International missing children's day

➤ To raise awareness on the issue of child abduction, educate parents on safeguard measures to protect their children.

World Thyroid day

About Thyroid Disorders:

➤ It is common worldwide and affect people of all ages. It is usually caused by iodine deficiency. The most common thyroid disorders are hypothyroidism, thyroiditis or Goitre.



Sweden to host world leaders conference to combat antisemitism in october 2020

> Swedish Prime Minister Stefan Lofven announced that Sweden will host an International Conference against Anti-Semitism in memory of the Holocaust in October 2020. It will

held in **Malmo, Southern Sweden,** on October 27 and 28, 20 years after the liberation of the Auschwitz concentration camp.

Key Points:

- ➤ The decision to fight against anti-Semitism is taken after the relations with Israel have been in trouble since the Nordic state's recognition of a Palestinian state by Lofven's Govenment in 2014.
- ➤ After the attacks in Paris and Copenhagen in 2015, the Simon Wiesenthal Centre had called for a European conference against anti-Semitism.



Veer savarkar jayanthi

➤ The birth anniversary of Veer Savarkar aka **Vinayak Damodar Savarkar** was observed on May 28 annually to commemorate the sacrifices made by him during the freedom struggle. He was born on May 28, 1883 in Bhagpur village near Nasik in

Maharashtra. He was a freedom fighter who called 1857 revolt as the first war of independence.

About Veer Savarkar:

- ➤ In 1923, he founded the word "Hindutva".
- ➤ Veer Savarkar founded the two-nation theory in his book Hindutva calling Hindus and Muslims two separate nations. In 1937, Hindu Mahasabha passed it as a resolution.
- ➤ He had founded Abhinav Bharat Society (in Pune) and Free India Society (in London).
- ➤ He has written "Joseph Mazzini Biography and Politics". He has published "The Indian War of Independence" about Indian rebellion of 1857. He also founded the two-nation theory in his book "Hindutva" calling Hindus and Muslims two separate nations.

World Hunger Day

- ➤ The 9th annual **World Hunger Day** was observed with a theme of "Sustaibability". World Hunger Day is an initiative by **The Hunger Project.** first started in 2011.
- ➤ The objective is to raise awareness about more than 821 million people living in chronic hunger worldwide. It seeks to celebrate sustainable solutions to hunger and poverty and to inspire everyone to be a part of the solution.



International day of United Nations Peacekeepers

> Theme 2019: "Protecting Civilians, Protecting Peace".

International Everest Day

➤ Nepal decided to observe the day as International Everest Day since 2008 when the legendary climber Hillary passed away. Everest Day on May 29 every year in memory of the first summit of Mt. Everest by Sir Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norgay Sherpa on the day in 1953.

World Digestive health day

- > World Digestive Health Day was celebrated every year on May 29 every year. This year the theme of the World Digestive Health Day 2019 was "Early Diagnosis and Treatment of Gastrointestinal (G) Cancer".
- ➤ The day was celebrated by World Gastroenterology Organisation (WGO) in collaboration with WGO Foundation gastrointestinal diseases and disorders.

Goa celebrates its statehood day

- ➤ Goa celebrates its statehood day on 30th May. It was on this day in **1987 Goa became the 25th** state of the Indian Union. It was a Union Territory along with Daman and Diu from December 1961 onwards when Goa was liberated from the colonial rule.
- ➤ Once Goa was liberated there was a controversy regarding merging Goa with the neighbouring state of Maharashtra or Mysore. However, an opinion poll of 1967 suggested that Goa, Daman and Diu be Union Territory.

Key words:

- ➤ Pramod Sawant is the 13th and current Chief Minister of Goa.
- ➤ Panaji is the state capital of Goa.
- ➤ Mridula Sinha is present Governor of Goa.



World No-Tobacco Day

- ➤ To raise awareness on the harmful and deadly effects of tobacco use and second-hand smoke exposure, and to discourage the use of tobacco in any form.
- > Theme 2019 "tobacco and lung health."



Global day of Parents

➤ First ever Global day of Parents was declared by UN general assembly in **2012** with resolution A/RES/66/292. Theme for this year - **Honor your parents.**

World Milk Day

- ➤ The theme for World Milk Day 2019 is "Drink Milk: Today & Everyday".
- ➤ The theme intended to educate people about the importance of milk in our life and society.



World Bicycle Day observed

To promote the use of bicycle daily in this current era of modern automobiles. The main aim of this day is to recognize bicycle as clean, affordable and environment friendly mode of transport.



International day of Innocent Children Victims of Aggression observed on june 4

➤ It was observed on **June 4.** It aims to spread awareness about the pain and sufferings faced by the children who are the victims of physical, mental and emotional abuse.



Celebrated as World Environment Day

- ➤ To raise awareness about environmental issues pertaining to our planet and the action to be taken to tackle them.
- ➤ This day was observed for the first time in **1974** by the United Nations. China is the country for World Environment Day 2019.

international day for the fight against iuu fishing

➤ June 5 is celebrated as the International Day for the Fight Against Illegal, Unreported and Unregulated (IUU) Fishing to promote awareness in combating IUU. The day was first celebrated in 2018. The day June 5 is chosen to mark the day Agreement on Port State Measures came into existence.



Maharana Pratap Jayanti

➤ The birth anniversary of Maharana Pratap Singh, a Rajput King of Mewar is celebrated as Maharana Pratap Jayanti on June 6th. He is renowned as a true patriot who commenced the first war of independence. This year is 479th birth anniversary of great warrior.



1st World Food Safety Day

- The first-ever **World Food Safety Day** was celebrated in **June 7, 2019.** It was adopted by the **United Nations General Assembly** in December 2018. The theme of the year is **"Food Safety, everyone's business".** On this occasion, an event was launched in New York with a panel discussion.
- > Theme 'Food Safety, everyone's business'.

Objective:

➤ By observing World Food Safety Day, WHO pursues its efforts of mainstreaming food safety in public agenda and reducing burden of foodborne diseases globally.

World Day Against Child Labour

- ➤ To focus on the extent of child labour worldwide and the efforts required to eliminate it.
- 1. The theme for the year is "Children shouldn't work in fields, but on dreams!".



International Albinism awareness day

> To preserve the rights of persons with albinism and take efforts to ensure equal access for them to employment, education, justice and good health. The theme for the year is "Still Standing Strong".



World Blood Donor Day

➤ To raise awareness on blood donation. The theme of this year's campaign is "Blood donation and universal access to **safe blood transfusion,"** as a component of achieving universal health coverage. It encourages people all over the world to become blood donors and donate blood regularly. The Slogan for World Blood Day 2019 is "Safe blood for all

United Nation has declared theme as "Yoga for Climate **Action**" and Ministry of Ayush, India has declared theme for Yoga Day as "Yoga for Heart".

World Music Day

1.2 DEFENCE

INDIA'S FIRST ALL WOMAN CREW FLIES MI-17 **V5 MEDIUM LIFT HELICOPTER**

➤ Three women officers of Indian Air Force were part of India's first all women crew to fly a medium lift helicopter Mi-17 V5. Flight Lieutenant Parul Bhardwaj (Captain), Flying Officer Nidhi (copilot) and Flight Lieutenant Hina Jaiswal (Flight



Engineer) were three women IAF officers flew the chopper, which took off from a forward air base in South Western air command.

Key Highlights:

➤ All three women officers flew a Mi-17 V5 helicopter for Battle Inoculation Training Mission. Under this mission helicopter had take off and land from restricted areas at a forward air base in South Western air command.

FLIGHT LIEUTENANT MOHANA SINGH BECAME THE FIRST IAF WOMAN PILOT TO FLY HAWK JETS.

> Flight Lieutenat Mohana **Singh** became the first IAF woman pilot to become complete operational by day on Hawk advanced jet aircraft. She landed the gruelling 4 aircraft combat sortie at the Kalaikunda **Air Force Station in West** Bengal.



Key Points:

- ➤ At the training period, she was trained to fly air-to-air combat and air-toground missions.
- > She has the experience of more than 500 hours of incident-free flying, of which 380 hours are on the Hawk Mk 132 jet.
- ➤ In June 2016, she along with two other women pilots Bhawana Kanth and Avani Chaturvadi had joined the fighter stream.

INDIA & PORTUGAL TO SETUP NATIONAL MARITIME HERITAGE MUSEUM IN LOTHAL


➤ Government ofIndia announced that it will join hands with Portugal to set up maritime museum near ancient Harappans civilization Lothal at in Gujarat. It will be the similar model of the museum which is at Lisbon. Portugal administered by Portuguese Navy.

Key points:

- ➤ In March 2019, The foundation stone of the museum was laid down by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- ➤ It will be built in **public**partnership private (PPP) model. It will display India's rich heritage of inland waterways, trade through the water route, ancient ship building and navigational technologies developed by India.
- **>** It is going to be implemented by Union Ministry of Shipping through its Sagarmala programme with the support of Archaeological Survey of India Gujarat (ASI), State Government, Indian Navy and number of stakeholders.

MARITIME INFORMATION SHARING WORKSHOP 2019 HELD IN GURUGRAM

➤ The two day event of **Maritime Information** Sharing Workshop 2019 (MISW 2019) hosted by the Indian Navy under the aegis of the Information Fusion Centre-India Ocean Region (IFC-IOR) held in Gurugram, Harvana on June 12, 2019.



Key points:

- ➤ The workshop was inaugurated by Vice Admiral MS Pawar, Deputy Chief of the Naval Staff.
- > Participation: It saw the participation of more than 41 delegates from 29 countries of Indian Ocean Region (IOR) and beyond.
- ➤ **Objectives:** It was aimed at making aware of all participants about IFC-IOR. It was also aimed at promoting and sharing the security and safety challenges faced by IOR.

1.3 EMINENT PERSONS

RIHANNA NAMED AS WORLD'S RICHEST FEMALE MUSICIAN WITH \$600 MILLION WEALTH

➤ Singer **Rihanna** of age 31 is named as the world's richest female according to the **Forbes magazine** with an estimated fortune of \$600 million. She over took Madonna and Beyonce who topped the list previously. She is from **Barbados**.



1.4 SUMMIT & CONFERENCE

72ND WORLD HEALTH ASSEMBLY

➤ The 72nd session of the World Health Organisation (WHO)'s World Assembly held in Geneva, Switzerland from May 20 to 28, 2019. The theme of this year is "Universal Health Coverage: Leaving no one behind". The World Health Assembly was attended by delegations from all 194 World Health Organisation (WHO) Member states. The main focus of the session if on specific health agenda prepared by the Executive Board.

Key Highlights:

- > WHO appointed four new goodwill ambassadors for promoting global health.
 - Ellen Johnson Sirleaf He was former President of Liberia.
 - Cynthia Germanotaa She is president of Liberia.
 - Alisson Becker He is goalkeeper of the Brazilia and Liverpool football team.
 - Natalia Loewe Becker She is medical doctor and health advocate from Brazil.

G20 FINANCE MINISTERS MEETING AND CENTRAL BANK GOVERNORS MEET HELD IN FUKUOKA, JAPAN

- > As a part of setting the stage for 2019 G20 Summit, to be held in Osaka, Japan, from 28-29 June 2019, a G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors Meet was held in FuKuoka, Japan on 8-9 June.
- ➤ It was one of the 8 ministerial meetings taking place in Japan before 2019 G20 summit. This is for the first time that Japan is hosting the G20 Summit & Ministerial Meetings at its eight different locations.
 - The Indian side was led by Union Minister for Finance & Corporate Affairs Nirmala Sitharaman comprising of of Subhash C.Garg. Finance Secretary and Economic Affairs Secretary Dr. Viral Acharya, Deputy Governor of RBI and other officers

ST PETERSBURG INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC FORUM 2019

Russia's annual Saint Petersburg International Economic Forum (SPIEF) is being held from 6-8 June 2019

It is an annual international forum that discusses key economic issues faced by Russia, emerging markets and world at large stage. The Saint Petersburg is Russia's former imperial capital.



Key Highlights of SPIEF:

- **Background**: The first SPIEF was held in **1997**. Now over past two decades, it has become one of leading global platforms for communication between representatives and discussion of crucial global economic issues. Since 2006 it has been held under auspicious and participation for Russian President Vladimir Putin.
- ➤ The SPIEF 2018 edition brought together around 17,000 participants from more than 140 countries. At the event Russia tries to boost its appeal to international business and investors.

INDIA RANKED 95TH IN 129 COUNTRIES IN NEW **GENDER EQUALITY INDEX**

➤ India was ranked 95th among 129 countries in new ➤ 14th SDF (Sustainable Development Goals) Gender Equality Index with 56.2 scores. The gender gap index of the World Economic Forum had ranked India with 108.

14TH OIC SUMMIT HELD IN MECCA, SAUDI ARABIA

- Islamic Summit organized Organization bv Islamic Co of operation (OIC) summit was held in **Mecca**, Saudi Arabia. It was by Saudi hosted King Salman bin Abdul Aziz al Saud.
- ➤ The summit, titled as "Mecca Summit: Together for the Future", aimed at developing a unified stance on events in the Islamic world.

MUMBAI RANKED MOST CONGESTED CITY IN THE WORLD, DELHI RANKED 4TH IN TRAFFIC INDEX 2018

> The recent study "Traffic Index 2018", analysis of current status of traffic mobility was conducted.

Key Findings:

- > According to the findings, **Mumbai** is the most traffic congested city among 403 cities in 56 countries with a congestion level of 65 percent, while New Delhi ranked fourth with a congestion of 58 per cent.
- ➤ The other top cities in the list of congested cities are: Bogota (63 per cent). Lima in Peru (58 per cent). Moscow in Russia (56 Per cent). Brussels (37 Per cent), London (37 Per cent) and Paris (36 per cent).
- > Top five most congested North American are in the list are: Mexico City (52 percent), Los Angels (41 per cent), Vancouver (38 per cent) and San Fransico (34 per cent).

PM MODI TO ATTEND THE G7 SUMMIT IN FRANCE AS A SPECIAL INVITEE

> French President. Emmanuel Macron has invited Prime Minister Mr.Narendra Modi attend the 45th session of the G7 Summit in Biarritz in France as a special invitee. The summit of the G7 group of countries scheduled to take place from August 24 to August 26.

Key points:

- ➤ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has accepted an invitation for the summit.
- ➤ The Seven (G7) countries are Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, the United Kingdom, and the United States.
- ➤ France's Minister of state for foreign affairs Jean-Baptiste Lemoyne is recently visiting India for the first time.
- ➤ The G7 Summit 2018 (44th Summit) was held in Quebec, Canada.

INDIA RANKED 113 OUT OF 176 COUNTRIES IN END OF CHILDHOOD **INDEX**

- ➤ According to the 3rd End of Childhood Index, a part of Changing Lives in Our Lifetime - Global Childhood Report 2019, India was ranked 113 in 176 countries on the wellbeing of children with 769 score out of 1000.
- ➤ The Index was released on May 28, 2019 by "Save the Children", a United Kingdom (UK) based non-profit organisation which works for child rights.



Key facts about India:

- ➤ As per the Index, India had improved on child mortality from 39 deaths per 1000 live births in 2017. It was 88 deaths per 1,000 live births in year 2000. It was reduced by 55%.
- ➤ More than 38% Indian children aged 0-59 months were stunted, it is the second-worst performance compared to its neighbours after Pakistan (40.8%). China (6%) had the lowest rate in the region, followed by Nepal (13.8%), Sri Lanka (17.3%), Bangladesh (17.4%) and Bhutan (19.1%).
- > In India, every fifth child was out of school at primary and secondary levels and more than 11% in the 5-17 age groups were child labourers.

16TH ASIA MEDIA SUMMIT HELD IN SIEM REAP PROVINCE, CAMBODIA

> The 16th Edition of Asia Media Summit (AMS) 2019 was held in Siem Reap province. Cambodia from June 12 to June 14, 2019. It was inaugurated by the Prime Minister of Cambodia, Samdech Hun Sen, AMS was held under the topic "Media Digitalization Focusing on Developing Markets" and it gave a call to fight against fake news and cybercrimes.

Key points:

➤ It was organized by Cambodian Ministry of Information collaboration with the Asia - Pacific Institute Broadcasting Development (AIBD).

WORLDWIDE DISPLACEMENT TOPS 70.8 MILLION AT THE END OF 2018: UNHCR REPORT

> According to the recently released UNHCR's (United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees) annual Global Trends report, almost 70.8 **million** people are forcibly displaced in 2018, the most since just after World War II and double the number of 20 years ago.

Key points:

- The report states that the number of people fleeing persecution, conflict, violence or human rights violations rose by 2.3 million in 2018.
- ➤ About 4 million **Venezuelans** and more than 1.5 million **Ethiopians** were the largest displaced population in 2018.

- ➤ The 1st edition of Thai film festival was inaugurated in 2017 to celebrate the 70 years of Indo-Thai diplomatic relations.
- ➤ The festival featured stage performances by Thai artists including Thai folk-jazz band **Asia-7**.
- ➤ It featured a series of Thai craft activities including mulberry paper mini umbrella making, fan painting, body paint, and button badge making along with the traditional Thai cuisines.



1.10 LATEST HISTORICAL EVENTS

ASI DECLARED CHAUKHANDI STUPA AS MONUMENT OF NATIONAL IMPORTANCE

Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has declared Chaukhandi Stupa as protected area "Monument of national importance". The ancient Buddhist site is situated at Sarnath. Uttar Pradesh.



Key points:

- **Construction**: It is said to be that Chaukhandi stupa was a terraced temple constructed between 4th to 6th century of the Gupta period.
- > Stupa's Significance : It was built to mark site where Lord Buddha and his first disciples met when travelling from Bodh Gaya to Sarnath.
- > Shape of Stupa: It was given by the Govardhan, the son of Raja Todarmal.
- > Excavations site During excavations Some Buddha and other statues were founded at Chaukhandi Stupa.

Background

> Section 4 of Ancient Monuments and Archaeological **Sites** and Remains Act, 1958 empowers the Government to declare ancient monuments archaeological or which are of historical, archaeological of artistic interest and which have been in existence for not less than 100 years as of national importance.

1.11 INDIA & ITS NEIGHBOURS

INDIA EXTENDS FINANCIAL AID TO NEPAL FOR REBUILDING **EARTHQUAKE - HIT HOUSES**

- > India extended a financial aid of 1.6 billion Nepalese Rupees (NPR) to Nepal government for rebuilding earthquake-hit houses in two district that were most hit.
- ➤ This sustained and generous humanitarian support extended by India for post-earthquake reconstruction was appreciated by Nepal.



Key Highlights:

- ➤ **Background**: In February **2019**, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between India and Nepal for grant with USD 100 Million to be provided by India, for supporting reconstruction of 50,000 private houses in two districts of Himalayan nation namely Nuwakot and Gorkha that were most damaged in earthquake that hit Nepali in 2015.
- ➤ The devastating earthquake which struck Nepal in April 2015, claimed more than 9,000 lives and damaged over 800,000 houses. The epicenter of earthquake was central Nepal's Gorkha district.

INDIA WILL OVERTAKE CHINA AS WORLD'S MOST POPULOUS COUNTRY: UN REPORT



According to the **26**th edition of the UN (United Nations) population estimates projection and report, "World Population Prospects 2019" published by the UN's Department of Economic and Social Affairs states that India is going to surpass China as the world's most populous country by 2027.

About UN:

- ➤ Headquarters: New York, United States
- > Founded: 24 October 1945
- > United States Secretary general: António Guterres

- ➤ As per the report, India likely to add nearly 273 million people between 2019 and 2050.
- ➤ According to the World Population Review 2019, India currently ranks second in the index (out of 230 countries), with over 17 per cent of the world population.
- ➤ Previous UN projections had estimated that India will surpass China as the world's most populous country as early as 2022.
- ➤ The report also stated that among the Southeast Asian counties. Bangladesh, Nepal and Myanmar have witnessed a large net outflow of migrants between 2010 and 2020.
- ➤ Nigeria with 733 million, the United States with 434 million, and Pakistan with 403 million are the three countries expected to get place after India and China.

1.12 APPOINTMENTS

INDIA'S ANITA BHATIA PICKED UP FOR DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF UN WOMEN

➤ Anita Bhatia, has been appointed by UN Secretary-General António Guterres as the deputy Executive Director of the **UN Entity for Gender Equality** and the Empowerment of Women (UN Women).



- > She have a famed career at the **World Bank**, serving in various senior leadership and management positions.
- ➤ Bhatia holds a BA in history from Calcutta University, an Master of Arts in Political Science from Yale University and Juris Doctor in law from Georgetown University.

ZUZANA CAPUTOVA SWORN IN AS FIRST FEMALE PRESIDENT OF SLOVAKIA

➤ Lawyer and Anti-corruption campaigner, Zuzana Caputova (45) sworn in as country's Slovakia's first female president. She defeated Smer-SD candidate Maros Sefcovic.





Key points:

- > She is the **fifth** president of Slovakia.
- ➤ She was elected in March 2019 with 58% of votes over Mr Sefcovic (42%).
- > She was honoured with the Goldman Environmental Award in 2016 for her strong leadership regarding the Pezinok landfill affair, Caputova.

QU DONGYU, THE FIRST CHINESE NATIONAL TO HEAD FAO

➤ China's agricultural deputy minister, **Qu Dongyu** (55) elected as the new director general of the United Nation's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) at Rome, Italy.



Key points:

➤ He won 108 votes, followed by Catherine Geslain-Laneelle of France (the first woman to run for the post, a former head of the European Food Safety Authority) with 71 votes and Georgia's Davit Kirvalidze (a former agriculture minister) with 12 votes in the first round of voting.

RBI DEPUTY GOVERNOR VIRAL ACHARYA **RESIGNS 6 MONTHS BEFORE HIS TERM ENDS**

> Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) Deputy Governor Viral Acharya has quit his role six months before the end of his term. He was appointed as the RBI deputy governor by the government on January 23, 2017, for a three-year term.

Key points:

- ➤ Acharya, who was in charge of monetary policy, will return to New York University as an economics professor in August instead of February 2020.
- > He had raised concern over the importance of RBI's independence in October 2018.
- ➤ The RBI is now left with three deputy governors N S Vishwanathan, B P Kanungo and M K Jain.
- ➤ Viral Acharya has co-authored research papers with former RBI Governor Raghuram Rajan.

- > She replaced **Dushyant Chautala** who was elected at the age of 26 from the Hisar Lok Sabha **seat** in 2014.

2.2 GOVT - WELFARE ORIENTED SCHEMES, THEIR UTILITY

ARMY COMMISSIONED AIR QUALITY MONITOR AT FORT WILLIAM AS A PART OF 'GO GREEN' INITIATIVE

> Army commissioned "Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring System (CAAQMSY)", an air quality monitor, at Fort William Military Station, Kolkata, as a part of 'Go Green' initiative. It monitors air pollution on real time basis.

Key Points:

- > It was commissioned by Lt Gen M M Naravane, General Officer, Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Command.
- > CAAQMS displays wind speed, direction, ambient temperature, relative humidity, solar radiation, barometric pressure and rain gauge.
- ➤ It can be used by the West Bengal Pollution Control Board or any other local international weather monitoring bodies.

I & B MINISTRY INSTITUTES ANTARASHTRIYA YOGA DIWAS MEDIA **SAMMAN**

The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (I&B) has instituted a new award called Antarashtriya Yoga Diwas Media Samman (AYDMS) from year 2019 to recognise contribution made by media in spreading awareness about Yoga and for promotion and commemoration of International Yoga Day, held every year on 21 June.



Key Highlights:

- ➤ **About :** Union Ministry of I & B instituted 1st Antarashtriya Yoga Diwas Media Samman (AYDMS) from 2019 onwards to acknowledge positive role and responsibility of media in disseminating outreach of Yoga in India and abroad.
- **Eligible:** AYDMS will be conferred to Media Houses engaged in Print and Electronic Media (including Television & Radio).

PM NARENDRA MODI RECONSTITUTED NITI AAYOG

> Prime Minister of India, Narendra Modi approved the reconstitution of government's policy think tank, National Institution for Transforming **India (NITI) Aayog.** It is scheduled to meet on June 15 for the first time after Modi government won a second term, chaired by the prime minister.

Key points:

- ➤ Rajiv Kumar was retained as the Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog whereas economist Bibek Debroy, a full-time member, was dropped from the team.
- ➤ V K Saraswat, Ramesh Chand and Dr V K Paul will continue as the members of NITI Aayog.
- ➤ Home Affairs Minister Amit Shah was appointed as one of the exofficio members of the NITI Aayog, along with Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and Agriculture and Rural Development Minister Narendra Singh Tomar.
- ➤ Road Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari, Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Thawar Chand Gehlot, Railways Minister Piyush Goyal, and MoS (Independent Charge) for Statistics and Programme Implementation Rao Inderjit Singh were named as special invitees.
- ➤ The name of Amitabh Kant, who was the NITI Aayog CEO during the first term of Modi government, was dropped out from the list.
- ➤ The council comprises of all chief ministers, lieutenant governors of union territories, several union ministers and senior government officials.
- ➤ The fifth meeting of NITI Aayog's Governing Council, scheduled to be held on June 15, 2019, will discuss various issues concerning water management, agriculture and security.

About NITI Aayog:

➤ NITI Aayog is the **premier policy think tank** of the central government and it provides both **directional and policy inputs** to the government. The policy think tank was **set up in 2015**, replacing the **planning commission**.

BULLETIN: PRADHAN MANTRI KISAN PENSION YOJANA

- ➤ The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra modi has approved **Pradhan Mantri Kisan Pension Yojana**, a new **Central Sector Scheme** (CSS), to provide pension cover to farmers.
- ➤ This decision was taken at the first Cabinet meeting after formation of new Government (second term) of Modi Government.

Key Features of Scheme:

- ➤ It is voluntary and contributory pension scheme for all Small and Marginal Farmers (SMF) across the country.
- ➤ **Eligibility:** Entry age of 18 to 40 years with provision of minimum fixed pension of Rs.3,000 on attaining the age of 60 years.
- **Contribution:** Beneficiary farmer of this scheme is required to contribute Rs.100 per month at median entry age of 29 years. Central Government will also contribute to Pension Fund an equal amount as contributed by eligible farmer.



3. Geography

3.1 GEOGRAPHICAL LANDMARKS

KOLHAPURI CHAPPAL GETS GI (GEOGRAPHICAL **INDICATIONS) TAG**

➤ World famous handcrafted footwear. Kolhapuri **chappal** gets a Geographic Indication (GI) tag from The Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trade Mark. The tag was given to the states of Maharashtra and Karnataka, covering four districts each.



Key points:

- > The four districts in Maharashtra are Kolhapur, Solapur, Sangli, and Satara and four districts in Karnataka are Dharwad, Belgaum, Bagalkot, and Bijapur.
- **Benefits**: Tagging will help artisans in Kolhapur make & market their products domestically and internationally. It will also help these artisans to tackle attempts to copy or imitate the footwear brand illegally.
- **Kolhapuri Chappal**: Brand Kolhapuri came at the beginning of the 20th century when the footwear began to be traded in Kolhapur. Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj encouraged production of Kolhapuri Chappal and opened 29 tanning centers during his rule.

About Geographical Indication:

> It is used on products that have a specific geographical origin and possess qualities or a reputation that are due to that origin.

3.2 POLICY ON ENVIRONMENT AND ECOLOGY

BINNY, INDIA'S ONLY ORANGUTAN DIES IN ODISHA ZOO

▶ A 41-year-old orangutan at Odisha's Nandankanan Zoological Park died following a prolonged illness. "Binny", the country's lone orangutan passed

- away due to old-age related ailments followed by respiratory tract infection.
- ➤ The great ape was under treatment for the last one year by experts from the College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry OUAT who were under constant advice of the Orangutan experts from UK and Singapore.



FOR THE FIRST TIME, INDIA OPENS WATER CLINIC FOR **ELEPHANTS IN MATHURA**

- > India has opened its first specialized hydrotherapy treatment centre for elephants suffering from arthritis, joint pain and foot ailments. It is situated in Mathura, Uttar Pradesh.
- > It is a collaboration of Uttar Pradesh Forest Department and the NGO (Non-Governmental Organization), Wildlife SOS.

Key points:

- > The jumbo hydrotherapy centre: It is near the Wildlife SOS' Elephant Conservation and Care Centre (ECCC), which has over 20 rescued elephants.
- > State-of-the-art modern facilities: It includes wireless digital X-ray, laser treatment, dental X-ray, thermal imaging and ultrasonography to treat injured, sick and geriatric elephants.

4. Economics

4.1 CURRENT SOCIO - ECONOMIC PROBLEMS

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN INDIA AT 6.1% IN 2017-18

➤ According to a survey conducted by **National Sample Survey Office (NSSO)** between July 2017 and June 2018 covering **4.3 lakh people** revealed that the unemployment rate was about 6.1% in 2017-18, highest in 45 year since 1972-73.

Job Count INDIA'S UNEMPLOYMENT STOOD AT 6.1% IN 2017-18 Rural 5.3% Urban 7.8% Includes period after methodology demonetisation followed

Key Points:

- ➤ Unemployment was **higher in urban** areas as compared to rural.
- ➤ Unemployment rate in **rural** areas was about **5.3%** while in **urban** areas it was about **7.8%.**
- ➤ 6.2% males and 5.7% females are jobless in India.
- ➤ The unemployment rate is highest among **urban females at 10.8%** followed by urban males at 7.1% rural males at 5.8% and rural females at 3.8%

INDIA CONSTITUTES 12% OF GLOBAL INTERNET USERS

> According to the report on internet trends released by the venture capitalist Mary Meeker stated that **India** ranks **second** by witnessing **12**% world internet users (close to 455 million). China leads the chart with 21% of global internet users while **U.S** (United States) placed **third** with **8%**.

- ➤ Now the total Internet users (3.88 billion) is more than half the world's population.
- ➤ The growth in Internet users in India was mainly driven by low price data plans introduced by Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd and cheaper smartphones.

INDIANS RANKED 2ND AMONG BLEISURE TRAVELERS GLOBALLY

➤ Indians were ranked 2nd among Bleisure Travelers across **31 countries** as per the study of Booking.com. In 2018, 72% Indian travelers extended their business trips. Bleisure is a new trend which means business and leisure trips.

Key Points:

- ➤ Thai travelers were ranked 1st with 80%.
- > Booking.com's study revealed that Indian travelers were more than the global average (51%).
- > The study was conducted in October-November 2018 among 53/492 respondents. It included 1,852 Indians across 31 countries who had travelled at least once in past 12 months.
- > Two-thirds of Indian travelers, around **65%**, travelled on domestic business trips. It was the highest, globally ahead of Indonesians (62%) and Chinese (62%).

3RD ADVANCE ESTIMATES OF PRODUCTION OF MAJOR CROPS FOR 2018-19 RELEASED BY THE GOVERNMENT

- > The Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare under the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare released the 3rd Advance Estimates of Production of major crops for 2018-19. The data was based on the feedback received from States and validated with information available from other sources.
- ➤ As per 3rd Advance Estimates, the estimated production of major crops during 2018-19 is as follows:
 - 1. Food grains production stood at 283.37 million tonnes, which was higher by 17.62 million tonnes than the previous five years (2013-14 to 2017-18) average production of food grain.

> The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced its second Bi-Monthly Monetary Policy Rates for **2019-20** in Mumbai on June 6, 2019.

5. Science

5.1 SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

SRI LANKA LAUNCHED ITS FIRST SATELLITE 'RAVANA-1' INTO ORBIT

> Sri Lanka successfully launched its first satellite 'Ravana-1' into orbit from the International Space Station (ISS) along with two other BIRDS - 3 satellites from Japan and Nepal. It was deployed to the 400-km of orbit at an inclination of 51.6 degrees using the JAXA (Japanese Aerospace and Exploration Agency) owned Kibo experiment module.

Key points: The satellite was designed and developed by 2 Sri Lankan engineers - Tharindu Dayaratne and Dulani Chamika who are studying space engineering at Japan's Kyushu Institute of Technology.

- ➤ Ravana 1 measures 11.3 cm x 10 cm x 10 cm and weighs around 1.05 kg. It was officially handed over to the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency on February 18, 2019 and was sent to the ISS on April 17, 2019 through the assistance of Cygnus-1 spacecraft from the US.
- The satellite is expected to fulfil five missions. It will have a minimum lifespan of one-and-a-half years but is expected to be active up to 5 years.

ISRO'S NEW COMMERCIAL ARM 'NEWSPACE INDIA LIMITED INAUGURATED IN BENGALURU

> Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has inaugurated its new commercial arm 'NewSpace India Limited' (NSIL) in Bengaluru, Karnataka. The objective of new commercial arm is to scale up industry participation in Indian space programmes, NSIL was inaugurated by Dr.K.Kasturirangan, ISRO's advisor, in the presence of ISRO's chairman Dr.K.Sivan.

NASA UNVEILED SCHEDULE FOR 2024 MOON MISSION 'ARTEMIS'

> NASA unveiled schedule for 2024 Moon mission 'Artemis'. The Mission is named 'Artemis' after the Greek mythological goddess of the Moon and twin sister to Apollo.

Key Points:

- > This Mission has committed to take a female astronaut to the surface of the moon for the first time.
- > There will be 3 Schedules for the launch. Artemis 1 is planned for 2020. Artemis 2 will orbit Earth's statellite with a crew around 2022 and Artemis 3 will land the astronauts including the first woman in 2024.
- ➤ The three will be launched into space by the Boeingled Space Launch System (SLS), the biggest rocket of all time, which is currently under development.
- > Along with these missions. there will be 5 launches carrying the building blocks of the lunar mini-station "Gateway". These will be carried out between 2022 and 2024 by private space companies.
- ➤ NASA has chosen Maxar, a private firm to build the first module of the station.

NASA TO SHUT DOWN SPITZER SPACE TELESCOPE AFTER 16 YEARS IN 2020

➤ The National Aeronautics and Space Administration's (NASA) Spitzer Space Telescope will be shut down on January 30. **2020** after 16 years of exploring the cosmos in infrared light. This was announced by the Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL).



- ➤ It was launched in January 1983 as Infrared Astronomical Satellite to conduct the first infrared survey of the sky. It was jointly developed by the United States, the Netherlands, and the United Kingdom.
- > Spitzer was originally built to last for a minimum of 2.5 year and by 2020 it will operate for more than 11 years beyond its prime mission.
- > Spitzer is a small, transformational observatory. It captures infrared light, which is emitted by 'warm' objects that are not quite hot enough to radiate visible light. In 2017, the telescope revealed the presence of seven rocky planets around the Transiting Planets and Planetesimals Small Telescope (TRAPPIST) -1 star.
- ➤ NASA's James Webb Space Telescope will be launched in 2021 after the expiry of Spitzer's Mission.

INDIAN NAVY SUCCESSFULLY CONDUCTED 'LIVE MATING' OF SUBMARINE RESCUE SYSTEM DSRV

> The **Deep Submergence Rescue Vehicle (DSRV)** based at Visakhapatnam, successfully conducted the live mating exercise. It involved the transfer of personnel from the bottomed submarine, INS Sindhudhvaj. It was inducted into the Navy by the former Chief of the Naval Staff, Admiral Sunil Lanba in December.

Key Points:

- ➤ The live mating exercise is a historic achievement towards DSRV integration into the Indian Navy. It paved way for the Indian Navy to emerge as a Submarine Rescue Provider in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR).
- > The DSRV is equipped with sophisticated radar and a remotely operated vehicle (ROV).
- ➤ It is operated by a crew of three and can rescue 14 personnel from a disabled submarine at one time.

- > Navy Day : 4th December.
- ➤ **Motto**: Sham No Varunah (May the Lord of the water be auspicious unto us)

THE WORLD'S LARGEST **NUCLEAR-POWERED ICEBREAKER 'URAL'**

> On May 25, 2019, Russia launched the world's largest nuclear-powered icebreaker 'Ural' at the Baltic Shipyard in St Petersburg in order to improve its ability to tap the Arctic's commercial potential. Russia is preparing for shipping via the Northern Sea Route (NSR).



- ➤ The Ural will be given to Russia's state-owned nuclear energy corporation Rosatom in 2022 after the other 2 ice-breakers Arktika (Arctic) and Sibir (Siberia) enter into service. The Arktika was floated in 2016.
- ➤ By 2035, Russia's ARctic fleet will have minimum 13 heavy-duty icebreakers, among them 9 will be powered by nuclear reactors.

Telangana Government had signed an agreement with Tech Mahindra to set up the Blockchain district in 2018.



Key points:

- ➤ The draft was released by Information Technology, Electronics and Communications (IT E & C) Department.
- ➤ The focus will be given the sectors such as banking. financial services and insurance, pharmaceuticals and healthcare, government institutions and departments, logistics and supply chains.

CENTRE LAUNCHES SONG 'HAWA AANE DE' ON AIR POLLUTION

➤ As the World **EnvironmentDav** is approaching, Ministry Environment, Forest and Climate Change



launched a theme song 'Hawa Aane De' on air pollution. The song was launched in the national capital.

➤ The aim is to spread awareness regarding protecting the environment. Secretary of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change launched the song in the presence of actor Shekhar Suman and singer Shaan. World Environment Day is celebrated on June 05.

10TH NATIONAL SCIENCE FILM FESTIVAL **OF INDIA**

- > 10th National Science Film Festival of India (NSFFI) will be in Agartala, Tripura in January-February 2020.
- > This is for the **second time** the event will be held in a North-Eastern city. it will be jointly hosted by Vigyan Prasar of the Central Government, State Government and Tripura Central University.

- ➤ The Chief Minister of the Stat Biplab Kumar Deb had requested the Union Science and Technology Minister to hodl the NSFF in Tripura.
- ➤ Minimum10 cdountries will participate in the upcoming event and it will include the films produced by UNICEF, UNESCO and filmakers from different countries.

DELHI METRO IS THE INDIA'S FIRST PROJECT TO RECEIVE POWER FROM WASTE-TO-ENERGY

> Delhi Metro became India's the first ever project to receive power from a waste-to-energy plant. The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) started receiving 2 MW power from a 12 MW capacity waste-to-energy plant set up in Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh.



Key Points:

- ➤ Since June, DMRC received the power from the facility, utilized at the Vinod Nagar Receiving Sub-station (RSS) to meet the operational requirements of Pink Line of Delhi Metro.
- ➤ It will use approximately 17.5 million units per annum from the plant.
- ➤ The waste-to-energy plant was set up by East Delhi Waste Processing Company Limited (EDWPCL). It is based on a Public Private Partnership (PPP) between the Delhi government and East Delhi Municipal Corporation (EDMC).



G20 MINISTERIAL MEETING ON TRADE AND DIGITAL ECONOMY

G20 Ministerial meeting on Trade and Digital Economy is being held from 8 June -9 June 2019 in Japanese city of Tsukuba, Ibaraki Prefecture, Japan.

Key Highlights:

- **Background**: Japan has assumed its 1st ever rotating presidency in G20 thus a series of various ministerial meeting are being held in Japanese cities in 2019. Japan's presidency will be culminating during G20 summit in Osala on 28-29 June 2019.
- > Chairman: Two day meet was chaired by Masatoshi Ishida, Japanese Minister of Internal Affairs and Communications and Hiroshige Seko, Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry.
- ➤ **Objective:** To discuss how economies of G20 countries can promote trade and investment and maximize benefits from development of digital economy and technologies so as to ensure sustainable growth of global economy.

AMASEBAILU BECOMES KARNATAKA'S FIRST SOLAR-POWERED GRAM PANCHAYAT

- Amasebailu in Kundapura Taluk of Udupi district has been named as the Karnataka's first Solar-powered Gram Panchayat.
- ➤ The allocation of fund between the Centre and State Government in the ratio of **30:20**, and the rest given by the Panchayat and charitable organizations.

Key points:

- ➤ About 1858 houses connected with the solar power at a total cost of **2.13 crore.**
- ➤ The lamps have the guarantee up to **five years** while the faulty one replaced by guarantee period.

CENTRAL INDIA GOT ITS FIRST SIKH MUSEUM IN RAIPUR. CHHATTISGARH

> Central India got its First Sikh Museum in Raipur, Chhattisgarh. The museum Shri Guru Teg Bahadur Sigh Museum is located at Gurudware Gurusingh Sabha in Guru Nanak Nagar. It was inaugurated by the Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh Bhupesh Bagel on the 'Shahidi Divas' of the fifth Sikh Guru, Arjun Dev.



Key points:

- ➤ The museum has a library and visitors are illuminated about the ten Sikh gurus and other personalities related to the religion.
- ➤ They can read books on gurus and on **Sikh religion**. They can enlighten themselves about the community's history by watching movies in the home theatre of the museum in its 5,000 square feet premises.

FIFTH MEETING OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL OF NITI AAYOG HELD IN NEW DELHI

Since its inception group has played a key role in responding to global financial crisis situations. In 2008, 1st G20 Leaders' Summit was held in Washington DC, United States.

- > 15th Finance Commission headed by the Chairman Shri N.K.Singh held meeting with the representatives of Autonomous Development Councils (ADCs) of Meghalaya as part of its visit to the State.
- ➤ There are 3 ADCs in Meghalaya the Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council, the Garo Hills Autonomous District Council and the Jaintia Hills Autonomous District Council

BANCHA BECAME THE FIRST SOLAR KITCHEN ONLY VILLAGE IN INDIA



> Bancha in Betul district of Madhya Pradesh became the first village in India to have zero wooden stoves. There was no use for Liquified Petroleum Gas (LPG) cylinders as all 75 houses relied on solar-powered stoves to meet their cooking needs. The solar-powered stoves were developed by Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Mumbai. The project of installing plates, solar -powered batteries and stoves in all the houses was started in September 2017 and was completed by December 2018.

INDIA'S FIRST DINOSAUR MUSEUM **INAGURATED IN GUJARAT**



Gujarat Chief Minister Vijav Rupani inagurated the new Dinosaur Museum-cumpark at Raiyoli

Village in Balasinor town of Mahisagar district.

This is the first such park in the country and also the world's third park which exhibits remains of various dinosaurs and fossil records.

Key points:

- ➤ 3D projection, 360 degrees virtual interactive reality presentations. kiosks. gaming consoles are the facilities equipped with the museum.
- ➤ The ten galleries of the museum exhibit the history of dinosaurs, which existed 65 million years ago, from origin to extinction.
- > The Tourism Corporation of Gujarat **Ltd** created the whole infrastructure of the museum.

G20 MINISTERIAL MEETING ON ENERGY TRANSITIONS AND GLOBAL **ENVIRONMENT**

- > G20 (Group of 20) Ministerial Meeting on **Energy Transitions and Global Environment** for Sustainable Growth for the year 2019 was held at Karuizawa Prince Hotel (Karuizawa Town, Nagano), **Japan** on June 15-16, 2019.
- ➤ The Indian delegation at the G20 Ministerial Meeting on Energy Transitions and Global Environment for Sustainable Growth was represented by Shri RK Singh, Minister



of State for Power and New & Renewable Energy and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship.

INDIA HOSTING INTERSESSIONAL MEETING OF KIMBERLEY PROCESS 2019

➤ India will be hosting Intersessional meeting of Kimberley Process (KP) from 17th to 21st June, 2019 in Mumbai, Maharashtra. Besides the meetings of different Working Groups and Committees of Kimberley Process Certification Scheme (KPCS), two special forums regarding Diamond Terminology and Artisanal Mining - Small Steps to Larger Outcomes will also held.

Key points:

Kimberley Process Certification Scheme (KPCS):

- > India is the founding member of KPCS and is the chair of Kimberley Process Certification Scheme for the year 2019 with the Russian Federation as Vice Chair.
- ➤ It outlines rules that govern trade in rough diamonds.
- ➤ Participants: At present, KPCS has 55 members representing 82 countries including European Union with 28 members.
- ➤ India had earlier chaired KPCS in the year 2008.

About Kimberley Process

- ▶ It is international certification scheme that regulates trade in rough diamonds with aim of preventing flow of conflict diamonds, while helping to protect legitimate trade in rough diamonds.
- ➤ It is joint initiative involving Government, international diamond industry and civil society to stem flow of Conflict Diamonds.
- ➤ The Plenary meeting of Kimberley Process is scheduled to be held from 11th to 15th November 2019 in New Delhi.

INDIA TO HOST COP-14 OF UNCCD IN SEPTEMBER 2019

- > To address the issues of land degradation and desertification, for the first time, India will host the 14th session of the Conference of Parties (COP-14) of United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) in September 2019. It will be held between September 2 and 13, 2019 at the India Expo Center and Mart, New Delhi.
- ➤ India will take over the COP presidency from China for the next two years till 2021 until the next COP. Last Conference was held from 6-16 September 2017 in Ordos in the People's Republic of China.
- ➤ Ahead of COP-14 Union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) Prakash Javadekar launched a flagship project. It is a part of a larger international initiative 'Bonn Challenge'.

SECOND EDITION OF WORLD FOOD INDIA TO BE HELD IN NEW DELHI FROM 1-4 NOVEMBER, 2019

➤ Union Minister for Food Processing Industries Smt Harsimrat Kaur Badal announced that World Food India (WFI) 2019, a biennial event, will be held at Vigyan Bhawan and Rajpath Lawns in New Delhi from 1-4 November, 2019. It will be the biggest gathering of all global and domestic stakeholders in Food Processing Sector. This will be the second edition of WFI, first was held in 2017.

- > The 35th Goods and Service Tax (GST) Council Meeting was held in New Delhi. It was chaired by the Union Finance & Corporate Affairs Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman and it was her first meeting after assuming the office.
- ➤ In order to ease the current process of GST registration and reduce the paperwork involved, GST Council introduced a new system for verification of taxpayers registering themselves under GST
- ➤ Tenure of National Anti-profiteering Authority (NAA) which was created through CGST Act, 2017 was due to end by 30 November 2019. GST Council extended it's tenure by two years, in order to enable it to take up all the pending cases.

ODISHA CM RELEASES FLOOD HAZARD ATLAS FOR EFFECTIVE MANAGEMENT OF **FLOOD**

- ➤ The State Government of Odisha released a Flood Hazard Atlas for efficient management of flood in the state. It was released by the Odisha Chief Minister (CM) Naveen Patnaik.
- ➤ This is jointly prepared by the Remote Sensing National Centre (NRSC) of ISRO (Indian Space Research Organization) and Odisha State Disaster Management **Authority** (OSDAMA) analyzing data relating to flood from 2001 to 2018.

- > The data shows crop around 8.96% (13.96 lakh hectares) of land is being affected by flood every year in Odisha.
- ➤ Eight out of 30 districts such Kendrapara, Bhadrak, Jagatsinghapur, Balasore, Puri, Jajpur, Khordha, and Cuttack districts are more flood-affected districts. 77% of Bhadrak and 70% of the Kendrapara district have been categorized as flood hazard.

INDIA RANKED 20TH AMONG THE TOP CAPITAL IMPORTING COUNTRIES BY KNIGHT FRANK

- ➤ Property consultants, Knight Frank in its Capital 2019 Report, assigned India with the 20th rank among the top capital importing countries, globally. In terms of outbound cross-border investments, it was ranked 30th.
- > Globally, **The United States** (US) was the **top capital importing country** with an investment of \$80.89 billion. It also topped the list of **capital exporting countries** with an investment of \$59.62 billion, followed by Canada with \$50.41 billion and Germany with \$24.50 billion.
- ➤ Singapore was the biggest capital source country for Indian commercial real estate between the first quarter of 2018 and the first quarter of 2019 with investment of \$704.14

RCEP INTER-SESSIONAL MEETING HELD IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

> Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) inter-sessional meeting was held in **Bangkok**, Thailand. The officials from 16 countries which included the 10-member ASEAN, China, Japan, South Korea, Australia, New Zeland and India participated in this meeting.

Key Points:

- ➤ China is the largest producer and exporter of aluminum products. Copper and Aluminum associates are of the opinion that if India reduces import duties to 0%, it will lead to Chinese goods being dumped into Indian markets. As a result, it will lead to the immediate closure of small-scale units.
- ➤ The RCEP countries are trying to conclude a treaty that would eliminate input tariffs on about 90% of traded goods.
- ➤ On the finished goods, the demand in the country is only 6.5 lakh tonnes, which is expected to grow to about 8 lakh tonnes in the next five years.

2ND SCO MASS MEDIA FORUM INAUGURATED AT BISHKEK IN **KYRGYZSTAN**

- ➤ Indian delegation participated in **2nd Shanghai** Cooperation Organization (SCO) Mass Media Forum at Bishkek in Kyrgyzstan. It is a 4 day forum inaugurated by the President of Kyrgyz Republic, S.Jeenbeko held from May 23-26 May, 2019.
- ➤ TheIndiandelegationwasrepresented by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting which included TVK Reddy, Addl. Director General and Ankur Lahoty, Asst.Director.

- ➤ The main aim is to strengthen the exchange and cooperation in the field of mass media amongst SCO countries.
- ➤ Indian Delegation featured the vital role of Ministry of Information and Broadcasting in the development of the mass media landscape within the country.
- ➤ The SCO Member Stated adopted the Resolution of Media Forum which calls for establishing successful collaborations of Mass Media Organizations of the SCO member Countries.

72ND ANNUAL CANNES FILM FESTIVAL HELD IN CANNES. FRANCE FROM 14 TO 25 **MAY 2019**

- ➤ Filmmaker of Mexico. Alejandro Gonzalez Inarritu served as jury of Cannes Film Festival 2019.
- ➤ The Festival honoured the French filmaker **Agnes** Varda, by featuring her on the official poster of the festival. She died in March 2019
- > South Korean film 'Parasite' wins Palme d'Or which is directed by Bong Joon-ho at Cannes Film Festival. He became the first Korean **director** to win the award.
- ➤ Indian filmmaker. AchyutanandDwivedi's "Seed Mother", won the third prize in the International Section of Nespresso Talents 2019.

CHINA LAUNCHES SPACE ROCKET FROM YELLOW SEA FOR 1ST TIME



- ➤ China launched space rocket а named "Long March 11" from a mobile launch platform in Yellow Sea off Shandong province (China) for the first time.
- > China became 3rd nation following the U.S. and Russia to successfully demonstrate ability to launch satellites into orbit from a floating platform.

Key Highlights:

- ➤ Background: In 2003, China became only 3rd nation to have capability of launching humans into space and in early 2019 became 1st nation to land a rover on far side of moon.]
- ➤ The Long March rocket first flew in 2015, and this was its 7th launch but was China's first attempt at an offshore launch of rocket into Earth orbit.

INDIA-CHINA INDUSTRY COOPERATION FORUM HELD IN GUIZHOU, **CHINA**

> India and China Industry Cooperation Forum was held in Guizhou, China. The objective is to create a new chapter in India-China cooperation in the new era of digital transition.

Key Highlights:

- ➤ The National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM) has also opened an Information Technology (IT) corridor for the purpose of better exchanges between two countries in IT sector.

➤ The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affair announced that **India** has been elected to the Executive Board of the



first UN-Habitat Assembly at the Plenary Session of the Assembly held in Nairobi, Kenya.

Key Points:

- > The theme for UN-Habitat Assembly is "Innovation for Better Quality of Life in Cities and Communities".
- ➤ The event was inaugurated by Kenya's President Uhuru Kenyatta.
- ➤ This is the first session of UN-Habitat Assembly held at Nairobi, Kenya, its headquartes. It began on May 27 an will conclude on May 31, 2019.

About UN-Habitat Assembly:

➤ UN-Habitat Assembly, also known as the United Human Settlements Programme, is the UN agency for human settlements and sustainable urban settlements established in the year 1978. It is an outcome of the First Un Conference on Human Settlements and Sustainable Urban Development (Habitat) held in Vancouver, Canada, in 1976.

3RD INDO-FRENCH CYBER DIALOGUE 2019 WAS HELD IN PARIS

> The third Indo-French cyber dialogue 2019 was held in Paris, France. The meeting was co-chaired by Henri Verdier, French Ambassador for Digital Affairs, and Upender Singh Rawat, Joint Secretary in charge of e-Governance, Information Technology and Cyber Diplomacy at the Ministry of External Affairs.

Key points:

Cooperation in cyber security sector

- ➤ To combat terror in cyber space, the two sides have decided to develop effective mechanism and coordinate their efforts in cyber space.
- > Consultations held on fight against cybercrime and the use of the Internet for terrorist purposes.
- ➤ The two sides affirmed their commitment to an open, reliable, secure, stable and peaceful cyberspace.
- ➤ Fourth Indo-French cyber dialogue will be held in India.

INDIA RANKED 43RD IN COMPETITIVENESS, SINGAPORE TOPPED THE CHART

➤ India has improved its rank by one place to rank 43rd among the most competitive economy in the world and **Singapore topped** the chart by topping US from first position, now US ranked 3rd in the rankings. The improvement of India's rank was result of its roboust economic growth, large labour force



and its huge market size.

- > The G20 Ministerial meeting on Trade and Digital Economy was held on June 8 and 9, 2019 in Tsukuba city, Ibaraki Prefecture, Japan. It is one of the eight Ministerial Meetings.
- ➤ Trade and Economy Ministers of the Group of 20 major economies discussed the ways to reorder trade rules and finances in an era of technological change and protectionism.
 - The Indian delegation for G20 Ministerial Meeting was led by the Union Minister of Commerce and industry & Railways, Piyush Goyal. He participated in the discussions related to increasing trade and cooperation to harness the potential of digital economy.

INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANISATION (ICAO)

- ➤ Senior Bureaucrat Shefali Juneja was appointed as representative of India on council of International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), Montreal, Canada.
 - > ICAO, an UN specialized agency, established in 1944 to implement convention on international Civil Aviation (Chicago Convention).

6TH ROUND OF INDIA - CHINA BILATERAL DIAGLOGUE IN NEW DELHI

➤ On June 3, 2019, 6th India-China Bilateral Dialogue on Disarmament and Non-proliferation was held in New Delhi. The Indian delegation was led by Shri Indra Mani Pandey, Additional Secretary (Disarmament & International Security Affairs) and the Chinese delegation was led by Ambassador Fu Cong. Director General. Department of Arms Control of Ministry of Foreign Affairs.



Key Points:

- > Both the countries exchanged their views on a various issues of mutual interest related to disarmament, non-proliferation and arms control.
- ➤ Ambassador Fu Cong invited the Indian delegation to Beijing for the next round of consultations which was accepted by India.
- > External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar will visit Beijing in September before the informal summit which will be held between the Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chinese President Xi Jinping.
- > The first informal summit between Indian Prime Minister and Chinese President was held in April, 2018 at Wuhan, China.

'NATIONAL STRATEGY FOR WELLBEING 2031' ADOPTED BY THE CABINET OF UAE

> The Cabinet of United Arab Emirated (UAE) adopted a 12-year strategy 'National Strategy for Wellbeing 2031' during its meeting at the Presidential Palace in Abu Dhabi. It will be chaired by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President, Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai.



- ➤ The newly adopted strategy has 2 objectives:
 - To make UAE a world leader in quality of life by launching 90 new projects that will improve the physical, psychological digital health of future generations.
 - To promote an integrated concept of well being bv supporting UAE Vision 2021 and UAE Centennial 2071.

INDIA TO BE GUEST COUNTRY AT GUADALAJARA INTERNATIONAL BOOK FAIR

➤ India has been designated as Guest of Honour at 33rd Guadalajara International Book Fair (also called Feria Intenational del Libro de Guadalajara), in Mexico. The book fair, will be organised from 30 November 2019 to 8 December 2019.



Key Highlights of Event:

- **Pavilion**: The book fair will display a dedicated India pavilion that will display more than 35 Indian authors and artists, along with 15 publishing houses.
- India will showcase wide array of its rich and composite literary and cultural heritage by undertaking literary and academic activities at the event. The activities will comprise of conferences, publisher's round table, and discussions and presentations on science and other genres.
- > Ancient and rare manuscripts such as that of 'Ramayana' and 'Mahabharata' will be put on exhibition at the event, along with paintings, handicrafts and photo books.

COUNTRY'S FIRST IRON ORE MINE DISCOVERED IN BANGLADESH

➤ Country's first iron ore mine was discovered at Isabpur village in Dinajpur of Bangladesh. The discovery was done by the Geological Survey of Bangladesh (GSB).

- ➤ At a depth of 1,330 feet, a 400-foot thick iron layer was discovered and it is extended over an area of 6-10 square kilometers.
- **Percentage of iron**: It is 60 in the mine, which is higher in quality in comparison to other iron ore mines in the world.
- > Other countries: Canada, China, Brazil Sweden and Australia which comprises less than 50 percent of iron.
- **Other sources**: The discovery site also found to have contained other minerals such as copper, nickel and chromium and limestone at a depth of 1,150 feet.
- ➤ The GSB's first drilling was done in 2013 and they started second time in April 2019.
- **Benefits**: With this discovery in Bangladesh, economic and employment opportunities will enhanced in the country.

GANDHI PEACE RALLY HELD IN SAUDI **ARABIA**

➤ To mark the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, India Embassy organized the 'Gandhi Cvcle Rallv for Peace', in Saudi Arabia. The rally was organized in association with the Diplomatic Quarter Authority and Saudi Cycling Federation.



Key points:

- > The rally was flagged off by the Ambassador of India to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Dr.Ausaf Saveed.
- ➤ The Saudi nationals, diplomats, India Diaspora attended the rally.
- > This was the first time this kind of rally held in Diplomatic Quarters in Rivadh, Saudi Arabia.

2ND GLOBAL DISABILITY SUMMIT HELD AT BUENOS AIRES, **ARGENTINA**

➤ The 2nd Global Disability Summit ➤ was held at Buenos Aires, Argentina from June 8, 2019. The objectives of the summit were to deliberate on issues across the world concerning empowerment and inclusion of Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) and to work out a mechanism for enabling them to live an independent and dignified life.

Key points:

➤ Indian delegation was headed by the Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment Shri Thaawar chand Gehlot and it comprised of Secretary, Department Empowerment of Persons of with Disabilities (DEPwD), Smt Shankutala Gamin, Joint Secretary, DEPwD, Dr.Prabodh Seth and Shri Neeraj Semwal, Private Secretary to Union Minister.

EL SALVADOR LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY DECLARES "FORESTS AS LIVING ENTITIES"

The Legislative Assembly of E1 Salvador has recognized forests as living entities on the World **Environment Day** (5th June, 2019). Its citizens will now be required to preserve forests and respect them as more than just property.

- ➤ Since 1960s, El Salvador has lost about 85% of its native forests and the planes as a whole have lost about 80 percent of its native forests.
- ➤ A coalition in El Salvador named "Yes for the Rights of Nature" (Si por Ios Derechos Naturaleza). de has environmentalists and social. leaders called for recognizing forests as living entities.

INDIA RANKED 141 IN GLOBAL PEACE INDEX, ICELAND REMAINS PEACEFUL

➤ Institute for Economics and Peace released the report, 'Global peace index 2019' stated that India ranked 141 among 163 countries on the



Global Peace Index. **Iceland** topped the in the list.

Key findings:

- ➤ The ranking of India in 2018 was the **136th**.
- ➤ **Most peaceful: Iceland** remains the most peaceful country in the world, a position it has held **since 2008.** Other countries at top of the Global Peace index (GPI) are New Zealand, Austria, Portugal, and Denmark.
- ➤ Least peaceful: Afghanistan is the least peaceful country in the world now replacing Syria, which is the second least peaceful. South Sudan, Yemen, and Iraq comprise the remaining five least peaceful countries.
- ➤ South Asian countries status: Bhutan (15th), Sri Lanka (72), Nepal (76), Bangladesh (101 and Pakistan.

About Global Peace Index:

- > Established: 2007
- ➤ The GPI was founded by **Steve Killelea**, an Australian technology entrepreneur and philanthropist.

CANADA TO CURB SINGLE USE PLASTICS FROM 2021

➤ The Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced to ban single use plastics from 2021. The products which are expected to be banned are cotton swabs, cutlery, plates, straws, bags and drink stirrers. The goal of the government is "Zero"




plastic waste (from) coast to coast". This is done to reduce ocean waste.

- ➤ The estimated figures show that one million birds and over 100,000 marine mammals die or get injured when they get caught in plastic or ingest it.
- ➤ The decision was made following the establishment of an Ocean Plastics Charter at the G7 conference 2018.

2ND MEETING OF INDIA-ITALY JOINT WORKING GROUP ON COUNTER TERRORISM WAS HELD IN NEW **DELHI**

> The 2nd Meeting of India-Italy Joint Working Group (JWG) on Counter Terrorism was held in New Delhi. It was co-chaired by Mr.Mahaveer Singhvi, Joint Secretary (Counter Terrorism), Ministry of External Affairs and Mr Diego Brasioli, Principal Director for Security, Disarmament and non-Proliferation. Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Italy.



Key points:

- ➤ They discussed the threats posed by terrorist entities globally and in their respective regions including cross border terrorism and exchanged views on current counter-terrorism challenges including countering radicalization, terror financing and misuse of internet for terrorist purposes.
- ➤ The threats arising from transactional crimes and money laundering were also discussed.

- ➤ Korean director Lee Eon Hee, Japanese director Kaneko Shusuke and Korean actress Uhm Junghwa are the jury members of the festival.



BIMSTEC SUMMITS

The Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation(BIMSTEC) is an international organisation of seven nations of South Asia and South East Asia, housing 1.5 billion people and having a combined gross domestic product of \$2.5 trillion (2014).

Established: 6 June 1997 through the Bangkok Declaration.

Headquarters: Dhaka, Bangladesh.

Objectives: Technological and economical cooperation among south Asian and south East Asian countries along the coast of the Bay of Bengal.

The BIMSTEC member states:

Bangladesh, India, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Bhutan, and Nepal, are among the countries dependent on the Bay of Bengal.

BIST-EC:

On June 6, 1997, a new sub-regional grouping was formed in Bangkok under the name BIST-EC (Bangladesh, India, Sri Lanka, and Thailand Economic Cooperation).

On 22 December 1997, Myanmar became a full member, resulting in the renaming of the grouping to BIMST-EC. In 1998, Nepal became an observer. In February 2004, Nepal and Bhutan became full members.

On July 31, 2004, in the first Summit the grouping was renamed as BIMSTEC or the Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation.
