



352nd Prakash Utsav of Guru Gobind Singh celebrate

➤ The **352nd** birth anniversary of the **10th Sikh** Guru, **Guru Govind Singh ji**, was celebrated as **Prakash utsav** at **Patna Sahib**, in **Bihar**, the birth place of Guruji.

AIM

- 1. The main function was organised at **Takhat Sri Harmandir Sahib Gurdwara**, Patna Sahib.
- 2. Guru Govind Singh ji was the creator of **Khalsa Panth**.
- 3. The **10th Sikh Guru** was a spiritual leader, philosopher, poet and master warrior.



Armed Forces Veterans Day

- ➤ The main motive behind this celebration is to honour the ex-servicemen and resolve the problems faced by them after their retirement.
- > 69th Army day is to be celebrated on January 15, 2019



AIM:

- > The main celebration in **Delhi** took place at New Delhi. Minister of State (Defence) **Dr Subhash Bhambre** inaugurated the main event.
- > This Day is commemorated in the memory of first Indian Commanderin-Chief of the Armed Forces Field Marshal K M Cariappa becoming a veteran in 1953. To mark the occasion, veteran rallies will be held country wide at Armed Forces stations.



2019 celebrated as 71st Army Day

➤ An annual parade was held at the **Carriappa Parade Ground in New Delhi** to celebrate the 71st anniversary of **the Indian Army** Day.

AIM:

- 1. **January 15** is celebrated as the Indian Army Day to commemorate our soldiers for their bravery and sacrifice.
- 2. This day was constituted by **Field Marshall KM Cariappa** who took over as the first Indian Army chief in 1949.



Manipur, Meghalaya, Tripura celebrating Statehood day

- ➤ Manipur, Meghalaya and Tripura are celebrating their statehood day. It is their 42nd statehood day.
- ➤ Tripura is the **second** largest rubber producer after Kerala.

Keys points to be noted:

- ➤ In the year 1972, all the three states became full-fledged states under the North Eastern Region (Reorganisation) Act, 1971.
- ➤ The erstwhile princely states of Tripura and Manipur were merged with India in 1949 and became full-fledged states in 1972.
- ➤ Meghalaya was a part of Assam before it was carved out as a full-fledged state under the **North Eastern Region (Re-Organisation) Act, 1971**.

Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's Birth Anniversary

➤ 122nd Birth Anniversary of the great Freedom Fighter Subhas Chandra Bose was celebrated all over India.

Key Points : Subash Chandra Bose was a member of the Indian National Congress and later he formed Indian National Army also known as **Azad Hind Fauz.**

- > Subhas Chandra Bose popularly known as Netaji was born on 23rd January 1897 and died on 18th August 1945.
- ➤ Recently 3 islands of Andaman and Nicobar Ross Island, Neil Island and Havelock Island has been named as Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep, Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep by Prime Minister Narendra Modi to mark the 75th anniversary of raising of the Indian National Flag by Subhas Chandra Bose.

National Girl Child Day

➤ Theme 2019- "Empowering Girls for a Brighter Tomorrow"

AIM:

➤ Women and Child Development Ministry celebrated the National Girl Child Day 2019 at Pravasi Bharti Kendra, New Delhi. Observed the anniversary of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme.

International Day of Education: 24 January

➤ The **United Nations General Assembly** adopted with consensus a resolution proclaiming **24**th **January as International Day of Education**, in celebration of the role of education for peace and development.

1.2 PROFILE OF STATES

HOME MINISTRY APPROVED UP'S PROPOSAL OF RENAMING ALLAHABAD AS PRAYAGRAJ

- ➤ Ahead of the **'Kumbh Mela** 2019'. the Union Home Ministry (MHA) approved the **Uttar Pradesh** government's proposal to rename Allahabad as Pravagraj.
- ➤ MHA had earlier approved the renaming of the British-era railway station Robertsgang as



Sonbhadra, Farah Town railway station near Mathura and iconic Mughalsarai junction after **Deen Dayal Upadhyay** — both in Uttar Pradesh.

Other State profile:

- > The Centre had also approved the renaming of Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport in Mumbai as Chhatrapati Shivaji 'Maharaj' International Airport, earlier.
- ➤ The Tripura government also got Centre's approval to change the name of Agartala Airport as Maharaja Bir Bikram Manikya Kishore, the erstwhile ruler of the state.

1.3 DEFENCE

CENTRE BANS KHALISTAN LIBERATION **FORCE**

➤ The **Khalistan** movement in Punjab, the **Khalistan** Liberation Force (KLF) has been banned under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA) by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA).

Khalistan Movement:

- > The Khalistan movement is a Sikh separatist movement, which seeks to create a separate country called Khalistan ("The Land of the Pure") in the **Punjab** region of South Asia to serve as a homeland for Sikhs.
- The territorial definition of the proposed country Khalistan consists of the current Punjab, India.

- > Founded by Aroor **Singh**, the outfit had been active in promoting secessionist activities till 1994.
- ➤ It was subsequently revived by **Harminder** Singh Mintoo who died of cardiac arrest in April 2018 in Patiala Central Jail where he was lodged.

INDIA-MYANMAR BILATERAL ARMY EXERCISE, IMBEX 2018 - 19 HELD IN CHANDIMANDIR

- India-Myanmar bilateral army exercise, IMBEX had begun at Chandimandir, headquarters of the Western Command in Chandigarh.
 - It is the **second edition** of the IMBEX EXERCISE.
 - 2. The motive of IMBEX 2018-19 is to train the Myanmar delegation for participation in United Nations peace keeping operations under the UN flag.

INDIA-MYANMAR JOINT TRAINING EXERCISE BEGINS IN CHANDIMANDIR

- Second edition of the India-Myanmar bilateral army exercise, IMBEX 2018-19, commenced at Chandimandir Military Station, that houses the headquarters of the Western Command, Chandigarh.
- ➤ The aim of this joint training programme, spread over six days, is to train the Myanmar delegation for participation in United Nations peacekeeping operations under the UN flag.

TAMIL NADU DEFENCE PRODUCTION QUAD

NIRMALA SITHARAMAN LAUNCHED TAMIL NADU DEFENCE INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR

- Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launched a series of projects as a part of the Tamil Nadu Defence Industrial Corridor in Tiruchirppalli.
- ➤ This is considered to be the second corridor succeeding the one launched in **Aligarh**, **Uttar Pradesh**.

WOMEN TO GET 20% JOBS IN MILITARY POLICE

- ➤ The Union Defence minister Nirmala Sitharaman has announced the decision to induct women in Personnel Below Office Rank, PBOR, role in Corps of Military Police.
- ➤ The women will be inducted in a graded manner to eventually comprise 20% of total Corps of Military Police. Accordingly, the Army chalked out induction of approximately 800 women in military police with a yearly intake of 52 personnel per year.

ROLE OF WOMEN IN MILITARY POLICE For the following roles:

- ➤ Investigation of offences such as rape, molestation, thefts etc.
- ➤ Military operations of nature where Army needs assistance from police organisations.
- ➤ Assisting civil police/administration for evacuation in forward villages during hostilities.
- ➤ Crowd control of refugees comprising women and children.
- ➤ Searching/Frisking of women during cordon & search operations/check posts.
- ➤ Ceremonial and Policing Duties: Maintaining military discipline.
- ➤ Manning the Prisoner of War Camps.

INDIAN NAVY COORDINATES LARGEST EVER COASTAL **DEFENCE EXERCISE 10 YEARS AFTER "26/11"**

> Indian Navy commenced largest ever coastal defence exercise SEA VIGIL in Indian Coast. It covered 7516.6km Indian Coastline and Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of India.

'SEA VIGIL' FOR COASTAL SECURI

- Exercise being undertaken along the entire 7516.6km coastline and Exclusive Economic Zone of India
- Aims to comprehensively and holistically validate the efficacy of the measures taken for coastal defence since 26/11
- It will provide a realistic assessment of our strengths and weaknesses



Mock drills and simulation of terror attacks will be conducted on Wednesday

Kev Points:

- ➤ The exercise is conducted in collaboration with Ministry of Defence, Home Affairs, Shipping, Petroleum and Natural Gas, Fisheries, Customs, State Governments and other agencies of Centre and States.
- ➤ The aim of the Exercise Sea Vigil is to validate the effectiveness of measures taken since terror attack in Mumbai on 26/11.
- ➤ It tests the country's preparation to prevent any attempt to carry out attack or infiltration through sea route.
- > Sea Vigil Exercise was a tri service exercise TROPEX (Theatre-level Readiness Operational Exercise) which is conducted by Indian Navy once in 2 years.

IAFTX 2019: INDIA AFRICA FIELD TRAINING EXERCISE HELD IN PUNE

- > The final planning conference to work out the modalities for **Indian Africa Field** Training Exercise (IAFTX)-2019 was conducted at Pune, Maharashtra.
- > The joint training exercise is being conducted with more than a dozen African countries & India. It aims at synergysing humanitarian mine action and joint peace operations.

1.4 SUMMIT & CONFERENCE

HO DG PRAISES AYUSHMAN BHARAT SCHEME

- > Director General of World Health Organization, Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus has expressed happiness that India's ambitious Ayushman Bharat scheme has provided free care to almost **7 lakh** people in its first 100 days.
- > The Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana, aims to provide insurance cover of five lakh rupees per annum to 50 crore poor people.
- The world's largest ambitious health care scheme, aims to benefit more than 10 crore poor families in the country.

25TH EDITION OF PARTNERSHIP SUMMIT HELD IN MUMBAI



- > The **25th** edition of the **CII Partnership** Summit 2019, a global platform for dialogue, debate. deliberation engagement among Indian and global leaders on economic policy and growth trends in India, kicked off in Mumbai, Maharashtra. The event will be concluded on 13th January 2019.
- > The inaugural session of the summit themed at 'New India: Rising to Global Occasions' will be attended by over 1000 delegates from 40 countries.
- ➤ This edition of the summit will showcase India in the present landscape of an emerging "New India", the "New Global Economic Address".

ARAB ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT SUMMIT HELD IN BEIRUT



The Arab Economic and Social Development Summit place in **Lebanon's** capital **Beirut** in which the Arab leaders have agreed a 29-item economic agenda in addition to encouraging the safe return of Syrian refugees to their homeland.

Key Points:

➤ About 20 countries took part in the summit and issued a joint statement called the Beirut Declaration called for the establishment of an Arab free trade zone and the international community to support countries hosting refugees and displaced people.


2ND WORLD INTEGRATED MEDICINE FORUM 2019 INAUGURATED IN GOA

➤ Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for AYUSH, Shripad Naik 2nd World inaugurated Integrated Medicine Forum 2019 in Goa. International drug regulators who are dealing with homeopathic or traditional medicines from various countries participated in the forum.



JAPAN'S PASSPORT RANKED WORLD'S MOST POWERFUL, INDIA'S 79TH

- According to the Henley Passport Index, **Japan** has retained its **top spot** as the world's most powerful passport this year, with its citizens able to enter 190 countries without requiring a visa.
- **India's** passport was ranked **79th**, having visa-free access to 61 destinations.
- **Singapore** and **South Korea** come **second** with access to 189 countries each while France and Germany share the third spot with access to 188 countries each.



About the Report:

- > The report's findings are based on the annual Global Risks Perception Survey, which asks the Forum's network of business, government, civil society and taught leaders to gauge the risks facing our world.
- The risks in the report has been divided into 2 parts:
- > Top 10 Risks by Likelihood and Top 10 Risks by Impact.
- ➤ Further the risks were divided into 5 categories of: (1)economic vulnerabilities, (2) geopolitical tensions, (3) societal and political strains, (4) environmental fragilities, and (5) technological instabilities.
- ➤ It was done in partnership with: Marsh McLennan Companies and Zurich Insurance Group.

1.5 EMINENT PERSONS

BARACK OBAMA NAMED MOST ADMIRED MAN

- ➤ Former President of United States of America (USA), Barack Obama has been named as the most admired man by Americans for the 11th year in a row according to a gallup poll. Present President of USA, Donald TRUMPS is ranked 2nd for the fourth consecutive vear.
 - of USA 1. Former First Lady Michelle Obama was also voted as the most admired women by Americans.
 - 2. Hillary Clinton missed the top of the list for the First time in 17 years.

FIRST FORT BEND COUNTY **JUDGE**



- ➤ Indian-American **KP George** sworn in as the Fort Bend County Judge, becoming the first person from the community to hold the office of one of America's most diverse counties.
- ➤ Mr.George, 53, a Democrat and Fort Bend Independent School District Board trustee, defeated Republican Judge Robert Hebert in November polls.

SUBASH CHANDRA BOSE AAPDA PRABANDHAN PURASKAAR


- The central government has launched Subash Chandra Bose **Aapda** annual Prabandhan Puraskaar awards to recognise the excellent work done by individuals and institutions in the country in the field of disaster management.
- ➤ The award has been instituted with an aim to recognise the efforts of individuals and organisations who have been working assiduously to alleviate human suffering caused by disasters.



About the Award


➤ As per the statement issued by the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) three eligible institutions and individuals will be given the 'Subash Chandra Bose Aapda Prbandhan Puraskaar' every year with cash rewards ranging from Rs.5 lakh to Rs.51 lakh. Only Indian nationals and Indian Institutions are eligible for this award.

RAMAKANT ACHREKAR PASSED AWAY



- 1990 Dronacharya awardee cricket coach Ramakant Achrekar, who coached Cricketer Sachin Tendulkar passed away at 86.
 - 1. Besides **Tendulkar**, he also coached other prominent players like Vinod Kambli, Pravin Amre, Sameer Dighe and Balwinder Singh Sandhu.
 - 2. Because of his contribution to the sport, he was honoured with Padma Shri in 2010.
 - 3. The Kamath Memorial Cricket Club in **Dadar** was founded by him.

APARNA KUMAR FIRST FEMALE IPS TO REACH THE SOUTH POLE



- > Aparna kumar, 2002 batch IPS officer of Uttar **Pradesh** is the first serving officer to finish this daunting challenge
- ➤ Aparna already became the first officer of the All India Services to have successfully climbed Antarctica's highest peak Mount Vinson Massif in 2016 and then climbed Mount Manaslu in the west-central part of Nepal in 2017.

HIGHEST PEAK OF **ANTARCTICA**



➤ 30 years old former National level Volleyball turned player mountaineer. Arunima Sinha became the world's first female amputee to climb Mount Vinson. highest the peak Antarctica.

Key Points:

- ➤ The Padma Shree Awardee. Arunima Sinha became the first woman amputee climb Mount Everest in 2013
- > She is from Uttar Pradesh and had lost one of her legs in a horrific incident in which she was thrown off the Padmawati Express train in 2011.
- ➤ Arunima Sinha's aim is to summit seven peaks across seven continents. She had already scaled five peaks which are Mt Everest, Mt Kilimanjaro, Mt Ebrus. Mt Kosciuszko and Mt Aconcagua.

INDIA'S SATYARUP SIDDHANTA BECAME WORLD'S YOUNGEST MOUNTAINEER TO CLIMB 7 PEAKS, 7 VOLCANO SUMMITS

- ➤ Software engineer and mountaineer **Satyarup** Siddhanta, hailing from Haridevpur in South Kolkata, became the first Indian and youngest man to climb the seven highest peaks and volcanic summits across all continents.

 - 1. This feat was attained after he conquered Antartica's highest point, Mount Sidley.
 - 2. He achieved the feat at the age of 35 years and 262 days.
 - 3. In 2018, Satyarup had scaled the highest volcanic peak in North America, Pico de Orizaba.
 - 4. He beat the record of Australia's Daniel Bull who had done it at the age of 36 years 157 days.

WORLD'S OLDEST MAN MASAZO NONAKA DIES IN JAPAN AGED 113

- ➤ World's oldest man **Masazo Nonaka** died due to natural causes in the Japan's northern most island of Hokkaido at the age of **113**.
 - 1. Masazo Nonaka was born on 25 July 1905 and have lived with his four generation family.



2. Japan has one of the world's highest life expectancies. The Longest living man on record Jiroemon Kimura who died after his 116th birthday in June 2013 was also from Japan.

1.6 PLACES IN NEWS

INDIA TO BUILD NEW VERTICAL BRIDGE TO REPLACE PAMBAN BRIDGE

- ➤ Indian Railways is building the country's first vertical-lift bridge to connect **Rameswaram** in the **Arabian Sea** to mainland India. The bridge will allow ships and stammers to pass through without any hindrance.
- ➤ The new bridge would replace the 104-year-old existing Pamban **bridge**. It would be ready in the next four years.



About the New Vertical Bridge

- > The New Bridge will have a **63-metre** stretch which will lift up while remaining parallel to the deck to allow access to the ships. The lifting would be done using sensors at each end.
- > The new bridge will have **Electro-Mechanical** controlled systems which will be interlocked with train control systems in place of existing manual operation and control.

1.7 SPORTS & GAMES

FIRST PERSON TO MAKE THE 1,600 KM JOURNEY WITHOUT ANY ASSISTANCE

- ➤ An American adventurer (Colin O' Brady, 33) has become the first person to complete a solo trek across **Antarctica** without assistance of any kind.
- ➤ He took 54 days to complete nearly **1,600 km** journey, crossing the frozen continent from coast to coast.
- > Mr. O'Brady an Englishman and Louis Rudd, 49, set off individually on **November 3** from **Union Glacier** in a bid to be the first to complete a solo, unassisted crossing the Antarctic.
- ➤ In **1996-97**, a **Norwegian** polar explorer, **Borge Ousland**, made the first solo crossing of **Antarctica** but he was wind-aided by kites on his voyage.

LAUREUS WORLD COMEBACK OF YEAR AWARD

- > Indian female wrestler Vinesh Phogat, who hails from Haryana, became the first Indian athlete to receive a nomination in the prestigious Laureus World Comeback of the Year Award.
- > She was nominated due to her comeback after battling a long injury lay-off to win a gold medal at the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games and Jakarta Asian Games.

ICC ANNOUNCES MEN'S TEST AND ODI TEAMS OF THE YEAR

> The International Cricket Council (ICC) announced the Men's Test and ODI teams of the year with Virat Kohli as the Captain of both teams following his brilliant performance in 2018 as a Batsman as well as a Captain.

DHONI BECOMES FIFTH INDIAN TO REACH 10000 RUN MARK IN ODIS




Key Points:

1.12 INDIA & ITS NEIGHBOURS

INDIA & PAKISTAN'S 28TH **EXCHANGED LISTS OF NUCLEAR INSTALLATIONS**

- > India, Pakistan exchanged lists of nuclear installations and list of prisoners for the 28th time through diplomatic channels in New Delhi and Islamabad.
 - 1. This was done under the Agreement on the **Prohibition of Attack against** Nuclear installations that was signed in December 1988 which came into force in January 1991.
 - 2. The pact states that two countries must inform each other of nuclear facilities to be covered under the agreement on January 1 every year.
 - 3. India handed over a list of 249 Pakistani civilian prisoners and 98 fishermen in its custody.
 - 4. The Pakistani side handed over a list of 537 prisoners 54 civilians and 483 fishermen — in its jails.
 - 5. The first such exchange was done in **January 1, 1992**.

The court had asked the government to maintain transparency in the process.

- ➤ Mysore-born **Gita Gopinath** joined **International Monetary Fund (IMF)** as its 11th chief economist, thus becoming the first woman to occupy the top IMF post.
- > She succeeded **Maurice Obstfeld** who retired on December 31, 2018.
- ➤ She is the John Zwaanstra professor of International Studies and Economics at Harvard University.

SC REINSTATED ALOK VERMA AS CBI CHIEF

- > Supreme Court, as per orders penned by **Chief Justice of India** Ranjan Gogoi, reinstated CBI Director Alok Kumar Verma without giving him any major policy decision making powers.
- > This was done against the October 23 2018 decision which had earlier divested him of his powers completely as per the corruption charges brought against him
- ➤ The Central Vigilance Commission inquiry against those charges will further steps be taken against him by the high-powered committee which selects and appoints the CBI Director.

PRESIDENT OF THE GLOBAL SOLAR COUNCIL

> Pranav R Mehta, President of the National Solar Energy Federation of India has become the president of the Global Solar Council. He has become the first Indian to head the Global Solar Council.

- ➤ Global Solar Council is an international non-profit association of the national. Regional and International associations in solar energy and the World's leading corporations.
- ➤ The Global Solar Council headquartered in Washington D.C., USA. came into being following the historic United Nations Climate Change Conference (UN COP 21).

PRANAV R MEHTA BECOMES LT GEN J S NAIN TOOK OVER AS 14TH COMMANDER OF ARMY'S RISING STAR CORPS



- > Lt Gen J S Nain took over as the 14th Corps Commander of the Rising Star Corps from Lt Gen Y V K Mohan in Jammu.
 - 1. He is a soldier and an alumnus of the National Defence Academy.
 - 2. Based in Yol cantonment town Kangra Valley, southeast of Dharamsala in Himachal Pradesh, the Rising Star Corps was raised in 2005 and is the Indian Army's youngest corps.

SWAMY APPOINTED KARNATAKA HC ACTING CJ

➤ The President of India Shri Ram Nath Kovind using the power conferred to him under Article 223 of the Constitution appointed Justice Lingappa Narayana **Swamy** as the Acting Chief Justice of the Karnataka High Court.

RAJA KRISHNAMOORTHI IS AP-POINTED AS A NEW MEMBER OF HPSCI FOR THE 116TH CON-GRESS

- > Raja Krishnamoorthi, a Democratic lawmaker. has been appointed as a member of a Congressional committee on intelligence. He is the first South Asian to serve in the powerful body tasked to strengthen **U.S.'s national security**. Mr.Krishnamoorthi. 45. represents Illinois's 8th Congressional District in the House.
- ➤ Along with him Congresswoman **Val** Demings of Florida, Sean Patrick Maloney of New York and Peter **Welch** of Vermont has been appointed as new Democratic members of House Permanent the Select Committee on Intelligence (HPSCI) for the 116th Congress. The HPSCI oversees the activities and budget of the 17 intelligence agencies of the U.S.

PIYUSH GOYAL NAMED INTERIM FINANCE MINISTER



- Piyush Goyal has been named the interim Finance Minister and interim Minister of Corporate Affairs during Arun Jaitley's indisposition. Goyal will retain his existing portfolios of coal and railways.
- Union Minister Arun Jaitley, 66, had left for the United States for a regular medical check-up. Jaitley will be designated as a minister without a portfolio during his period of indisposition.

NAVY CHIEF ADMIRAL SUNIL LANBA COMMISSIONED NEW NAVAL AIR BASE 'INS KOHASSA'

- > Indian Navy Chief Admiral Sunil Lanba commissioned the new Naval Air Base 'INS Kohassa' at Diglipur in Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- ➤ The airbase will be used to handle operations of helicopters and small aircraft like the Dornier.
- ➤ The new airbase in the northernmost part of the Andaman Nicobar Islands will be used for both Defence and civil aircraft.





2. Political Science

2.1 POLITICAL PARTIES AND POLITICAL SYSTEMS IN INDIA

PRESIDENT GAVE HIS ASSENT TO 2 STATE BILLS OF TAMIL NADU AND HIMACHAL PRADESH

- > President Ram Nath Kovind approved two state bills of Tamil Nadu and Himachal Pradesh.
 - 1. The Tamil Nadu Vanniyakula Kshatriya Public Charitable Trusts and Endowments (Protection and Maintenance) Bill 2018.
 - 2. The Himachal Pradesh Early Childhood Care and Education Centers (Registration and Regulation) Bill 2017.

About the Tamil Nadu bill:

- ➤ It aims to prevent misuse, misappropriation of properties and income by people.
- ➤ It will apply to all charitable trusts and endowments created and administered by persons or organisations of the Vanniyakula Kshatriya community.

Background:

- ➤ Many members of the community donated their properties for charitable purposes through trusts and endowments and such properties, in most cases, were neither utilised, nor maintained.
- > The state government decided to constitute a separate board to save the properties and administer them without any hindrance.

About the Himachal Pradesh Bill:

- > It aims to bring the early childhood care and education centres in the state under government monitoring.
- ➤ This will enable equal access, quality and commercialisation to childcare centres that are controlled by trusts, societies, religious groups or international funding agencies.

Background:

- > As per the 86th Constitutional Amendment Act of 2002, Article 45 of the Directive Principles of State Policy states that "the State shall endeavour to provide early childhood care and education for all children until they complete the age of 6 years".
- ➤ Under **Article 200**, the Governor can reserve a bill passed by the legislature for the consideration of the President.

LOK SABHA PASSES TRIPLE TALAQ BILL

- ➤ The Lok Sabha has passed the Muslim Women (Protection of Rights on Marriage) Bill, famously referred to as Triple Talaq Bill. The bill would replace the ordinance passed in the month of September.
- > The opposition members AIADMK Congress an staged the walkout demanding that the government must refer the bill to the joint select committee.

Features of the Bill

> Talag-e-biddat (Triple Talag)

• It refers to the practice sunder Muslim personal laws where pronouncement of the world 'talaq' thrice on one sitting by a Muslim man to his wife results in an instant and irrevocable divorce,

Cognizable offence

• A cognizable offence is one for which a police officer may arrest an accused person without a warrant.

> Compounding of offence

• Compounding of offence refers to a procedure where the two sides agree to stop legal proceedings, and settle the dispute.

IMPORTANT CABINET **APPROVALS**

- ➤ The Union Cabinet chaired by **Prime** Minister Narendra Modi has given the following set of approvals.

AADHAAR AMENDMENT BILL INTRODUCED IN LOK SABHA

- > The government introduced a bill in the Lok Sabha that permits the individuals to voluntary offer Aadhaar as a means of identity verification for obtaining services such as opening a bank account and getting a mobile phone connection.
- ➤ The bill, which seeks to amend three separate laws governing Aadhaar, telecom sector. and banking regulation, also gives a minor an option to opt out of the 12-digit identity scheme on attaining the age of 18 years.

PRESIDENT OF INDIA GIVES ASSENT TO THE CONSTITUTION THE REDRAFTED CITIZENSHIP (ONE HUNDRED AND THIRD AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019

> The President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind has given his assent to the Constitution (One Hundred and third Amendment) Act, 2019 which grants 10 per cent reservation in iobs and educational institutions to the economically weaker sections in the general category.

Key Points:

- > The Act amends Articles 15 and 16 of the Constitution to provide reservation to the economically weaker sections in the general category.
- ➤ The 10 per cent reservation will be in addition to the existing 50 per cent reservation for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes (OBC) making the total reservation quota 60%.
- > Following group of general category people are eligible for the reservation as per the law
 - Families with Income below Rs 8 lakh per annum.
 - People possessing agricultural land below five acres and residential house below 1000 square feet.
 - For Urban areas, people living in residential plot below 100 yards in notified municipality and residential plot below 200 yards in the non-notified municipal areas.

UNION CABINET CLEARED AMENDMENT BILL

> The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi cleared the redrafted Citizenship Amendment Bill thus providing Indian citizenship to non-Muslims from Bangladesh, Afghanistan and Pakistan.

Features of the Bill:

- > First introduced in Parliament in 2016, the bill seeks to amend the Citizenship Act 1955.
- ➤ It enables grant of Indian nationality to people from minority communities Hindus. Sikhs. **Buddhists.** Jains. Parsis and Christiansfrom Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan after six years of residence in India instead of 12 even if they don't possess any proper document.
- > The 1985 Assam Accord under which any foreign national, irrespective of religion, who had entered the state after 1971 should be deported.

10% OUOTA FOR THE POOR GETS LS APPROVAL

- ➤ The Lok Sabha on Tuesday passed a Bill allowing 10% quota employment and education for the general category candidates who belong to the economically weaker sections.
- ➤ The Constitution (124th Amendment) Bill, 2019, introduced by Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment Thawar Chand Gehlot, was cleared with a majority of the members (319) voting for it, and four against.

LOK SABHA PASSES CITIZENSHIP AMENDMENT BILL

- ➤ The Lok Sabha on January 8, 2019 passed the Citizenship (Amendment) Bill, which seeks to amend the Citizenship Act, 1955 to make illegal migrants who are Hindus, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, Parsis and Christians from Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan, eligible for citizenship. The bill has now been tabled in the Raiva Sabha.
- > Under the 1955 Act, one of the requirements citizenship for bv naturalisation is that the applicant must have resided in India during the last 12 months and for 11 of the previous 14 years.
- > The bill relaxes this 11-year requirement to six years for persons belonging to the all the six religions from the three countries.

UP THIRD STATE TO APPROVE QUOTA FOR POOR AMONG UPPER CASTES

- > Uttar Pradesh became the third state after Jharkhand and Gujarat to approve the 10 per cent reservation for economically backward among upper castes in jobs educational institutions.
- > The Approval was given in a meeting headed by Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister, Yogi Adityanath.
- ➤ The Reservation for the poor among upper castes came into effect on 14th January 2019, when Parliament passed "The Constitution (124 Amendment) Bill 2019".

PARLIAMENT PASSES NCTE AMENDMENT BILL

> The Parliament following the approval from the Rajya-Sabha passed a bill to provide retrospective recognition to central and state government funded institutions offering B.Ed and related courses that are not recognized under the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act.

Key Points:

- > The NCTE (Amendment) Bill which will be a one-time measure would help over 17,000 students who have obtained B.Ed degrees from those institutions which do not have NCTE approval for the course under the 1993 law.
- ➤ 23 state and central universities and colleges offering B.Ed courses were found not recognised by the Council.

About National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993:

> The NCTE Act, 1993 came into force on 1 July 1995 and is applicable throughout the country, except the State of Jammu and Kashmir. The NCTE plans and co-ordinates the development of the teacher education system throughout the country and ensure maintenance of norms and standards in the teacher education system.

2.2 LATEST COURT VERDICTS

CABINET APPROVED 10 PC **QUOTA FOR ECONOMICALLY** WEAKER SECTIONS IN GENERAL CATEGORY

- > The Union Cabinet chaired by **Prime** Minister Narendra Modi approved 10 pc quota in jobs and educational institutions for economically weaker sections in general category.
- > For the implementation of the quota, Articles 15 and 16 of the Constitution will have to be amended.

About the features:

- > This would be availed by those whose annual income is below Rs 8 lakh and have up to five acres of land.
- > The quota will be over and above the existing 50 per cent reservation.

About Articles 15 & 16:

- > Articles 15, 16 falls under the category of Fundamental Rights in the Part III of the Indian Constitution.
- > Article 15 states that the State shall not discriminate against any citizen on grounds only of religion, race, caste, sex, place of birth or any of them. Also nothing in this article shall prevent the state from making any special provisions for women, children or any socially and educationally backward classes.
- > Article 16 guarantees the Equality of opportunity in matters of public employment with no discrimination being done on basis of religion, race, caste, sex, place of birth.

FIVE - JUDGE CONSTITUTION BENCH LED BY CJI GOGOI TO **HEAR AYODHYA LAND** DISPUTE CASE

> The Supreme Court on January 8, 2019 set up a five-judge Constitution Bench to hear the Ram Janmabhoomi-Babri Masjid land title dispute case.

What is the case?

- ➤ In the Ram Janmabhoomi-Babri Masjid Case 14 appeals were filled against the 2010 Allahabad High Court judgement. verdict of the Allahabad High Court judgment had partitioned the 2.77. acre land equally among the three parties - the Sunni Waqf Board, the Nirmohi Akhara and Ram Lalla.
- ➤ The Allahabad High Court had concluded that Lord Ram, son of King Dashrath, was born within the 1,482.5 square yards of the Ramjanmabhoomidisputed Babri Masjid premises over 9,00,000 years ago during the Treta Yuga.

Ram Janmabhoomi-Babri **Masjid Dispute**

➤ The Masjid-Ram Babri Janmabhoomi case is a property dispute over the land where the Babri Masjid, a 16th-century mosque once stood. The mosque was razed by kar sevaks on 6 December 1992.

SC SETS UP PANEL FOR TO SUGGEST REFORMS FOR HOLDING **COMPETITIVE EXAMS**

> Supreme court has set up a committee to set reforms to hold the competitive exams after the conflicts that arose in ssc examination.the committee includes Nandan Nilekani, a co-founder of tech giant Infosys, and renowned computer scientist Vijay P Bhatkar.

2.3 GOVT. - WELFARE ORIENTED GOVT SCHEMES, THEIR UTILITY

MADHYA PRADESH GOVERNMENT TO CREATE AN ADHYATMIK VIBHAG (SPIRITUAL DEPARTMENT)

> The Government of Madhya Pradesh has announced setting up of a new Adhyatmik Vibhag (Spiritual department). The proposed new department will be set up by merging several existing departments.

Anand Vibhag (Happiness Department)

➤ Madhya Pradesh has become the first state in the country to create Happiness Department. The government has also announced the setting up of the Happiness Institute.

ONE DISTRICT, ONE PRODUCT SCHEME OF UTTAR PRADESH

- > The Government of Uttar Pradesh has initiated One District, One Product scheme to encourage indigenous and specialized products and crafts of the state.
- ➤ The scheme aims to capitalize the rich heritage of the Uttar Pradesh by reviving them through modernization and publicisation to enhance the reach of these products.

Objective of the Scheme

- **Uttar Pradesh** is a vast State with vast diversity in all facts of life. The diversity of products and crafts in UP is breathtaking. The vast diversity encompasses the ancient and nutritious Kala namak rice, the rare and intriguing wheat-stalk craft, world-famous chikankari and zari-zardozi work on clothes.
- > The intricate and stunning horn and bone work that uses the remains of dead animals rather than live ones, a nature-friendly replacement for ivory.

ADHYATMIK VIBHAGM (SPIRITUAL DEPARTMENT)

The **Congress - led Madhya Pradesh Govern ment** an nounced that it is going to create an Adhyat mik Vibhag (spiritual depart ment) by merging several existing depart ment.

Key Points:

- > The Congress had promised to form such a department before the last month's Assembly elections.
- > The proposed Adhyatmik Vibhag (Spiritual Department) going to be formed by merging Dharmik Nyas Evam Dharmasv Department (Religious Trust and Endowment Department), Anand Vibhag (Happiness Department) in addition to the Directorate of Religious Trust and Endowment, Madhya Pradesh Teerth Evam Mela Pradhikaran and Rajya Anand Sansthan. Madhya Pradesh had become the first state in the country to create Happiness Department.

PRESIDENT OF INDIA PRESENTS PRADHAN MANTRI RASHTRIYA BAL **PURASKAR**

> Shri Ram Nath Kovind. the President of India, the presented Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Ba1 Puraskar 2019 at Rashtrapati Bhavan in New Delhi.



Key Points:

- > The awards were presented in the presence of **Smt Maneka Sanjay Gandhi**, Union Minister for Women and Child Development and other dignitaries.
- > The Awards were given in two categories Bal Shakti Puraskar (erstwhile known as National Child Award) for which 26 children were shortlisted and Bal Kalyan Puraskar (erstwhile known as National Child Welfare Award) for which 2 individuals and 3 institutions were awarded.

SHEHRI SAMRIDHI UTSAV

- > Housing and Urban Affairs Minister, Hardeep Singh Puri announced that Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs will organize a fortnight of events named Shehri Samridhi Utsav from 1st February to 15th February 2019.
 - 1. The Shehr Samridhi Utsav focusing on urban livelihoods will be celebrated all over the country with active participation from states and cities.
 - 2. The event is aimed at extending the outreach of **Deendayal Antyodaya** Yojana -National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY - NULM).

'ONE FAMILY, ONE JOB' SCHEME IN ROJGAR **MELA 2019**

- > Sikkim Chief Minister Pawan Kumar Chamling launched the 'One Family One Job' scheme, under which for every family one government job has been allotted, in Gangtok.
- ➤ New recruits were taken for Group C and Group D posts in 12 departments.
- ➤ As part of the scheme, a "Rojgar Mela" (employment fair) was organised at the Paljor stadium in Gangtok, where over 12,000 unemployed youths, from 32 constituencies, were handed out appointment letters.
- ➤ Sikkim became the first state in the country to carry out such a programme for the people entitling them to state government employee benefits.



Background:

➤ CM Chamling is the longest serving CM of the Independent India.

WB GOVT ANNOUNCES TWO INITIATIVES FOR FARMERS

➤ The Mamata Banerjee led West Bengal government announced two welfare initiatives for farmers as a part of the 'Krishi Krishak Bondhu' scheme which will come into effect from New Year's Day January 1, 2019.



Key Points:

- > Under the first of the two schemes, If a farmer aged between 18 to 60 years dies a natural or unnatural death, the state government will pay his family **Rs 2 lakh.** The farmers will be able to start applying for the scheme from February 1, 2019.
- ➤ Under the second initiative, farmers would get **Rs 2,500** twice a year for growing a single crop on one acre of land. The farmers will be able to apply for this scheme from **February 1**, while the amount will be calculated from January 1, 2019.
- > The **West Bengal** government has already waived tax and cess on agricultural land to help farmers in distress.
- **> Odisha** government also approved ₹10,180 crore financial aid to farmers through 'Krushak Assistance for Livelihood and Income Augmentation' (KALIA) scheme.
- **> Jharkhand** had also announced a cash assistance of **Rs 5,000** per acre to over 22.76 lakh small and marginal farmers across the state.

TO ENROL FARMERS FOR THE ATAL SOLAR KRISHI PUMP YOJANA

- ➤ Maharashtra Government distribution announced of free sops to encourage farmers to enrol in the Atal Solar Krishi Pump Yojana.
- ➤ The things included: two LED bulbs, a DC fan and a mobile charging socket.



About Atal Solar Krishi Pump Yojana (ASKP):

- ➤ Launched in October 2018, it aims to reduce losses due to non-payment of electricity bills and also promote solar energy.
- > Farmers with less than five acres will have to pay 5 per cent of the cost of a 3 HP solar pump while farmers with more than five acres will get a 5 HP solar pump and the sops.
- ➤ It would provide subsidy of upto 95% on solar agriculture pumpsets.
- ➤ Also around 1 lakh solar pumps were distributed to farmers to irrigate 14,000 Ha land.

2ND REGIONAL CONFERENCE ON "DEENDAYAL DISABLED REHABILITATION SCHEME (DDRS)" **HELD AT MUMBAI**

- of Social **Justice** > Ministry & Empowerment, **Department** of **Empowerment Persons** of with **Disabilities** organized the 2nd regional conference at Nehru Centre, Mumbai, on a scheme titled 'Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme (DDRS)'.
 - conference 1. The consisted Programme Implementing Agencies (PIAs) from the Western Region of the country which further would culminate in a National Conference in New Delhi.
 - 2. The Regional Conference was organized in order to disseminate the provisions of the revised scheme (2018) and to create better linkages between the department, agencies and stakeholders associated with the scheme.
 - 3. The western states concerned were, namely, Maharashtra, Madhva Pradesh, Gujarat and Goa and two Union Territories i.e., Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu.

About the scheme DDRS:

- ➤ DDRS is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India which is being implemented since 1999 for providing financial assistance to NGOs working for education and rehabilitation of persons with disabilities.
- > The objective of the scheme is ensuring welfare of Divyangian and the dignity they deserve.
- ➤ Under DDRS, Grant-in-Aid is released to about **600** NGOs every year.

ANDAMAN TO BE FIRST ISLAND TO **OPERATE SEAPLANES UNDER UDAN-3**

> The Ministry of Civil Aviation has approved operations of seaplanes in the Andaman Islands under **UDAN-3** (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) making Andaman the first island of India to operate seaplanes.

Key Points:

- > The Islands of Andaman that would be connected through seaplanes are Campbell Bay, Car Nicobar, Havelock, Hutbay, Neil, Long island and Diglipur.
- ➤ Operation of Seaplanes which are commonly used in Maldives and Mauritius is a part government's ambitious regional connectivity scheme and it will give a huge push to tourism in the strategically important region.

- ➤ The first batch of 40 Indian-origin people are at the **Pravasi Bharatiya Divas** and from here they will begin their tour.

PRAVASI TEERTH DARSHAN YOJANA

- ➤ Prime Minister Narendra Modilaunched the **Pravasi** Teerth Darahan Yojana. the features of the Pravasi Teerth Darshan Yojana are:
- ➤ Under the scheme, a group of Indian diaspora will be taken on a governmentsponsered tour of religious places in India twice a vear.
- ➤ The first batch of 40 people participated in the **Pravasi** Bharativa Divas 2019 held in Varanasi.
- > Those selected would be taken to religious places of all major religious in India.
- ➤ The government will bear all the expenses including the airfare from their country of residence.
- ➤ People of Indian-origin aged 45 to 65 can apply can avail the benefits under the scheme.
- ➤ The Scheme accords first preference to people from Girmitiva countries such as Mauritius, Fiji Suriname, Guyana, Trinidad and Tobago and Jamaica.



3. Geography

3.1 POLICY ON ENVIRONMENT AND ECOLOGY

GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS UP 22% BETWEEN 2010 AND 2014

- > Released by **Government of India** that has to be submitted to the secretariat of the UN Framework Convention of Climate change in every 2 years recites that India's total Greenhouse emissions grew by more than 22 per cent between 2010 and 2014.
 - 1. The greenhouse gas emissions reached a level of **2.6 billion tonnes** of carbon dioxide equivalent in 2014 and has created a net carbon sink of at least 300 million tonnes.
 - **2. Carbon dioxide** absorption through forests and croplands has also gone up. The energy sector including electricity generation, transport and other fuel combustion activities are the main reason for the above mentioned effect.'

3.2 NATURAL DISASTERS - SAFEGUARD MEASURES

6.9-MAGNITUDE QUAKE STRIKES SOUTHERN PHILIPPINES

- ➤ An earthquake of 6.9-magnitude struck off the southern Philippine island of Mindanao (Dec 29), but there were no immediate reports of casualties or damage.
- ➤ The quake struck **193km** east of the city of General Santos, the USGS said, with a depth of **59km. USGS** had earlier reported the quake measured 7.2 in magnitude before downgrading it.
- ➤ Hazardous tsunami waves from this earthquake are possible within 300km of the epicentre along the coasts of Indonesia and the Philippines.
- possible ➤ Tsunami waves within are 300km of the quake, in Philippines and Indonesia.

TROPICAL STORM USMAN HITS PHILIPPINES

- > Tropical Storm Usman hit Philippines' Bicol region in Manila
 - 1. The tropical depression brought heavy rains triggered deadly and landslides all over the country.
 - 2. The Philippines is affected by 15 to 20 typhoons every year during the rainy season, which usually begins in May or June and concludes in November or December.

CYCLONIC STORM 'PABUK' OVER ANDAMAN SEA

- > A warning was issued by **The India** Meteorological Department (IMD) that a Cyclonic storm "PABUK" over Andaman Sea and neighbourhood is moving towards west-northwestwards with a speed of 21 kmph.
- ➤ Cyclone warning for Andaman Islands is "ORANGE MESSAGE".



Key Points:

- > IMD issued guidelines to people living on the Andaman islands to remain at safe place and suspended all fishing operations in the Andaman sea and southeast and east central Bay of Bengal on 5th & 6th January 2019.
- ➤ The Cyclone PABUK will cross Andaman by the evening of 6th **January** and move towards Myanmar coast and weaken gradually during 7th and 8th January.
- > PABUK was originated in the **Gulf** of Thailand and created landfall in Nakhon Si Thammarat province of Thailand on 4th January 2019.

VOLCANO ERUPTS ON **KUCHINOERABU ISLAND OF JAPAN**

- ➤ All the 140 people living on the Kuchinoerabu island were evacuated after the violent eruption. Japan has 110 active volcanoes.
- ➤ Kuchinoerabu Island **1,000km** southwest of the capital, Tokyo and has an area of 38 square kilometers. The entire island lies within the borders of the Kirishima-Yaku National Park.


4.1 CURRENT SOCIO - ECONOMIC PROBLEMS

VIJAY MALLYA FIRST PERSON TO BE NAMED 'FUGITIVE ECONOMIC OFFENDER'

- > Under Section 12 of the Fugitive Economic Offenders' Act, 2018 by a special Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) Court in Mumbai.
 - 1. The Enforcement Directorate (ED) had filed an application before the court in November, 2018 and this declaration was made by Special judge MS Azmi.
 - 2. The ED had also sought immediate confiscation of about Rs 12,500 crore worth of assets.
 - 3. He is wanted in India for defaulting on Rs. 9,000 crore in loans to his failed Kingfisher Airlines from a consortium of 12 banks led by the State Bank of India.

INDIA'S GDP EXPECTED TO GROW AT 7.3% IN 2018-19: WORLD **BANK**

- ➤ World Bank projected India' GDP, expected to grow at 7.3% in the fiscal year 2018-19, and 7.5% in the following two years. The Bank said India will continue to be the fastest growing major economy in the world.
- ➤ In India, the growth has accelerated, driven by an upswing in consumption, and investment growth has firmed as the effects of temporary factors wane, the World Bank said in its latest report.

Highlights:

- ➤ The countries were categorized and colour coded in 4 sections. They were:
 - 1. Full Democracy (Dark Green) scoring 8-10 & consisting of **20** countries,
 - 2. Flawed **Democracy** (Light Green) scoring 6-7.99 consisting of **55** countries.
 - **3. Hybrid Regime** (Mint green to Light Yellow) scoring 4-5.99 consisting of 39 countries and
 - 4. Authoritarian Regime (Dark Red) scoring 1-3.99 consisting of **53** countries.
- ➤ The scores were divided based on 60 indicators on five categories of:
 - Electoral process and




- Civil liberties:

- ➤ France also surpassed the UK in the world's largest economy rankings in 2019, knocking it from fifth to seventh place with increased rate of 1.7% GDP.
- ➤ Due to lower growth rate we may have a trade war in 2019.main focus of tension would be between US-China trade
- ➤ The US was the world's largest economy with a size of 19.39 trillion dollars, followed by China at 12.23 trillion dollars at the second place in 2017.

IRANIAN BANK TO OPEN IN MUMBAI

GOVERNMENT **REVIVIES PLAN TO CHANGE FISCAL YEAR** TO JAN-DEC: REPORTS

- The government reportedly revived plans to change the fiscal year January-December from the April-March period.
- > This is expected to help the government include forecast monsoon Budget projections. thereby ensuring better allocation of resources to agricultural sector.
- > India has been following the April-March fiscal vear since **1867**. line with what the British Government and followed.
- India has permitted an Iranian private bank to open a branch in Mumbai that is expected to begin operations by March to handle transactions related to New **Delhi's oil purchases** in view of American sanctions on Tehran.
- > Chabahar port, on Iran's southern coast along the Gulf of Oman, is being developed as a transportation corridor for landlocked Afghanistan that bypasses Pakistan.
- ➤ Iron and Construction, Development of Transport and Infrastructure Company (CDTIC) of Iran are now building the **Chabahar-Zahedan** railway line.

INDIA'S GROWTH TO ACCELERATE FROM 7.4% TO 7.6% IN FY20: UN REPORT

➤ With robust private consumption and 7.4% GDP growth rate in the current fiscal, the Indian economy is expected to accelerate at a rate of 7.6% in 2019-20, according to a report by the United Nations titled United Nations' World Economic Situation and Prospects (WESP) 2019.

INDIA IS SET TO BECOME WORLD'S THIRD LARGEST CONSUMER MARKET

➤ A report by World Economic Forum today said that India is set to become the world's third largest consumer market behind only USA and China by 2030. The report titled "Future of Consumption in Fast- Growth Consumer Market- India" also noted growth of the middle class will lift nearly 25 million household out of poverty.

RAILWAYS DEVELOPS AI-POWERED ROBOT TO CHECK FOR FAULTS IN **TRAINS**

> The mechanical branch of **Central** Railway's Nagpur division has developed a new AI-powered robot USTAAD (Undergear named Surveillance through Artificial Intelligence Assisted which examines parts of the coach in real time with a HD camera and transmits them over WiFi.



Features:

➤ The special features of the robot include HD (high-definition) camera that can be rotated in any direction as per commands given by the engineer and can capture video as well as still photographs with zoom in or out facility.

- ➤ It is also equipped with **LED flood** light which enables to capture the videos in low light as well as in dark mode.
- ➤ The robot is also capable of capturing sound of flat tyre, during placement of the rake on the Pit Line in order to keep a check on the train's swift journey.

MANNED SPACE MISSION TO TAKE OFF

- ➤ The Union Cabinet approved the ambitious Ganganyaan programme, which will send three Indian astronauts to space for up to seven days by 2022 at a cost of ₹10,000 crore.
- > The first human fight space demonstration is targeted to be completed within 40 months of the sanction date. Two unmanned fights in full complement will be carried out to gain confidence.



NASA'S NEW HORIZONS SPACECRAFT HISTORIC FLY BY OF ULTIMA THULE


➤ The American space agency **NASA's** ➤ The New Horizons spacecraft performed the farthest flyby in history as it approached the Kuiper Belt object Ultima Thule.

Kev Points:

- > At **6.5 billion km** from Earth. the encounter is the most distant ever exploration of a Solar System body. The cosmic rendezvous occurred so far from Earth that it took more than 6 hours for a signal from New Horizons to reach Earth
- > Ultima is an object in the Kuiper belt which is a band of frozen material that orbits the Sun more than 2 billion km (1.25bn miles) further out than the Neptune; and 1.5 billion km beyond even the dwarf planet Pluto, which New Horizons visited in 2015.

ISRO LAUNCHES 'SAMWAD' WITH STUDENTS TO ENGAGE THEM ON SPACE SCIENCE

Indian Space Research (ISRO) Organisation launched a new platform named "Samwad with Students" (SwS) as part of the enhanced outreach programme and to engage youngsters across India to capture their scientific temperament in Bengaluru.



Key Points:

- ➤ The first **SwS** event saw interaction of 40 students and 10 teachers from select schools with ISRO Chairman **Dr K Sivan** during which the students were briefed about Indian space programme and their benefits to the common man at the Anthariksh Bhavan, Bengaluru.
- ➤ Under the **SwS platform**, ISRO will also be organising guided tours thrice in a year, for students of class 11 and class 12 in which they would be taken to ISRO facilities in Thiruvananthapuram Bengaluru and the launch centre at Sriharikota. Students would also be taken to space laboratories and would be allowed to make small satellites.

NASA'S PROBE DISCOVERS A NEW PLANET

- ➤ NASA's latest planethunting probe has discovered a new world outside our solar system, orbiting a dwarf star 53 light years away.
- > This is the **third** new planet confirmed by the **Transiting** Exoplanet Survey Satellite (TESS) since its launch in April last year.
- ➤ The planet, named **HD 21749b**, orbits a bright, nearby dwarf star about 53 light years away, in the constellation Reticulum, and appears to have the longest orbital period of the three planets so far identified by TESS



BRAIN PACEMAKER

- ➤ Scientists have developed a device named **WAND** which stands for "Wireless artifact-free neuromodulation device" that works like a "Pacemaker for the **brain**" to monitor the brain's electrical activity and potentially deliver fine-tuned treatments to patients suffering from diseases like epilepsy and Parkinson's.
 - 1. The most important feature of the device is that it is both wireless and autonomous, which means when it learns to recognize the signs of tremor or seizures then it can adjust the stimulation parameters on its own to prevent the unwanted movements.
 - 2. The device has custom integrated circuits to record the full signal from both the subtle brain wave and the strong electrical pulses.

SPACE FUEL

- > IIT-Madras team created 'space fuel' by trapping carbon dioxide in crystalline form with the help of water molecules. This would in future help to curb greenhouse gases.
 - 1. This was made in vacuum, one thousand billion times below the atmospheric ultrapressure called high vacuum (UHV) and temperature close to minus 263 degree Celsius.
 - 2. These conditions are present in deep space which they mimicked in the lab.
 - 3. The Study was published in the journal Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences (PNAS).

ALBUMIN BETTER INDICATOR OF DIABETES: STUDY BY SCIENTISTS OF NCL, PUNE

- > Scientists at the National Chemical Laboratory, Pune suggested that albumin can be a better indicator of diabetes.
 - 1. This can be achieved based on measurements of levels of free albumin and albumin attached to glucose molecules in the blood.
 - 2. Glycation is binding of glucose to protein or lipid molecules and glycated hemoglobin is the percentage of glucose bound to hemoglobin.

3. These albumin levels in blood influence glycation of haemoglobin which further helps in diagnosis of diabetes.

Background:

➤ According to **WHO**, levels of glycated (or glucose-bound) hemoglobin in blood can be used for diagnosis of diabetes.

LUNAR ROVER NAMED ' YUTU-2', LANDS ON THE FAR SIDE OF THE MOON

- ➤ Lunar rover Yutu-2 or Jade Rabbit-2 of the Chang'e-4 spacecraft made the first-ever soft landing on the far side of the moon.
 - 1. Images were sent back to the Earth via the relay satellite 'Queqiao'.
 - 2. In Chinese folklore, Yutu is the white pet rabbit of Chang'e, the moon goddess who lent her name to the Chinese lunar mission.
 - 3. China's lunar probe is a part of its 'Made in China **2025'** project.
 - 4. It follows a homegron Global Chinese **Positioning System** named BeiDou Navigation Satellite System.



FIRST MANNED MISSION TO SPACE BY DECEMBER 2021: ISRO



- > Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) chairman K Sivan announced that the 1st Gaganyaan manned mission to outer space would be launched by December 2021.
- Under Gaganyaan project, India is planning to send three astronauts to outer space for seven days and bring them back.
- ➤ As of 2019, **332** launches are planned this year. Detail of some of these missions are as follows:
 - Launch of Chandrayan -2 mission to the moon in mid-April 2019. Indian land up and rover will study southpole of the moon for the first time under Chandrayaan- 2 mission.
 - GSAT-20 Satellite for high bandwidth connectivity to be launched in September-October 2019.
 - ISRO is conceiving a mission to **Venus** by 2023.
 - ISRO TV Channel will be launched by another 3-4 months (March to April 2019).

PAPER SENSOR TO DETECT FRESHNESS OF MILK

> Scientists from the **Indian Institute** of Technology, Guwahati, have developed a paper kit to test the freshness of milk and determine how well the milk has been pasteurized. The kit can also aid in ensuring that milk is consumed before it turns too sour with the help of a smartphone app.

How does the Kit work?

> The Kit uses an ordinary filter paper to prepare the detector. The filter paper which is cut into small pieces is impregnated with chemical probes that preferentially react with Alkaline Phosphatase, which is an indicator of the quality of the milk. When the filter paper impregnated with probes come in contact with the milk, its colour changes.

- ➤ The colour change is photographed by a Smartphone. The images then processed to obtain are corresponding colour values. These values are then compared with standard data stored date stored in the phone.
- ➤ This provides information about the quality of the Milk. Since the sensors used works in both qualitative and quantitative mode, the kit can also be used to measure the quantity of the milk
 - ➤ Alkaline Phosphatase or ALP is an indicator of milk quality. It's presence even after pasteurization indicates presence of microbes that may not have been rendered inactive with pasteurization.

- ➤ The Union cabinet approved the draft National Commission for Homeopathy Bill, 2018, which seekstoreplacetheexisting regulator central council of homoeopathy with a new body to ensure transparency and accountability.
- The draft bill provides for constitution of a national commission with three autonomous boards entrusted with conducting overall education of homoeopathy by homoeopathy education board.

Aim:

- ➤ To assess and grant permission to educational institutions of homoeopathy and board of ethics and registration of practitioners of homeopathy to maintain national register and ethical issues relating to practice are under the National Commission for Homoeopathy.
- ➤ The bill also aims at bringing reforms in the medical education of homoeopathy in line with the National Medical Commission proposed for setting up for Allopathy system of medicine.

ISLANDS OF ANDAMAN TO BE RENAMED AFTER NETAJI BOSE

- ➤ The Union Government has decided to rename Ross, Neil and Havelock islands of Andaman.
- ➤ The Ross, Neil and Havelock Island are to be named as Netaji Subash Chandra Bose Island, Shaheed Dweep, and Swaraj Dweep, respectively.
- ➤ The announcement about renaming is expected to be made by PM Narendra Modi on 30 December during his visit to the Islands. 30th December marks the 75th anniversary of the Netaji's visit to the Andaman Islands.

Netaji's connect with the Andaman Islands

- Netaji, accompanied by Sarvashri Anand Mohan Sahay, Captain Rawat-ADC and Colonel DS Raju, the personal physician of Netaji, landed at the Port Blair aerodrome in Andman on 29th December 1943.
- Netaji was accorded a warm welcome.
 Netaji had appointed Indian National
 Army General AD Loganathan as the governor of the islands.

 - 1. The programme was organised on October 26, 2018 and 487 participants took part in it.
 - 2. This is the **first** Guinness World Records achievement for the state government in the field of medicine.
 - 3. The hospital also received recognition from 'High Range Book of World Records'
 - 4. Thus these made MNJ Institute the first and only government hospital in the state of Telangana to get 2 world records.



ARUNACHAL TOUCHES RECORD HIGH REVENUE GENERATION

➤ The Arunachal Pradesh government that the government has recited remarkably succeeded in increasing the state revenue generation in the past two years with the record revenue collection of **Rs 1598.49 crore** during the year 2017-18 which is a new high in the last 30 years.

- > The index captured the business environment at the sub-national level on the basis of 72 hard and soft indicators.



INDIAN FOREST SERVICE TO BE RENAMED AS INDIAN FOREST AND TRIBAL SERVICE: DOPT.

- > The Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) proposed renaming of the Indian Forest Service as Indian Forest and Tribal Service.
 - 1. The move was made for the IFS to be more receptive towards tribals and forest dwellers.
 - 2. This was made after a directive from the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST) suggested to do so.

About Indian Forest Service:

➤ It came into existence in 1996 under the All India Services Act, 1951.

WEST BENGAL QUIT AYUSHMAN BHARAT SCHEME

- > Bengal chief minister **Mamata Banerjee** announced exit of West Bengal from the Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna due to the use of PM's picture in the official poster of the centre-state joint scheme.
 - 1. According to the announcement, the **states** are supposed to bear **40%** of the project cost, while the **Centre** will foot **60%** of the bill.

- 2. Furthermore, the centre had unilaterally changed the scheme to Ayushman Bharat- Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana in spite of agreed efforts to retain the state sponsored health scheme name: **Swasthyasathi** which was launched in **2016**.
- 3. Thus, West Bengaljoined the league of states of **Telangana**, **Kerala**, **Odisha**, **and Delhi** which have opted out of the scheme for varied reasons.

Pradhan Mantri - Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY)

➤ Pradhan Mantri-Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY) is a scheme of the government under **Ayushman Bharat**. The scheme aims to reduce the financial burden on poor and vulnerable groups arising out of catastrophic hospital episodes and ensure their access to quality health services was conceived. It also seeks to accelerate India's progress towards the achievement of **Universal Health Coverage (UHC) and Sustainable Development Goal** - 3 (SDG3).

NATIONAL CLEAN AIR PROGRAMME (NCAP) LAUNCHED IN NEW DELHI



- > The Union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, **Dr. Harsh Vardhan** launched **National Clean Air Programme** (NCAP) in New Delhi.
 - It will be a mid-term, **five-year** action plan with **2019** as the first year.
 - It will be launched in the 43 smart cities falling in the list of the 102 non-attainment cities, under the Smart Cities program. Selection of 102 non-attainment cities identified with respect to 'Ambient Air Quality India' report of 2011-15 and WHO report of 2014-2018.
 - National level target of 20%-30% reduction of PM2.5 and PM10 concentration by 2024 taking 2017 as the base year.

ONE-DAY GLOBAL SKILL SUMMIT 2019 HELD IN RANCHI



- ➤ The one day Global Skill Summit 2019 was held in Ranchi, Jharkhand.
- ➤ It is the only state where overall three global summits were organized in a row merely in four years by the state government.
 - 1. The theme of the Summit was: 'Skilling Youth, Enabling Youth'.
 - 2. It was under the **#MO MEMTUM JHARKHAND**campaign.
 - 3. It was attended by **Shri Dhar mendra Pradhan**, Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas, & Skill Development and Entrepreneurship.

SIKKIM WILL BECOME FIRST STATE TO ROLL OUT UNIVERSAL BASIC INCOME

➤ Sikkim, though being a smallest state have set a initiative to introduce UBI in the entire nation. Sikkim's long lasting chief minister and head of sikkim's ruling party(sikkim democratic front) Pawan kumar chamling, quoted that if everything goes right then sikkim would be the first state to implement UNIVERSAL BASIC **INCOME SYSTEM** and execute it by **2022**.



> This scheme is also regarded as an alternative to social welfare programmes with benefits towards reducing poverty.

ABOUT UNIVERSAL BASIC INCOME:

- ➤ The UBI basically is an income given to families irrespective of what they do. It means everyone and every household will get an income irrespective of their profession.
- ➤ In other words ,it is a step taken by the government to alleviate poverty by providing a basic income to all citizens
- > This same scheme has been tested even in India. The UBI has been tried in Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and the results are fairly good.

3-DAY 29TH INDIAN PAINT CONFERENCE - 2019 HELD IN AGRA, UP BY IPA

- > The 3-day 29th Indian Paint Conference 2019 commenced in Agra, Uttar Pradesh. It would conclude on January 13, 2019.

U.S ISRAEL QUIT UNESCO CITING BIAS

> The United states of America (USA) and Israel officially quit the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural **Organization (UNESCO)** amid concerns that the organization fosters anti-Israel bias.



Key Points:

- > UNESCO was established in **1945** after the end of world war II to foster peace and it is best known for its World Heritage programs which designates cultural sites and aims to preserve traditions.
- ➤ Both the countries filed the notice to withdraw from the organization in **2017**.
- > The United states, one of the founding member of **UNESCO** has demanded "Fundamental Reform" in the organization.
- ➤ USA and Israel stopped paying dues to UNESCO after Palestine which is disputes part of Israel was voted in as a member state of UNESCO in 2011. So this move will not affect UNESCO because it has been already dealing with funding slash ever since 2011.

SHEIKH HASINA WINS THIRD TERM AS PM OF BANGLADESH

➤ Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's alliance won Bangladesh's election with a thumping majority giving her a third straight term.



Key Points:

- > The alliance dominated by her Awami League, won 287 of the 298 seats for which results have been declared, the commission said. There are 300 constituencies in the country.
- > The main opposition Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP), which boycotted the last poll in 2014, won just 6 seats.

UAE TO REOPEN DAMASCUS EMBASSY AFTER 7 YEARS

- > The United Arab Emirates reopened its embassy in Syria's capital, Damascus for the first time in seven years, a reflection of improved relations between Bashar **Assad** and some of his **Arab foes** as the war winds down.
- > UAE's charge d'affaires Abdul-Hakim Naimi visited the embassy and witnessed his country's flag being raised again on the compound in central **Damascus**.
- > The move provides a major boost to Assad, whose forces have won a series of military victories in recent years with the help of Russia and Iran.
- > Sudan's President Omar Bashir visited Damascus earlier this month, becoming the first **Arab** head of state to visit **Syria** since the start of the war.

JAIR BOLSONARO TAKES OATH AS NEW PRESIDENT OF BRAZIL

- ➤ Jair Bolsonaro was sworn in as Brazil's President in a ceremony at Brazil's National Congress Building. Bolsonaro is a former Army captain and admirer of the country's 1964-1985 military dictatorship.
- ➤ Bolsonaro, 63, was a sevenfringe congressman term who rode a wave of antiestablishment anger to become Brazil's first far-right president since a military dictatorship gave way to civilian rule three decades ago.

IRAN APPROVED ANTI-MONEY LAUN-DERING BILL FOR EASE OF BUSINESS

- ➤ Iranian council known as the **Expediency** Council approved an anti-money laundering bill to ease trade
- This bill will be in line with the standards set by the Financial Action Task Force (FATF).

Background:

➤ Iran is alone with North Korea on the FATF's blacklist — although the Parisbased organisation has suspended counter- measures since June 2017 while Iran works on reforms.

ISRAEL, US SUCCESSFULLY TEST BALLISTICE MISSILE INTERCEPTORS

- > The **Israel and US** countries have successfully tested ballistic missile interceptors deployed at Israeli airbases.

- ➤ The Arrow 3 interceptor system, designed to shoot down missiles above the atmosphere, was deployed at air force bases across Israel two years ago.

PAKISTAN TO ISSUE BONDS TO RAISE CAPITAL IN CHINA

- The government of Pakistan has decided to launch Panda Bonds to raise loans from Chinese capital markets.
- ➤ Launching of Panda Bonds is part of Pakistan's plans to move towards giving the Chinese currency, a status at par with that enjoyed by the US dollar. The interest rates and the size of the bonds would be decided at a later stage.
- > The Finance Ministry Pakistan has said that the Panda Bonds are part of its multipronged approach for bridging the foreign financing needs and building foreign exchange reserves.
- ➤ Panda Bonds will help Pakistan to diversify the investor base of capital market issuance and provide a source of raising renminhi.

Panda Bonds

- ➤ Panda bonds are Chinese reminbi-denominated bonds from a non-chinese issuer, sold in the people's Republic of China. The first two Panda bonds were issued in October 2005 by the International finance Corporation and the Asian Development Bank on the same day.
- > The Philippines issued its inaugural Panda bonds in 2018. It was the first ASEAN member to issue Panda bonds.

THE 7TH ASEAN-INDIA TOURISM MINISTERS MEETING AT HA LONG CITY, VIETNAM

➤ Union Tourism Minister K. J. Alphons, co-chaired the 7th Meeting of Tourism Ministers of ASEAN-India with Minister of Culture, Sports and Tourism of Viet Nam, Mr. Nguyen Ngoc Thien. The Meeting was held in Ha Long City in Viet Nam.



Key points:

- > The Meeting was also attended by the Tourism Ministers of Brunei Darussalam, Combodia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Lao PDR. Philippines, Singapore and Thailand.
- ➤ Tourism Ministers welcomed of ASEAN-India Informal decision summit which was held on 15 November lauched 2018 **ASEAN-India** and Tourism Cooperation Year 2019. Earlier Indian Prime Minister, Narendra Modi also proposed to designate 2019 as the ASEAN-India Tourism Year.

- ➤ Egypt opened West Asia's largest cathedral in its **New Administrative Capital**, 45 kms away from its capital,



- ➤ The bridge is made out of 44 hollowed-out 3D printed concrete blocks which were printed by the robotic arms in a span of 19 days.
- ➤ The newly-opened bridge has a technology that supplies data which also includes vibrating wire stress sensors.

1. INITIATIVES FOR IMPROVING **QUALITY OF EDUCATION**

➤ The Central Government has launched the following mechanisms for improving the quality of education:

(A) Integrated Scheme for School **Education-Samagra Shiksha**

- ➤ Integrated Schemefor School Education-Samagra Shiksha has been launched by subsuming three erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA(and Teacher Edcuation (TE).
- ➤ The Samagara Shiksha scheme focuses on improving the Quality of education by providing support for different interventions like; in-service training of teachers and schools heads, conduct of achievement surveys at National and State level, provision of textbooks as per Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009, remedial teaching for academically weaker students, ICT and digital initiatives etc.

(B) Rashtriya Aavishkar Abhiyan

> Rashtriya Aavishkar Abhiyan motivates and engages children of the age group from 6-18 years in Science, Mathematics and Technology through observation, experimentation, inference students, ICT and digital initiatives etc.



ABOUT RASTRIYA KRISHI VIKAS YOJNA:

- ➤ Rastriya Krishi Vikas Yojna or National Agriculture Development Programme is a State Plan Scheme of Additional Central Assistance launched in August 2007 as a part of the 11th Five Year Plan by the Government of India.
- ➤ It aims to achieve 4% annual growth in agriculture through development of Agriculture and its allied sectors.
- > The funds are released to the State Governments/UTs on the basis of projects approved in the State Sanctioning Committee Meeting (SLSC) headed by the Chief Secretary of the concerned State.
- ➤ The Cabinet has approved (as on 1st November 2017) for continuation of the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Scheme (State Plans) - Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) as Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana-Remunerative **Approaches** for Agriculture and Allied Sector Rejuvenation (RKVY-RAFTAAR) for three years i.e. 2017-18 to 2019-20 with a financial allocation of Rs. 15,722 crores.

(C) e PATHSHALA

- ➤ e PATHSHALA has been launched as a single point repository of e resources containing NCERT textbooks and various other learning resources.
- ➤ e PATHSHALA has been developed for showcasing and disseminating all educational resources including textbooks, audio, video, periodicals, and a vatiety of other print and nonprint materials.

(D) SWAYAM

➤ SWAYAM portal offers various online courses for school education and higher education, NCERT is providing course modules in the SWAYAM portal.

(E) SWAYAM PRABHA DTH-TV

➤ SWAYAM PRABHA DTH-TV has been launched to provide learning opportunities for the students, as per their convenience. Everyday four hour fresh slot is telecast and repeated six times in 24 hours.

PARIVESH

- ➤ Parivesh is a web-based workflow application which has been developed for online submission and monitoring of the proposals submitted by the proponents for seeking Environment, Forest, Wildlife and CRZ Clearances from Central, State and district level authorities.
- ➤ **Parivesh** automates the entire tracking of proposals which includes online submission of a new proposal, editing/updating the details of proposals and displays status of the proposals at each stage of the **workflow**.

(F) Diksha Portal

➤ Diksha Portal has been launched to provide a digital platform for teachers to learn and train themselves and connect with teacher community.

- > Indian Oil Corp (IOC), the nation's biggest oil firm, announced commission of its first Rs 5,151-crore worth Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) import terminal in Ennore, Tamil Nadu.
 - 1. This is the first LNG import terminal IOC has built on its own and will become operational by the end of January 2019.
 - 2. IOC holds 95 per cent stake in the Ennore LNG import terminal. Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation (TIDCO) has 5 per cent.
 - 3. The firm is also working on laying a 1,385 km natural gas pipeline originating from the **Ennore** terminal to Nagapattinam in Tamil Nadu via Puducherry.
 - 4. Also, branch pipelines will be laid in Madurai, Tuticorin, and Bengaluru to meet the LNG demand.

KALLAKURICHI 33RD DISTRICT OF TAMIL NADU

- ➤ Chief Minister Edappadi K.Palaniswamy announced the creation of a new district by bifurscating Villupuram district.
- ➤ Kallakurichi will be headquarters of the new district and its creation has increased the number of districts in Tamil Nadu to 33.
- ➤ Villupuram, with 1,099 pancha yats, was the biggest distrtict in the State.
- ➤ Villupuram district, which was bifurcated from the erstwhile South Arcot district in 1993, has 11 Assembly segments.

TN BULL TAMING EVENT ENTERS WORLD RECORD



- ➤ Jallikattu' as a symbol the valour and courage of the Tamil people. A grand "iallikattu" (bull-taming) event held in **Pudukottai** and this event entered the world record for the maximum number of bulls released into the sport arena.

Key Points to be Noted:

- ➤ The government formed a **5-point plan** to implement the policies which include creating ecosystems, ensure resources availability for Startup ecosystem, enable skill development and job creation, support social entrepreneurship and establish global accessibility and partnerships.
- ➤ The State is to set up Tamil Nadu Startup Fund of Funds for Rs.250 crore which is to be registered as an Alternative Investment Fund (AIF) managed by Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), for investment in startups and MSMEs.

KILPAUK MEDICAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL GETS STATE-OF-THE-ART BREAST CLINIC

- > The first-of-its-kind in India machinery has three advanced forms of screening techniques that includes tomosynthesis, contrast mammography and stereo biopsy.
- ➤ The installed machinery will be open for public from January 2019 at a **breastclinic** in Kilpauk Medical College.
- > Tomosynthesis, also known as three-dimensional (3-D) mammography, uses a low-dose **x-ray system** and computer reconstructions to create three-dimensional images of the breasts.
- ➤ As the process uses volume-based mammography, the imaging can be more efficient and clear in diagnosing the cancer cells

Colour: Light Grey to Ash Grey.

Texture: Sandy to silty loam or clay.

Red soil:

Seen mainly in low rainfall area. Also known as Omnibus group..

Colour: Red because of Ferric oxide. The lower layer is reddish

yellow or yellow.

Texture: Sandy to clay and loamy.

Black soil / regur soil:

Regur means cotton - best soil for cotton cultivation. Most of the Deccan is occupied by Black soil. It is Mature soil. It has High water retaining capacity. Soils are Swells and will become sticky when wet and shrink when dried. Selfploughing is a characteristic of the black soil as it develops wide cracks when dried.

Colour: Deep black to light black.

Laterite soil:

Name from Latin word 'Later' which means Brick.It becomes so soft when wet and so hard when dried. In the areas of high temperature and high rainfall.

Colour: Red colour due to iron oxide.

Desert / arid soil:

Seen under Arid and Semi-Arid conditions.

Colour: Red to Brown.

Texture: Sandy

Peaty / marshy soil:

Areas of heavy rainfall and high humidity.Growth of vegetation is very less.A large quantity of dead organic matter/humus which makes the soil alkaline

Forest soil:

Regions of high rainfall. Humus content is less and thus the soil is acidic.

Mountain soil:

In the mountain regions of the country. Immature soil with low humus and acidic.
