March 21	World Down Syndrome Day	 World Down Syndrome Day is observed every year on March 21 to raise awareness about Down syndrome. Theme 2024: 'End The Stereotypes'. The day has been officially observed by the United Nations since 2012.

- Tiger Triumph 24 is a bilateral tri-Service **Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief** (HADR) Exercise between India and USA.
- It is held onboard INS Jalashwa.

IMT TRILAT- 2024

 Indian Navy is set to participate in the second edition of IMT TRILAT Exercise.

- It is the joint maritime exercise between the navies of India, Mozambique and Tanzania.
- The first edition of the IMT TRILAT exercise was conducted in October 2022.

Op Sankalp

- March 23 marked the completion of 100 days of the ongoing maritime security operations under the aegis of 'Op Sankalp'.
- 'Operation Sankalp' was launched by the Indian Navy in the Persian Gulf and the Gulf of Oman as a measure to assure the safety and security of the Indian vessels.

LCA - Mk1A flight test

- The Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) successfully completed the first flight of indigenous Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas Mark 1A fighter jet in Bengaluru.
- LCA Mk1A is the most advanced version of Tejas.
- Tejas is an indigenously built multi-role fighter aircraft.

- It is considered to be the highest award in the Carnatic music scene.
- Nritya Kalanidhi award was presented to Dr. Neena Prasad for 2024.

Abel Prize

 The Abel Prize for 2024 has been awarded to French mathematician Michael Talagrand recently.

- The Award is given to scholar who has made a significant contribution to mathematics.
- It has been presented since 2003.

Bharat Ratna 2024

- President Droupadi Murmu conferred the Bharat Ratna 2024 on five personalities, namely,

- Four awards except for LK Advani were presented posthumously at a brief ceremony at the Rashtrapati Bhavan.

India-Bhutan

- India has decided to double Bhutan's assistance over the next five years, from ₹5,000 crore in 2019-2024 to ₹10,000 crore for the period till 2029.
- India lends support to the 'Gelephu Mindfulness City' Project of Bhutan.

2.2 PUBLIC AWARENESS & GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

Captive Elephant (Transfer or Transport) Rules, 2024

- The Centre has notified a set of rules called the Captive Elephant (Transfer or Transport) Rules, 2024.
- The Rules liberalise the conditions under which elephants may be transferred within or between states.

Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2024

 Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has recently notified the rules under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 to amend Plastic Waste Management (PWM) Rules, 2016.

• The Rules revises provisions relating to plastic packaging and commodities made from compostable plastics or biodegradable plastics.

E- Vehicle policy 2024

- The Cabinet recently approved the E-Vehicle policy to promote India as a manufacturing destination for EVs.
- The policy aims to promote India as a manufacturing destination so that e-vehicles (EV) with the latest technology can be manufactured.

2.3 GOVT - WELFARE ORIENTED GOVT SCHEMES, THEIR UTILITY

SAKHI App

- The **Vikram** Sarabhai **Space** called SAKHI-Space-borne Assistant and Knowledge Hub for Crew Interaction.
- The App will help the astronauts stay \overline{a} The scheme aims to promote the adoption connected with Earth and also alert them about their dietary schedules.
- ISRO is planning to launch the Gaganyaan human spaceflight mission in 2025.

Electric Mobility Promotion Scheme Centre (EMPS), 2024

- (VSSC) has developed a multi-purpose app Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) has proposed to implement the Electric Mobility Promotion Scheme (EMPS), 2024 recently.
 - of electric two-wheelers (e2W) and threewheelers (e3W).
 - The scheme does not cover electric fourwheelers (e4Ws) and e-buses.

BhashaNet portal

- The portal was launched jointly by the National Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY).
- BhashaNet portal is a Multilingual Internet and Universal Acceptance Initiative.
- The portal provides an eco-system to enable citizen to easily create, communicate, transact, process and retrieve information with ease in digital medium without language barrier

Revised wages under the MGNREGS

 The Union government recently notified the revised wages under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee

Scheme (MGNREGS) with States reporting a hike in wages by eight to 10%.

- Internet Exchange of India (NIXI) and the Haryana offers the highest wages at ₹374 per day and Uttar Pradesh offers the lowest wages at ₹237.
 - Tamil Nadu revised the wages Rs.294 to 319.

C-Vigil app

- The Election Commission recently stated that over 79,000 complaints against violation of model code of conduct were received on C-Vigil app and over 99 per cent of complaints have been resolved.
- "cVIGIL" App enable citizens to report on violation of election code of conduct.





3. GEOGRAPHY

3.1 POLICY ON ENVIRONMENT AND ECOLOGY

Pandavula Gutta

- Pandavula Gutta has been officially recognised as the Geo-heritage site in Telangana.
- It is a geological marvel older than the Himalayan hills.
- Geo-heritage sites are announced by the Geological Survey of India (GSI).

'Hottest Year' on record

- According to 'The State of Global Climate Report' released by World Meteorological Organisation 2023 is officially the hottest year on record.
- The global average near-surface temperature was 1.45 degrees Celsius above the preindustrial baseline.

Senna spectabilis

- The Forest Department stated that Senna spectabilis which is a highly invasive tree species has been removed from around 400 hectares of the Mudumalai Tiger Reserve (MTR).
- Madras High Court had ordered the removal of the tree from both Mudumalai and
 Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserves.

Note

 Invasive species are non-native species that significantly disrupts the ecosystems.

4.1 REPORTS AND INDICES

Human Development Index (HDI) 2023-24

- Human Development Report 2023-2024 is released by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) recently.
- Theme of the report: "Breaking the Gridlock: Reimagining Cooperation in a Polarized World "
- India ranked 134 in 2022.
- India is in the medium human development category
- HDI value increase by 48.4 percent from 0.434 in 1990 to 644 in 2022 between 1990 and 2022.
- India's life expectancy at birth is 67.7 years in 2022.
- The expected years of schooling (EYS) is 12.6 years.
- Gross National Income (GNI) per capita is \$6,951.

Gender Inequality Index 2022

- The Gender Inequality Index 2022 was □ Bihar's Begusarai has emerged as the world's released by **UNDP** recently.
- India stands at rank 108 out of 193 countries with a score of 0.437.
- India improved 14 places from the 2021 ranking of 122 out of 191 countries, with a score of **0.490**.

ILO Report

 The report titled "Profits and poverty: The economics of forced labour" was released recently by the International Labour Organization (ILO).

Key Highlights of the Report

- The forced labour generates illegal profits worth \$36 billion per year with \$10,000 per victim.
- Total annual illegal profits from forced labour are highest in Europe and Central Asia followed by Asia.
- Top three sectors with the highest annual illegal profits from forced labour,
 - Forced commercial sexual exploitation.
 - Industries
 - Services

Air Quality Report 2023

 Air Quality Report 2023 is released by Swiss organisation IQAir recently.

Key Findings:

- India was third most polluted country after Bangladesh and Pakistan.
- New Delhi has been ranked as the World's most Polluted Capital City.
- most polluted metropolitan area.
- 42 of the world's most polluted 50 cities are in India.

World Happiness Report (WHR) 2024

- The World Happiness Report is published annually by the United Nations Sustainable **Development Solutions Network.**
- It is calculated using six variables GDP per capita, healthy life expectancy, having someone to count on, freedom to make life choices, generosity, and freedom from corruption

- India ranked 126 in the Index.
- The report observed that in India, older age is associated with higher life satisfaction.
- Finland topped the list for the seventh year in a row, followed by Denmark, Iceland and Sweden.

UN World Water Development Report 2024

- UN World Water Development Report 2024 focusing on 'Water for Prosperity and Peace' was released recently.
- It was released by UN-Water.
- The report states that agriculture accounts for 70% of freshwater withdrawals.

India Employment Report 2024

 The India Employment Report 2024 was recently released by the International Labour Organisation (ILO) and the Institute of Human Development (IHD).

Key Highlights

- The youngsters account for almost 83% of the India's unemployed workforce.
- The share of those with secondary or higher education among the unemployed youth in India has almost doubled from 35.2% in 2000 to 65.7% in 2022.
- Labour from agriculture was mainly absorbed by the construction and services sectors.

Global Trade Update Report

 Global Trade Update Report was recently released by United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD).

Key Highlights

 Export of services from India rose by 14% in 2023.

- Exports of goods from India declined by 6%.
- International trade is expected to rebound in 2024.

Food Waste Index Report 2024

 Food Waste Index Report 2024 was released by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and WRAP (Waste and Resources Action Programme).

Key Highlights

- The households across the globe waste over one billion meals a day in 2022.
- 1.05 billion tonnes of food waste were generated in **2022**.
- India's per capita food waste is 55kg per year.
- India ranked 111 out of 125 countries in the index.

India TB report 2024

 India TB report 2024 was recently released by the Union Health Ministry.

Key Highlights

- Since 2015, India has recorded a decline of 16% in incidence of TB (Tuberculosis) and a 18% reduction in mortality.
- The incidence rate in India is 199 per lakh population in 2022.
- The mortality rate is 23 per lakh population in 2022.
- India has set 2025 as the target for eliminating TB.

Note

National Tuberculosis Elimination
 Programme (NTEP) is guided by the National
 Strategic Plan 2017–25 to accelerate the TB elimination.



5. SCIENCE

5.1 SPACE

India's First liquid oxygen-kerosene rocket

- The Chennai based Space start-up Agnikul Cosmos Private Limited will be launching its First Rocket Agnibaan Sub Orbital Technology Demonstrator (SOrTeD) from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre, in Sriharikota.
- Agnibaan SOrTeD will be,
 - India's First launch from a private launchpad
 - India's First semi-cryogenic engine powered rocket launch
 - World's First single piece 3D printed engine designed and built indigenously.
- Agnikul Cosmos is the First company in the country to sign an agreement with Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) under the IN-SPACe initiative

'Pushpak' Reusable Landing Vehicle

- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has successfully conducted the Pushpak Reusable Landing Vehicle (RLV) LEX 02 landing experiment
- The test was conducted at the Aeronautical Test Range (ATR), Chitradurga, Karnataka.
- The RLV LEX 02 landing experiment is the second of the series of experiments conducted by ISRO.
- RLV-LEX-01 mission was launched in 2023.

Statio Shiv Shakti

 The International Astronomical Union (IAU) officially approved the name "Statio Shiv Shakti" for the landing site of Chandrayaan-3's Vikram lander.

 IAU is the internationally recognised authority for assigning names to planetary surface features.

POEM-3 mission

- The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) announced that Polar Satellite Launch
 Vehicle Orbital Experimental Module-3 (POEM-3) has re-entered the Earth's atmosphere with zero debris in orbit.
- PSLV-C58/XPoSat mission has left zero debris in the orbit.
- POEM-3 was configured with a total of 9 different experimental payloads to carry out technology demonstrations and scientific experiments on the newly developed indigenous systems.

Kalam-250

- The leading space-tech company **Skyroot Aerospace** has successfully test-fired **Kalam 250** recently.
- Kalam 250 is the Stage-2 of Vikram-1 space launch vehicle.
- It was successfully test fired at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh.

Note

 The Vikram is a series of launch vehicles developed by Skyroot Aerospace which is an Indian startup aerospace company.

LATEST DISCOVERIES IN HEALTH SCIENCE

CoViNet

- Recently, the World Health Organisation (WHO) has launched a new network for - At present, it comprises 36 laboratories from coronaviruses, CoViNet.
- CoViNet is a network of global laboratories

with expertise in human, animal environmental coronavirus surveillance.

21 countries in all six WHO regions.





6. NATIONAL – DIARY OF EVENT

Model Code of Conduct (MCC)

- The Election Commission of India (ECI) announced that the Lok Sabha elections would be conducted in seven phases from April 19 to June 1 and the results will be announced on June 4.
- The MCC is a set of guidelines issued to regulate political parties and candidates prior to elections.
- It is **not legally binding**.
- It contains eight provisions dealing with general conduct, meetings, processions, polling day, polling booths, observers, the party in power, and election manifestos.

Solar Waste

- According to a new study published by the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) and a climate think tank Council on Energy, Environment and Water (CEEW) 600 kilotonnes of solar waste will be generated in India by 2030.
- The current solar capacity of India stands at 66.7 GW as of March 2023.

Operation 'Indravati' launched

- India recently launched Operation 'Indravati' to rescue Indians from Haiti to the Dominican Republic.
- The security situation has deteriorated due to internal unrest in Haiti.

Rajasthan Water Resources Dashboard

- Rajasthan became the first state in India to launch a dedicated portal for water.
- The portal provides real time information on the water level in dams, reservoirs and canals in different parts of Rajasthan

Domestic Systemically Important Insurers (D-SIIs)

- Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) releases the list of Domestic Systemically Important Insurers (D-SIIs) for 2023-24.
- Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC), General Insurance Corporation of India (GIC) and New India Assurance Company were identified as D-SIIs.



7. INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

Russian president

- Vladimir Putin was elected as the President of Russia again with winning 87.8% of the vote.
- He first became the President of Russia on December 31, 1999.

World's first ever Nuclear Energy Summit

- The World's first ever Nuclear Energy Summit was held in Brussels in Belgium recently.
- The summit was jointly organized by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA)

- and the **government of Belgium** to promote nuclear energy.
- The Summit was attended by more than 30 countries including India.

About IAEA

- Formation 1957
- It is an autonomous body under United Nations.
- Members 178 (Including India)





8. TAMILNADU AFFAIRS

Pudhumai Penn Scheme

- The government order issued by the Social Welfare Department has expanded the scope of the Pudhumai Penn Scheme to students studying through Tamil medium at aided schools.
- This would benefit over 49,600 more girl students studying through Tamil medium in aided schools across Tamil Nadu.
- Pudhumai Pen Scheme is launched on September 5, 2022.

Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam (MTM)

- A State-wide, cross-sectional survey has found that Makkalai Thedi Maruthuvam (MTM) has reached the most vulnerable groups, such as women in rural areas and the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes.
- hypertension were the most widely covered non-communicable diseases (NCDs) under MTM and cancer screening coverage was extremely low.
- MTM was launched in 2021.
- Aim To deliver medical care at people's doorstep.

Panel for global conference on Lord Muruga

 The Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments (HR&CE) Department has constituted a 20-member coordination committee for the International Conference Lord Muruga.

- The committee will be headed by HR&CE Minister P.K. Sekarbabu.
- The conference will be held in Palani.

Second World Classical Tamil Conference

- Chief Minister M.K. Stalin announced that the second World Classical Tamil Conference would be held in Chennai in June 2025 for five days.
- The First World Classical Tamil Conference was held in June 2010 in Coimbatore under the leadership of then Chief Minister M.Karunanidhi.

Four New Municipalities

- The State government has ordered that Pudukottai, Namakkal, Tiruvannamalai, and Karaikudi be upgraded to Municipal Corporations.
- The new Municipal Corporations will be established in compliance with the procedures laid down under the Tamil Nadu Urban Local Bodies Act, 1998.

PM SHRI Schools scheme

- The Tamil Nadu School Education Department stated that the Tamil Nadu government has decided to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Union Education Ministry to implement the PM SHRI scheme in the state.
- PM SHRI is a centrally sponsored scheme that aims to showcase the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020.
